– A Message from Father James Reutter –

“TO DIE IS GAIN” – THE SACRAMENT OF THE ANOINTING OF THE SICK

Most faithful Catholics learn about the seven sacraments from a very young age. Most parishes also put a great deal of effort into catechesis about and preparation for the sacraments. This certainly applies to the “once-in-a-lifetime” sacraments (Baptism, Confirmation, and [usually] Matrimony), but also to those that are part of the daily life of the faithful (Mass and Confession). The one sacrament that tends to get short shrift and is often poorly understood is the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick, perhaps because it is often associated with death, which many prefer not to think about. That is unfortunate because Christians of all ages should pray about and prepare for death, especially by considering how to receive God’s grace, mercy, and healing before then.

The Catechism’s explanation of the sacrament is a great place to start, beginning with these beautiful words in #1499:

“By the sacred anointing of the sick and the prayer of the priests the whole Church commends those who are ill to the suffering and glorified Lord, that he may raise them up and save them. And indeed she exhorts them ... [to] freely unit[e] themselves to the Passion and death of Christ.”

The Catechism continues to explain that the sacrament is an avenue for Christ to bestow His compassion upon the sick and, if He so chooses, to provide healing of body and soul. As the Gospels frequently remind us, the gravest illness is not of the body but of the soul burdened by sin. That is why the sacrament is typically administered in conjunction with the Sacrament of Confession for those who are able to make a Confession. In cases where someone’s illness prevents him from making a Confession, the Anointing itself can provide forgiveness of sins, provided that the recipient’s heart is properly disposed to receive it.

The Catechism continues to explain that grave illness can be a cause of conversion and an opportunity to return to God for those who have distanced themselves from Him. Since God brings good out of evil, illness can help the sick person discern what is truly important in life and grow in gratitude for the gifts of God.

There is a common misunderstanding that goes something like this: “Vatican II changed the sacrament. It used to be just for people who were actively dying, but now it is for all the sick.” That is not quite right. The sacrament is still administered to those who are dangerously ill. When the rite was revised, it retained this language: “the sacrament of the anointing of the sick is administered to those who are dangerously ill.” This means those who have an illness unto death or extreme frailty of body. What has changed from the older rite is that one need not wait to administer the sacrament until death is immediately imminent. Next month’s column will focus on practical tips on when and how to receive the sacrament.

For further reading, I recommend the book *To Die Is Gain* by Roger W. Nutt, a professor at Ave Maria University. A recent blog post by Fr. Zuhlsdorf, published on August 17, 2026, is also helpful.

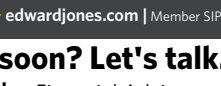
