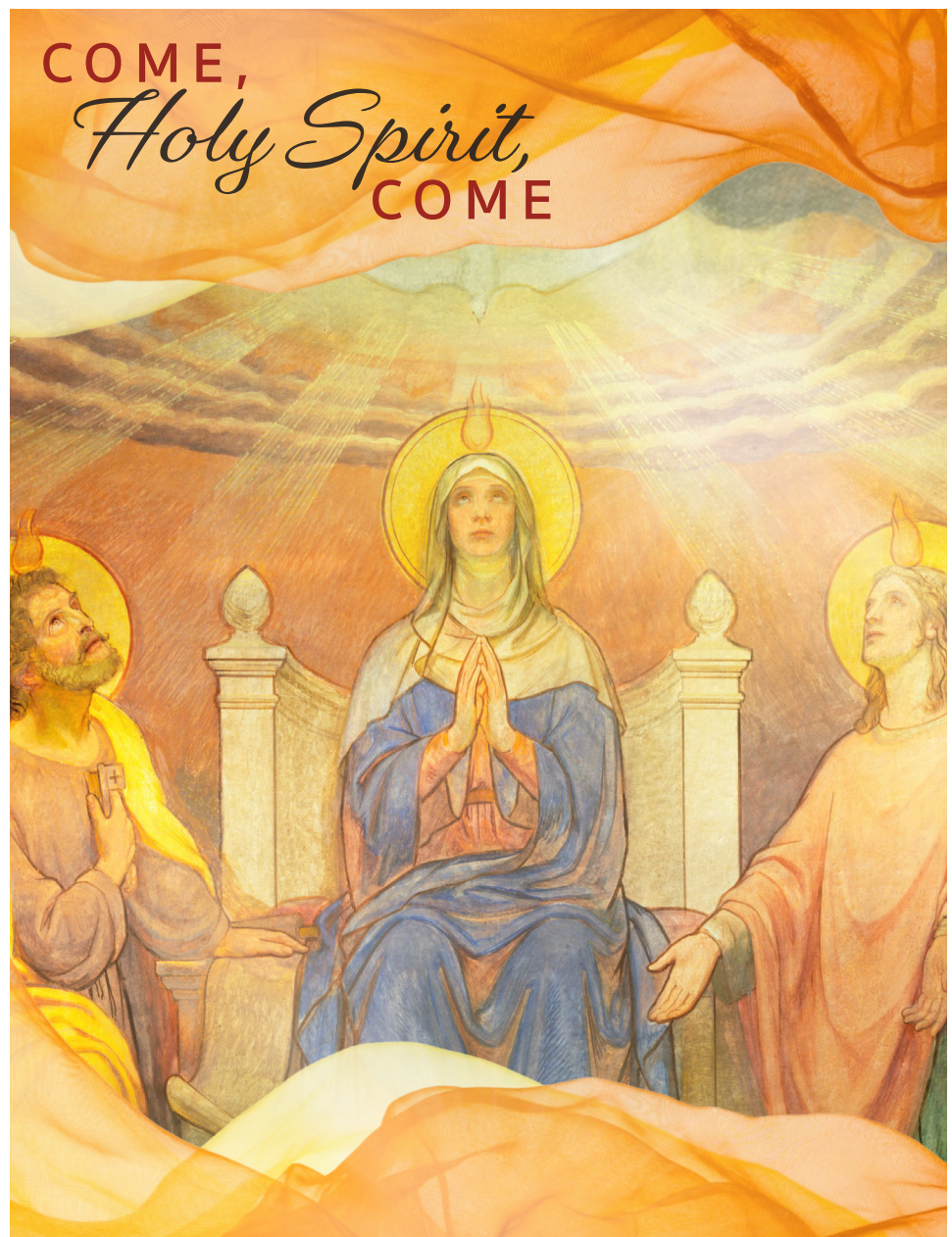

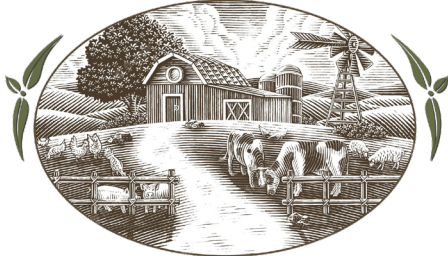

– A Message from Father Ned Brown –

PENTECOST SUNDAY REFLECTION “THE QUIET POWER OF THE HOLY SPIRIT”

We love spectacular fireworks – the boom, the flash, the thrill. The Church’s first Pentecost delivered exactly that. Gathered in one place, the Apostles and early Christians suddenly heard a thunderous wind roar from heaven. Flames of fire appeared, hovered, and rested on each of them. They began speaking in languages they had never learned. Pilgrims from every nation heard the Gospel in their own tongue. It was dramatic, unmistakable, life-changing.

Yet we would miss the deeper truth if we expected the Holy Spirit to work only in fireworks. In our daily lives, His action is usually gentle, subtle, and quiet – like a breath, like a seed growing in hidden soil.

