Stage	Card Name	Core Conditional Meaning	Interpretation
W1	Seed	Intention & preparation	Set a new intention or direction; conditions are not ready yet.
W2	Sprout	Small start, slight change	Take the first small step; courage for a modest beginning is required.
W3	Root	Foundation & inner grounding	Strengthening your base is essential; impatience will block progress.
W4	Pruning	Removing the unnecessary	Cleaning up, eliminating distractions, and focusing on essentials are required.
W5	Leaf	Communication & outward reach	Expanding communication, networking, and visibility is the necessary condition.
W6	Sunlight	External recognition	Support, attention, or improved reputation is required; PR/visibility needed.
W7	Wind	Change & flexibility	You must accept change, adapt, and shift direction; stubbornness will block success.
W8	Growth Rings	Maturity & accumulation	Time accumulation, consistent experience, and repetition are key conditions.
W9	Forest	Expansion & network	Collaboration, resource expansion, and people connections are required.
W10	Harvest	Completion & closure	Finish unfinished tasks; results require closure and consolidation.

Stage	Card Name	Core Conditional Meaning	Interpretation
