PL9GA Executive Board Meeting Minutes

Nury welcomed the attendees to her home and called the meeting to order at 3:10 pm.

The minutes of the prior meeting (October 27, 2025) were approved.

Events & Games Review – Nury Duerst

- The **Mix & Mingle** was well attended with approximately 24 members, including several new members. Participants embraced the Howdy Partner theme by dressing in their best cowgirl outfits & learning steps to a line dance led by Andrea. Beverage expenses came in well under budget.
- **PL9 Season Opener** took place the following day with an 8:30 am shotgun start. Despite the early start & chilly weather, the event was well attended, and costs came in under budget. Proceeds of the 50/50 draw were \$170. It is expected that the PL18 and PL9 leagues will hold separate events next season.
- The two-day **Queen Bee Event** is scheduled for back-to-back days on March 23rd and 24th. There was some discussion about designating March 24th as our season closer since only one day (March 31st) has been allocated by the ProShop for Ladies Closing Day. The alternative would be to have a joint Season Closer with the PL18.
- Approximately 15 members attended the **Sips and Tips** gathering with Katelin providing information on basic golf rules and pace of play etiquette as well as answering questions from attendees. Katelin will discuss a rule each week at our post game gathering. A second Sips and Tips session will be scheduled in February.
- Nury & Adrienne attended a meeting with Charles & Katelin for a productive discussion on improving league pace of play which is a priority for all Plantation members. Many helpful tips were exchanged and communicated with PL9 members, and these have already resulted in pace of play improvements on league days. “Balls in the air at 1:00” has been adopted as our new catch phrase to ensure players get off to a timely start.
- The game for December 9th will be **Merry Mulligans** followed by a **Candle Exchange** post play. Katelin will distribute a flyer to membership. Nury has some festive treats planned on-course and Andrea will lead us in creating our custom version of The Twelve Days of Christmas after the game. Each member is asked to drop a wrapped candle at the clubhouse prior to play.
- The **Welcome Back Event** for 2026 will be held following the January 6th game.

- **Three Queens & a King Event** will be held on January 13th, and we will need to recruit about a dozen men to play with us. Lunch will be a taco bar & meals for the Kings will be complimentary.
- The club is hosting a **Member/Member Event** on February 10th as an 8:30 am shotgun. Since attendance will likely be low for the regular PL9 game that day, previously scheduled 50/50 ticket sales will be postponed to the following week (February 17th).

Other

- Consideration will be given to increasing the weekly game fee from \$6 to \$7 which is inline with the PL18 league.
