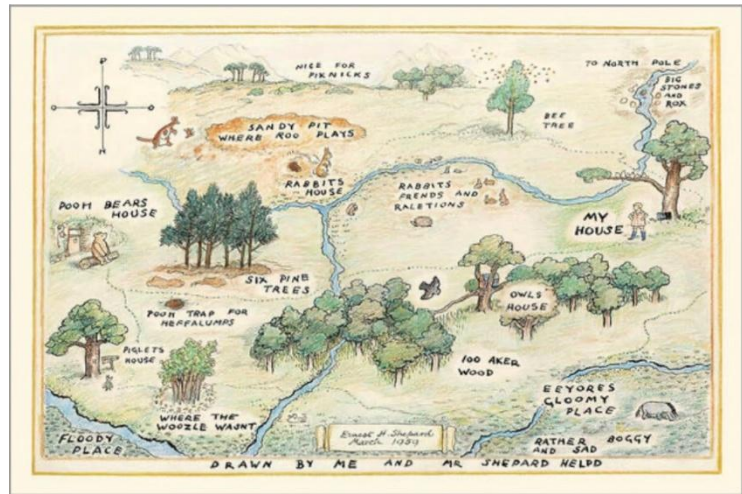

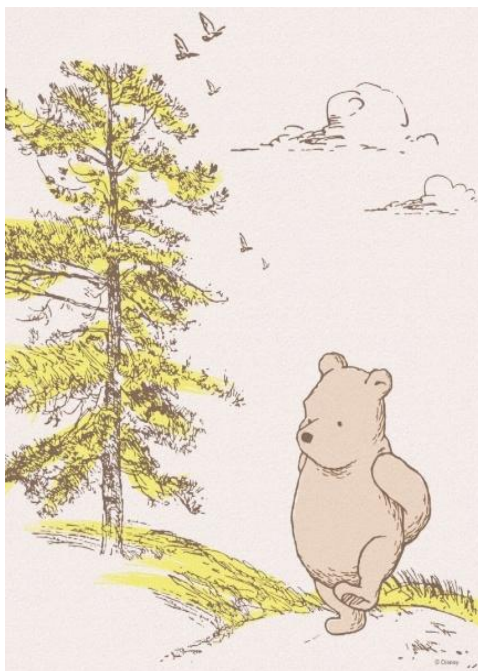

Crossroads at Big Creek

Check out "The Bears and The Bees". Stop in at the 200-acre nature preserve and learning center with distinct ecosystems to explore, and miles of trails for hiking, skiing, birding, nature study. Visit the hands-on displays about bees and black bear! Then walk along the accessible Pooh Storybook Walk & Activity Trail.

The Ridges Sanctuary

Visit the 1700-acre National Natural Landmark and follow the Pooh Storybook Walk. Passes available at local libraries. The Ridges is Wisconsin's first Land Trust property famous for its rare ridge-and-swale landscape, native orchids and diverse boreal forest.

Door County Land Trust

Enjoy dozens of hiking trails across the Peninsula. The Land Trust protects 10,600 acres of land and water in Door County. Visitors enjoy peaceful, diverse landscapes featuring tranquil dunes, wildflowers, and sweeping views of Lake Michigan and local bays. Hikers and nature lovers rate the preserves highly for the quiet, well-maintained trails and great wildlife viewing opportunities.

Woodwalk Gallery

Wander the trails of Woodwalk's 10 acres of field, gardens and woods and enjoy the wide-open rural landscape and the rustic barn, outdoor art and art gallery.

Write On, Door County

Roam 59 acres of nature and a writing center perfect for writers and readers. Pick up a copy of Winnie the Pooh Hike & Write Booklet inside and wander along the trails that surround Write On, Door County.

29 State Natural Areas

Most State Natural Areas lack restrooms, drinking water, or picnic tables.

Trails: Walking paths are usually primitive footpaths or unpaved dirt trails.

Activities: They are ideal for quiet activities like hiking, bird watching, and nature study. Door County had Wisconsin's first established Natural Area in 1953.
