## – A Message from Father Andrew Reckers –

### HOLY DAYS OF OBLIGATION

Around this time every year, I get many questions about Holy Days of Obligation. For example, many people wonder why Ascension Thursday is celebrated on a Sunday in the Archdiocese of Cincinnati rather than on the traditional Thursday which is 40 days after Easter. The bottom line is that a Bishop with the proper permissions can suppress or transfer to a Sunday one or more of the Holy Days of Obligation that do not fall on a Sunday (see the Code of Canon Law 1246). So, inspired by these questions, I have decided to categorize how the ten Holy Days of Obligation in Canon 1246 are treated in the Archdiocese of Cincinnati.

In this article, I include four categories to which these Holy Days of Obligation fall. The first category includes Holy Days which are obligatory regardless of the day of the week on which they fall. The second category includes Holy Days that are obligatory, unless they fall on a Monday or a Saturday. The third category includes the Holy Days that have been transferred to a Sunday. Finally, the last category includes the Holy Days that are not obligatory if they do not fall on a Sunday.

- Category 1: Always Obligatory. The two Holy Days which are always obligatory are the Immaculate Conception (December 8th), and Christmas Day (December 25th). It should be noted well that even on a year when December 8th falls on a Sunday, and the Immaculate Conception is observed the following Monday, December 9th, it is still obligatory to attend Mass that day.
- Category 2: Obligatory, except when the Feast falls on a Monday or a Saturday. The three Holy Days which fall under this category are the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God (January 1st), the Assumption of Mary (August 15th), and All Saints' Day (November 1st).
- Category 3: Transferred to a Sunday. The three Holy Days in this category are the Epiphany (transferred from January 6th to the Sunday following January 1st), The Ascension of the Lord (transferred from the Thursday 40 days after Easter Sunday to the Seventh Sunday of Easter), and The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ [Corpus Christi] (transferred from the Thursday after the first Sunday after Pentecost to the Second Sunday after Pentecost). Note well that in some Dioceses in the United States, the Ascension is still celebrated on the traditional Thursday following the Sixth Sunday of Easter.
- Category 4: No Obligation to Attend Mass, if not on Sunday. The two Holy Days in this category are the Solemnity of Saint Joseph (March 19th), and the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul (June 29th).

In conclusion, if you are living in the Archdiocese of Cincinnati, the five following dates for Holy Days are important to check each year and mark on your calendar: December 8th (or 9th if the 8th is on a Sunday), December 25th, January 1st, August 15th, and November 1st. God bless, and hopefully this makes things clearer.

**THOUGHTS ON THE ACTS OF THE APOSTLES DURING THE EASTER SEASON:** All during this season of Easter, we have been hearing from the Book of the Acts of the Apostles. This is a great time to read the entire Book of Acts from start to finish, as it gives us a real shot in the arm as Christians. Let's specifically take a look at Acts 17:10-13: As soon as it was night, the brothers sent Paul and Silas off to Berea. On their arrival, they went to the Jewish synagogue. Its members were better disposed than those in Thessalonica and welcomed the message with great enthusiasm. Each day they studied the Scriptures to see whether these things were so. Many of them came to believe, as did numerous influential Greek women and men. But when the Jews of Thessalonica learned that the word of God had been proclaimed by Paul in Berea also, they hurried there to cause a commotion and stir up the crowds. When we read this passage, we see: [They] welcomed the message with great enthusiasm. Each day they studied the Scriptures. Do we welcome God's plans for us with enthusiasm? Are we attentive to Scripture at Holy Mass? Do we truly try to take in Father's homily to learn from his perspective of the readings? Do we study God's word, or do we waste a lot of time scrolling endlessly on our phones and then find that we "just don't have time" to read the Bible? Do we look at God's word as the guiding force in our lives? Do we look at the Ten Commandments as the "Ten Suggestions?" Do we make excuses to others, or even worse to ourselves, for not following God's word? Do we fail to read God's word and pray about His will for our lives because it would require us to change in ways we are not open to? We also read above: But when the Jews of Thessalonica learned that the word of God had been proclaimed by Paul in Berea also, they hurried there to cause a commotion and stir up the crowds. Do we enjoy stirring the pot and causing a commotion about things we feel strongly about? Do we enjoy convicting others but aren't concerned about our own faults? Do we react to things out of emotion instead of taking issues to prayer and seeking God's wisdom before reacting? Do we find ourselves always in a preaching posture and never in a learning posture? There is always so much more to know about God. Living our Catholic Faith deeply and with intentionality is the greatest adventure, as shared by St. Augustine: "To fall in love with God is the greatest romance; to seek Him is the greatest adventure; to find Him, the greatest human achievement." [This article is in response to Father Nathan Cromly's "Dare Great Things for Christ" podcast #65.]
