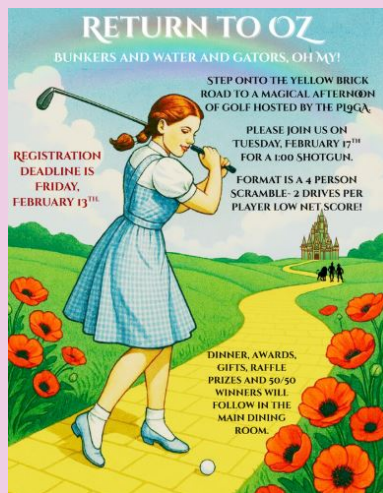

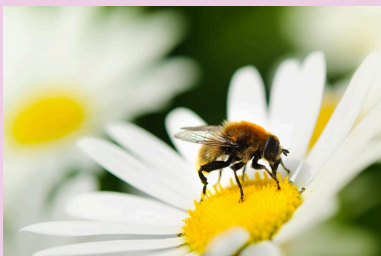
We invite you to join us for playful nine-hole rounds filled with friends, laughter, and a shared love of the game. This group is about making golf social, supportive and most of all FUN.

April 1st - April Fool's Day - Course is closed for real - No fooling!

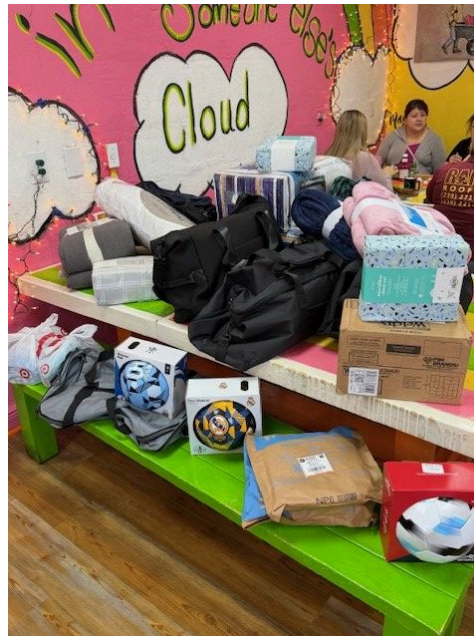
Closing Day:

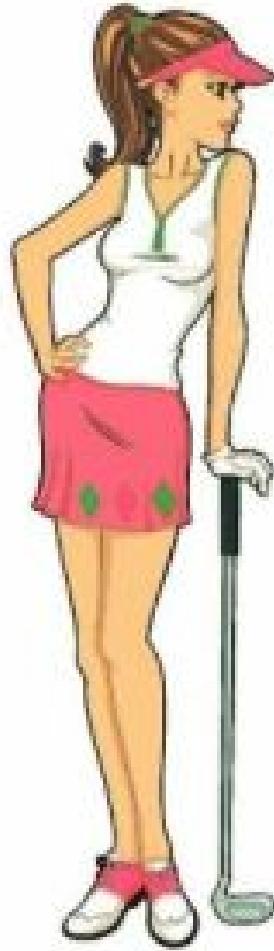
Quite a few items were dropped off last week from the donation boxes outside the Pro Shop, so we're off to a great start! Keep'em coming!
