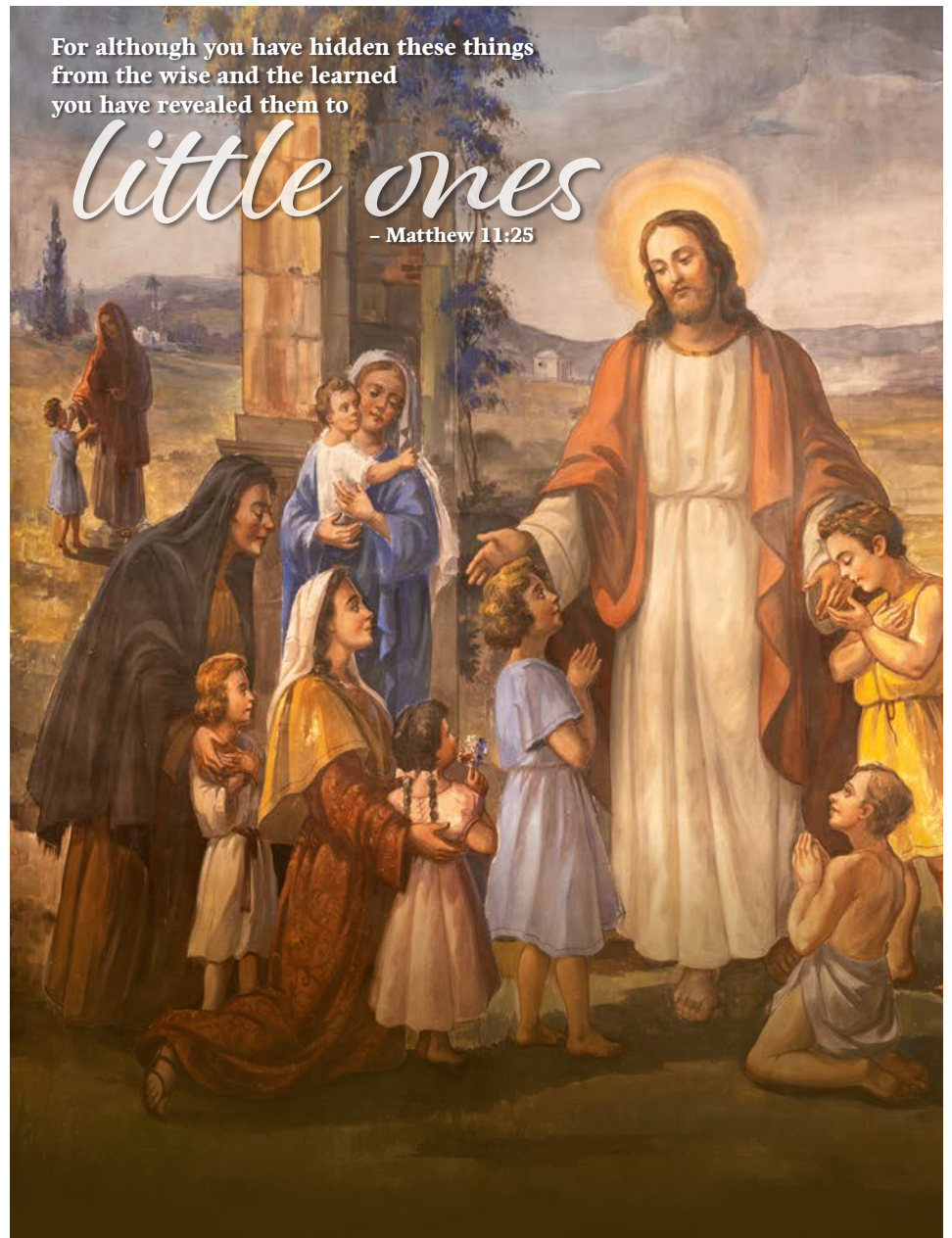

The Safe Environment Office of the Archdiocese of Cincinnati continually reviews its procedures to ensure the highest standards of child protection. As part of these ongoing efforts and in alignment with U.S.C.C.B. recommendations, they are expanding their background-check protocols. All online background checks will now require renewal every five years. 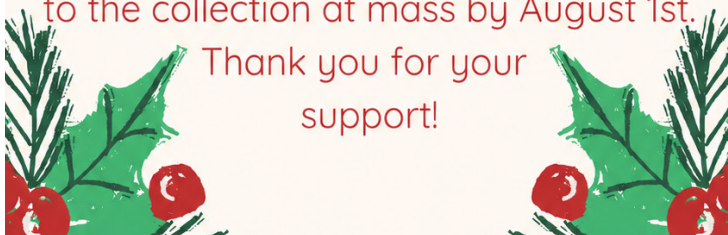
CHRISTMAS IN JULY

– A Message from Father James Reutter –

PATRIOTISM THROUGH A CATHOLIC LENS

Although I was very young, I well remember our nation's bicentennial celebration 50 years ago in 1976. There was a real surge of patriotism and an atmosphere of excitement for nearly a full year before the huge July 4 celebration, with patriotic displays, flags flying everywhere, and special events like parades, historical reenactments, boat regattas, Sousa marches, and much more. To get into the spirit, my siblings and I even painted the entire wall of one of our bedrooms as a giant American flag, with the other three walls painted, respectively, red, white, and blue.

I can't help but notice that 50 years later, as the nation has just observed her 250th Anniversary of Nationhood (the semiquincentennial, to use the \$10.00 word), there seems to be almost no enthusiasm to celebrate it in many corners of our country. For various reasons, patriotism just seems to be disappearing from much of American public life. People could write whole books on this phenomenon and transition – whether it is because we consider ourselves a “global village” now that the internet and media have transformed the way we live; because our education system and many politicians and social media influencers teach young people to be ashamed of their Christian and Western heritage; because of growing ignorance of American history in an increasingly inadequate public school system; or because we have lost a common culture as we become increasingly individualistic and tied to our private screens. I think there is some truth to all of these.

So, as we reflect on our nation during this Independence Day weekend, we should remember that patriotism is not something that is contrasted with our faith but is an integral part of it. Many people are surprised to learn that patriotism is part of our Christian duty under the Fourth Commandment: “Honor thy father and mother.” (The word patriotism comes from the same root as father.) Paragraph 2239 of the Catechism of the Catholic Church says this: “It is the duty of citizens to contribute along with the civil authorities to the good of society in a spirit of truth, justice, solidarity, and freedom. The love and service of one's country follow from the duty of gratitude and belong to the order of charity. Submission to legitimate authorities and service of the common good require citizens to fulfill their roles in the life of the political community.”

Here's where the parental parallel becomes a little clearer. Imagine if, upon reaching adulthood, we had not the least bit of gratitude for what our parents did for us: giving us life, providing for our needs, and forming and raising us. That would be the height of ingratitude and utterly lacking in charity. The Church teaches that our nation, too, helps to form us and shape us, providing a culture built up by the sacrifices of many generations before us. As a matter of justice, we owe gratitude and loyalty to her as a result. Sadly, many modern Catholics will knee-jerk their way into proclaiming, “But my country has many flaws and failings.” So do our parents. They aren't perfect, but we don't stop loving them because of it. THE CONTRIBUTING MIRACLE IN FULTON SHEEN'S BLESSED DECLARATION

The miracle that contributed to Archbishop Fulton J. Sheen's beatification was the miraculous recovery of a stillborn infant in central Illinois in 2001.

The case involved James Fulton Engstrom, born with a tight knot in his umbilical cord that cut off oxygen, leading to a stillbirth. After 61 minutes without a heartbeat and no signs of life, his parents and family immediately prayed for Sheen's intercession.