After His Resurrection, Jesus did not shout or perform signs when He gave the Spirit to the Apostles. He simply breathed on them. St. Paul compares the Holy Spirit to the soul in a body – powerful and essential, yet invisible. The real work of the Holy Spirit is changing hearts, and hearts change in intimate, quiet encounters with God.

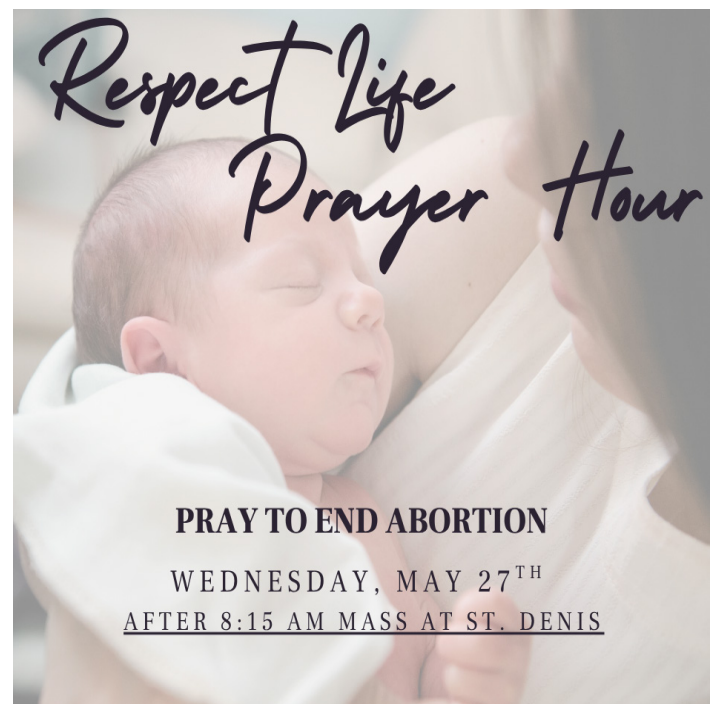
The Holy Spirit is like the invisible score in a symphony orchestra. The Pope may be the conductor and we the musicians, each with unique talents, but the living score that unites us, guides our timing, and creates beauty is the Holy Spirit Himself. In St. Peter’s Basilica in Rome, a single oval window high above the altar quietly bathes the entire vast space in warm golden light. At its center is a dove – the Holy Spirit – subtle yet transformative.

Mary shows us this quiet path perfectly. She was with the Apostles in the Upper Room, praying, serving, and sharing stories of Jesus. The same Spirit who overshadowed her at the Annunciation continued to speak in the silence of her heart. As St. Luke tells us, “Mary kept all these things, contemplating them in her heart.”

So how do we experience this quiet power? Jesus gives a clear indication: “Whoever loves me will keep my word.” By being docile to the sure teaching of the Church (Scripture, Catechism, the saints, etc.) and through personal inspirations, especially in life’s unique moments. We don’t obey the Holy Spirit’s inspirations like robots; we obey out of love, because we know that Christ will never lead us astray, and because we want to stay close to him. He guides us from within, the way magnetism guides a compass. But unless we frequently look to see where that compass is pointing, we will never reach the destination we long for.

On this Solemn Feast day, when He renews His commitment to guide us, let’s renew our commitment to pay attention, to listen to follow trusting in the Lord and not in order to experience spiritual fireworks, but in order to feed the fire of God’s love in our hearts, whose light and heat we all need so much. Come, Holy Spirit. Fill our hearts and kindle in us the fire of Your love and You shall renew the face of the earth!



SAINT PHILIP NERI

Saint of the Day: May 26

Patron Saint of Joy, Humor, Laughter, and Cheerfulness

At an early age, Philip Neri abandoned the chance to become a businessman and devoted his life and individuality to God. After three years of studies, he gave up any thought of ordination. The next 13 years were spent in a vocation unusual at the time – that of a layperson actively engaged in prayer and the apostolate.

As the Council of Trent (1545-63) was reforming the Church on a doctrinal level, Philip Neri's appealing personality was winning him friends from all levels of society, from beggars to cardinals.

At the urging of his confessor, Philip Neri was ordained a priest and soon became an outstanding confessor himself, gifted with the knack of piercing the pretenses and illusions of others, though always in a charitable manner and often with a joke. He arranged talks, discussions, and prayers for his penitents in a room above the church.

Some of Philip's followers became priests and lived together in community. This was the beginning of the Oratory, the religious institute he founded. A feature of their life was a daily afternoon service of four informal talks, with vernacular hymns and prayers.

Philip's advice was sought by many of the prominent figures of his day. He is one of the influential figures of the Counter-Reformation, mainly for converting to personal holiness many of the influential people within the Church itself. His characteristic virtues were humility and gaiety.

After spending a day hearing confessions and receiving visitors, Philip Neri suffered a hemorrhage and died on the feast of Corpus Christi in 1595. He was beatified in 1615 and canonized in 1622.
