Helps For:

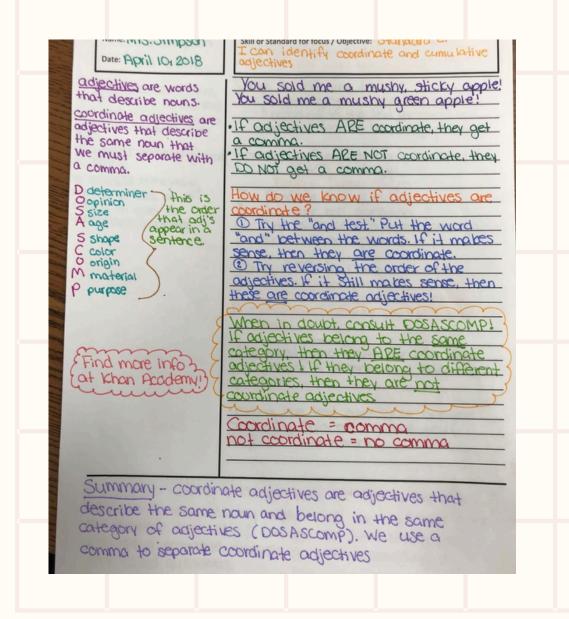
- Test prep

Left side (Cues): Keywords/ main questions

Right Column: Main notes/examples

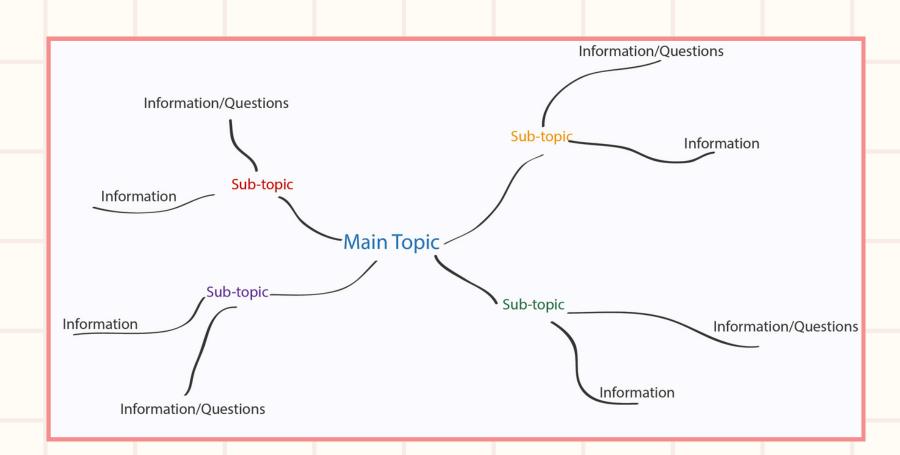
**Bottom: Summary**

Best For: Visual learners

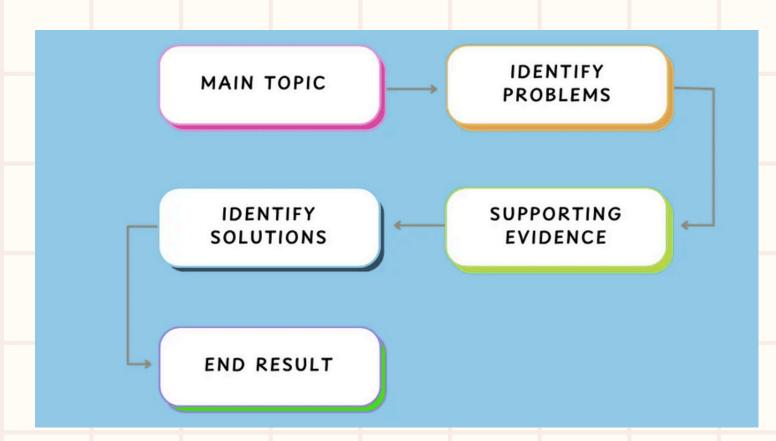
Subjects: English, Psychology, Brainstorming, key topics
