Project Title: Development and Deployment of a Community Outreach & HIV Screening Digital Tool

Purpose & Background

Proposals are invited from qualified technology vendors and developers to design, deploy, and support a comprehensive **Digital Tool for Household Screening and Community Outreach**. The core objective of this digital system is to empower field workers to identify children at risk of HIV and other social ills, seamlessly manage health facility referrals, and track the successful completion of HIV testing referrals.

Core Functional & Technical Requirements

The proposed software solution must natively support the following capabilities:

- **Household Vulnerability Assessments:** Configurable digital screening forms.
- **Referral Tracking System:** Closed-loop monitoring to confirm successful facility testing outcomes.
- **100% Offline Capability:** Full operational data entry in remote areas with secure, automated data synchronization upon reconnection.
- **Automated Geolocation Capture:** Passive GPS logging during household community visits.
- **Real-Time Monitoring Dashboard:** Web-based supervisor portal for field worker tracking and activity mapping.
- **Reporting Engine:** Automated compilation and daily data export capabilities (CSV, Excel, or API).

Submission Requirements

Interested vendors must submit a comprehensive response containing:

2. **Technical Proposal:** Explicit breakdown of offline syncing, GPS tracking mechanics, and dashboard layout.
