– A Message from Father Matt Feist –

September 20 is the Feast Day of Saints Andrew Kim Tae-gŏn, Paul Chŏng Ha-sang, and Companions, Martyrs. This feast of the Korean martyrs is genuinely unique because the Catholic Church in Korea wasn't planted by missionaries walking into the country to hand on the faith. It was planted by Koreans themselves.

In the late 1700s, a group of Korean scholars got their hands on Catholic texts brought back from China, started reading, started praying, and decided that this was true. One of them traveled to Beijing and was baptized there in 1784. He then returned home and began baptizing others. By the time an actual ordained priest ever set foot in Korea, the Church had already been alive and growing there for years, entirely through the faith of laypeople.

Today, we celebrate 103 martyrs together in one feast, canonized by Pope John Paul II in Seoul in 1984 – the first canonization ceremony ever held outside Rome. Among them are three bishops and eight priests, but most were ordinary laypeople: farmers, mothers, teenagers, elderly grandparents, married and unmarried.

St. Andrew Kim Tae-gŏn, Korea's first native-born priest, guided missionaries into the country and shepherded a hidden, hunted flock before being beheaded in 1846 at just 25 years old. St. Paul Chŏng Ha-sang, a brilliant lay apostle, tirelessly petitioned Rome for priests and held communities together through persecution before he, too, was martyred. Between roughly 1839 and 1866, waves of brutal persecution swept through the country, and these men and women were beaten, starved, exiled, and executed rather than renounce Christ.

So what does their example ask of us today?

Own your faith instead of outsourcing it. These communities studied and believed before a priest ever arrived. Don't wait for someone else to hand you a fully formed faith. Read Scripture, ask questions, and wrestle with what you believe and why.

Build faith into hidden, unglamorous places. These believers met in secret homes with no fanfare. Most of us won't face that kind of danger, but we can still ask: Does my faith show up in the ordinary corners of my week – in the dinner table conversation, with a struggling coworker, or in a quiet prayer before bed?

Share it informally. St. Paul spent his life teaching and organizing. You don't need a title to do the same. Answer your child's questions honestly, invite a friend back to church, and build community wherever you are.

Stay faithful when it costs you something. Few of us face torture, but we do face smaller costs: standing by an unpopular conviction, admitting what we believe, or choosing to live differently because of our faith. Practice faithfulness in small things, and you build the strength for bigger ones.

Pray for persecuted Christians today. This isn't ancient history. Many Christians still face real danger for their faith right now.

None of these martyrs set out to be saints. They simply kept choosing faithfulness, one ordinary day at a time, until it cost them everything.

Based on Dante's writings, the seven deadly sins correspond to the seven stories of Dante's Mount Purgatory. The seven sins are presented as patterns of dysfunction within us that lead to unhappiness. Bishop Barron shows us how to counteract these sinful patterns through a conscious process of opposition, known as the "seven lively virtues." 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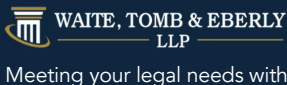
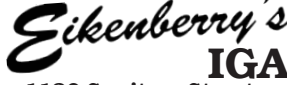
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
