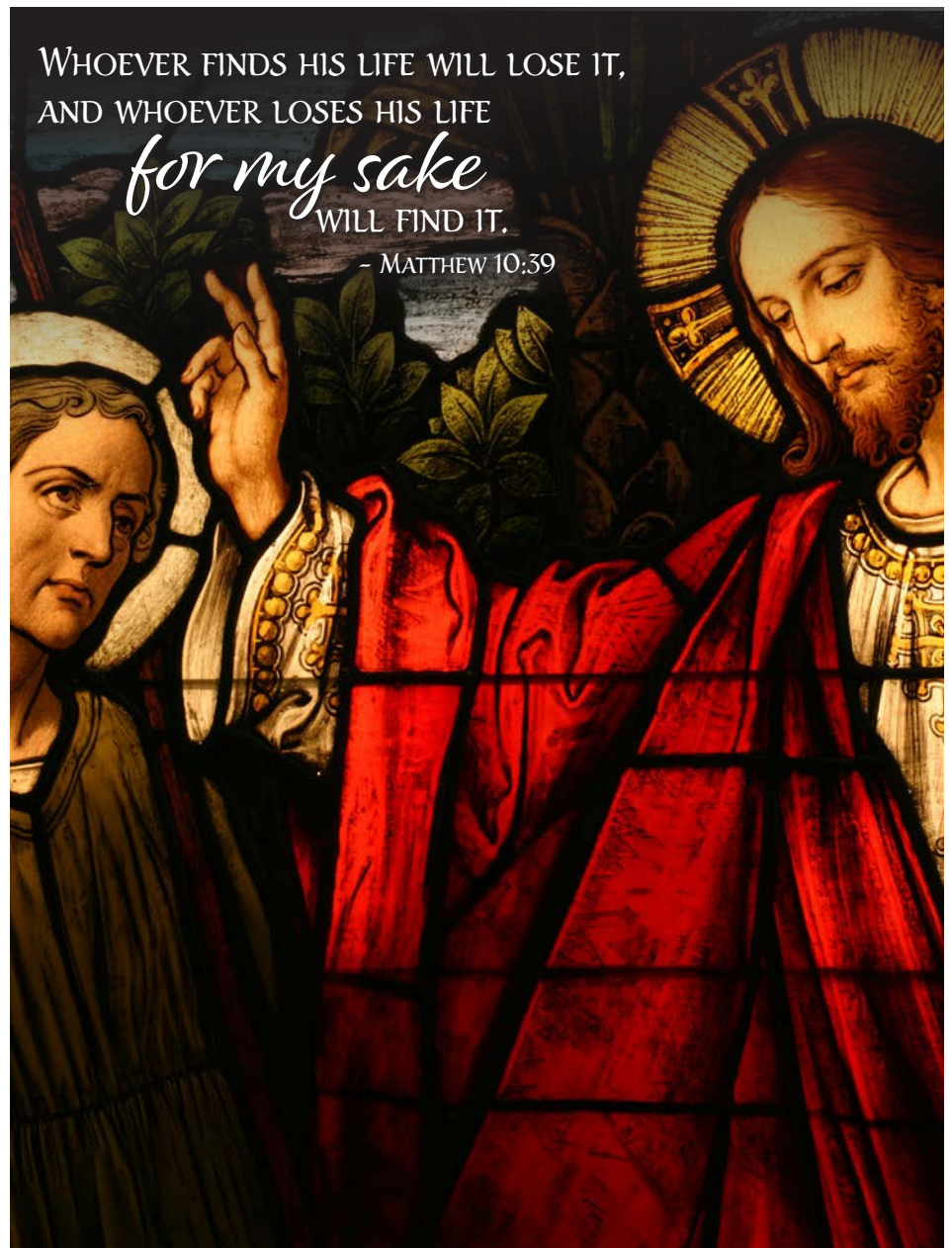

The miracle that contributed to Archbishop Fulton J. Sheen's beatification was the miraculous recovery of a stillborn infant in central Illinois in 2001.
The case involved James Fulton Engstrom, born with a tight knot in his umbilical cord that cut off oxygen, leading to a stillbirth. After 61 minutes without a heartbeat and no signs of life, his parents and family immediately prayed for Sheen's intercession.

– A Message from Father Matt Feist –

Hello Friends,

Something remarkable happens in the Church's calendar this week. We are given four feast days of martyrs: St. Irenaeus; Sts. Peter and Paul; the First Martyrs of the Church of Rome; and St. Thomas. Woven right into the middle of it all, on July 1st, is the traditional Feast of the Most Precious Blood of Our Lord Jesus Christ.

Every one of these saints was martyred. They sacrificed their lives for the faith. Every single one. Blood was the price they paid for the faith we inherited. And at the center of it all stands the Blood that made their sacrifice possible and meaningful in the first place.

The Blood of Christ is not just a pious devotion. It is the source. Everything flows from it.

We do not talk about sacrifice much anymore, do we? Our world has gotten very good at avoiding discomfort. We scroll past hard things, opt out of difficult conversations, and quietly drop commitments that cost too much. It is understandable; nobody wakes up looking for suffering. But the saints this week, and the feast that anchors them, are asking us a different question: not "Are you comfortable?" but "What are you willing to give?"

Living the Catholic faith today does not usually mean facing a sword. But it does mean things that feel costly in their own way. It means staying married when it is hard because you made a vow before God. It means showing up for a neighbor nobody else bothers with. It means turning off what is easy and choosing what is true. It means raising your children in the faith even when the culture laughs at it. It means speaking up at work, at school, and at the dinner table – not to pick a fight, but because truth matters, and silence has a cost, too.

The Precious Blood reminds us that nothing real comes without sacrifice and that sacrifice is never wasted when it is united to Christ. That is the whole logic of martyrdom. These men did not die despite their faith; they died because it was worth more than their lives. They had tasted something so real, so true, so alive, that no earthly threat could outweigh it.

Most of us will never be asked to die for the faith. But we are asked, every single day, to live it fully, openly, and at some cost. The martyrs did not become who they were overnight. They became who they were through small acts of faithfulness long before the moment of martyrdom arrived.

This week, let the Blood of Christ and the witness of these saints do something in you. Let it stir up the part of you that knows faith is not meant to be kept safe and quiet. Let it remind you that you belong to something worth giving your life to – even if today, that just means giving your afternoon, your comfort, your pride, or your fear.

That is the sacrifice the world can actually see. And it is the one that just might change it.
