The Hub (Almonte Community Co-ordinators) has been a much loved not-for-profit tradition in Almonte since 1974, dedicated to serving the most vulnerable in the community through the revenue generated from the store. The store resells donations from the community that range from clothing to books, toys to housewares, jewelry to office supplies, and much more!

The Hub has a long history in downtown Almonte. It opened its doors at 66 Mill Street in May, 1974, until suffering a devastating fire there in 1997. In 1998, the Royal Bank of Canada sold them The Hub's current location at 118 Mill Street for \$1!

At the beginning of the 20th century, 118 Mill Street was the Orpheum Theatre. It later became the O'Brien Theatre, which played a key role in the triage of victims from Almonte's 1942 wartime train wreck.

The recent renovation of 118 Mill St has revealed the glorious original theatre ceilings over twenty feet high, burgundy walls and turquoise blue trim cornices ... even the projection booth!
