# **SCHOOL RULES**

- 1) School attendance is compulsory. In case of absenteeism, parents should submit an excuse to the principal per letter or telephonically.
- 2) Appointments should not be made for learners during school hours.
- 3) Should a learner be deemed medically unfit to partake in any sport activities, a medical certificate should be handed in at the school.
- 4) No jewelry, outlandish hairstyles, colour nailpolish, make-up or chewing-gum is allowed at school or during extra-mural activities and sport events. Learners may colour their hair one shade lighter/darker than the learner's natural colour. Should this rule be overstepped, it will be expected that the learner have his hair returned to its natural colour immediately. Should a learner break this rule twice, it will be regarded as being done on purpose which would be a serious transgression in terms of the Disciplinary code and further disciplinary steps will be taken against the learner.
- 5) Learners may not receive phone calls during lessons. Only messages in exceptional circumstances will be passed on to learners during school hours.
- 6) Learners who stay in school uniform after school must wear the full uniform.
- 7) No learner may smoke on the school terrain or in the school buildings. Alcoholic beverages and other substances are prohibited. Any transgression of this rule could lead to immediate expulsion.
- 8) No school property or any other item at school which belongs to anyone else, may be damaged or disfigured in any way.
- 9) No learner may drive or park any vehicle on the school grounds without prior permission from the principal.
- 10) No learner may in any way demean or endanger any other learner in any way.
- 11) No learner may be in a classroom during break or after school without permission from a staff member.
- 12) The foyer leading to the office may not be used by learners unless accompanied by their parents or when arranged by principal.
- 13) No learner is to use the cloakroom between periods without permission.
- 14) Learners are not allowed to walk over the lawn in front of the staffroom.
- 15) Learners' behaviour in and on the sportfield should be exemplary at all times and good sportsmanship should prevail.
- 16) AT NO TIME MAY ANY LEARNER BRING THE SCHOOL'S NAME INTO DISREPUTE.
