BOARDING TIME

Your boat will normally be ready to board at 2.00pm on the hire start date. You must return your boat to the boatyard with all its gear and equipment in good order by 9.00am on your final day of hire.

WHAT WILL IT COST?

In addition to the basic hire charge you should also budget for the following:

SECURITY AND FUEL DEPOSIT

Your boat is fully insured but we have to ask you to be responsible for the first part of any damage or loss, either to the boat, its equipment or to any third party. You will be requested to pay a combined security and fuel deposit of £100 (please note that in the case of all male/female parties an additional deposit of £10 per person will be required). This item will be shown on your hire invoice.

At the end of your holiday, the deposit will be refunded to you less the value of the fuel you have used. Should you have been unfortunate enough to experience loss or damage to the boat or its equipment, the cost of repairs/replacement will also be deducted up to a maximum of the deposit. Should the damage/loss figure exceed the deposit, the fuel used will be charged separately.

Alternatively, you may wish to take advantage of our indemnity waiver for a payment of £18 (non refundable) in which case you will incur no additional penalty in the event of loss or damage to the boat or its equipment (this scheme is not available to all male/female parties). Should you wish to take up this offer, a separate £50 fuel deposit will apply.

Often ten gallons of fuel will cover a weeks cruise.

1. HIRE TERMS

ALL TERMS ARE QUOTED IN £ STERLING PER WEEK FOR THE BOAT, EQUIPPED AS DESCRIBED UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED. AS SOON AS THE BOOKING IS MADE BY YOU AND CONFIRMED BY US, THE HIRE TERMS ARE GUARANTEED.

2. V.A.T.

HIRE TERMS INCLUDE V.A.T. AT 17 1/2% BUT THEY ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGES

3. EXTRA PERSONS

THE NUMBER OF PERSONS INDICATED FOR EACH BOAT MUST NOT BE EXCEEDED, ALTHOUGH SOME BOAT LAYOUTS SHOW EXTRA BERTHS, THESE ONLY INDICATE DIFFERENT CONFIGURATIONS AVAILABLE.

4. OPTIONAL EXTRAS

OPTIONAL EXTRAS SUCH AS DINGHIES, ETC. MAY BE AVAILABLE AT EXTRA CHARGE AS STATED IN THE BROCHURE BUT ARE SUBJECT TO AVAILABILITY ON YOUR HIRE START DATE.

5. PETS

6. INITIAL PAYMENT

IN ALL CASES OF CANCELLATION THE DEPOSIT IS FORFEITED. WE WILL ENDEAVOUR TO RE-LET THE BOAT, BUT UNLESS SUCH A RE-LET IS OBTAINED YOU WILL REMAIN RESPONSIBLE FOR THE PAYMENT OF THE BALANCE OF HIRE.

9. NON-ARRIVAL

IF YOU DO NOT ARRIVE AT THE BOATYARD BY MIDDAY ON THE DAY FOLLOWING YOUR HIRE START DATE, AND YOU HAVE NOT ADVISED US THAT YOU WILL BE LATE, WE SHALL BE ENTITLED TO PLACE THE BOAT FOR RE-LET FORTHWITH.

UNDER THE FOREGOING CIRCUMSTANCES AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH CONDITIONS ABOVE, IF THE BOAT IS NOT RE-LET YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE BALANCE OF HIRE; OR IF THE BOAT IS RE-LET FOR ONLY PART OF THE PERIOD OF HIRE, YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE REMAINING PORTION OF THE BALANCE OF HIRE.

10. BOARDING OF BOAT

UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN THE BROCHURE, THE NORMAL TIME FOR BOARDING THE BOAT IS 2 PM ON THE HIRE START DATE. YOUR BOAT MAY BE AVAILABLE EARLIER (OR LATER SUBJECT TO CIRCUMSTANCES BEYOND OUR CONTROL)

MOTOR CRUISERS ARE LET ON THE UNDERSTANDING THAT WE WILL GIVE YOU A TRIAL RUN TO EXPLAIN THE CONTROLS OF THE BOAT AND ITS EQUIPMENT, AFTER WHICH YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE BOAT.

IF WE ARE PREVENTED BY CIRCUMSTANCES BEYOND OUR CONTROL FROM MAKING THE BOAT AVAILABLE AND CANNOT PROVIDE A SUITABLE ALTERNATIVE, WE WILL REFUND ALL

MONIES PAID BY YOU BUT NO FURTHER LIABILITY WILL BE ACCEPTED.

11. RETURN OF BOAT

UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN THE BROCHURE YOU MUST RETURN THE BOAT (INCLUDING ALL ITS GEAR AND EQUIPMENT) IN A CLEAN AND TIDY CONDITION TO US AT THE BOATYARD WHERE IT WAS HIRED BY 9 AM. ON THE FINAL DAY OF HIRE. A CHARGE WILL BE MADE IF THE BOAT IS NOT RETURNED ON TIME OR IF IT IS NOT RETURNED IN A CLEAN AND TIDY CONDITION.

12. MINORS

BOOKING FROM PERSONS AGED UNDER 18 YEARS CANNOT BE ACCEPTED.

13. UNSUITABLE HIRERS

WE RESERVE THE RIGHT TO DECLINE TO ACCEPT A BOOKING OR TO REFUSE TO HAND OVER A BOAT TO ANY PERSON WHO IN OUR OPINION IS NOT SUITABLE TO TAKE CHARGE ON THE GROUNDS OF AGE, ILL-HEALTH, DISABILITY, INEXPERIENCE OR ANY OTHER REASON. WHEN, IN OUR OPINION, TO DO SO WOULD LEAD TO A SERIOUS RISK OF ACCIDENT OR DAMAGE. IN SUCH CASES, THE HIRE TERMS PAID SHALL BE REFUNDED IN FULL AND THE CONTRACT SHALL BE DISCHARGED WITHOUT FURTHER LIABILITY ON EITHER PARTY.

WE RESERVE THE RIGHT TO REPOSSESS THE BOAT AT ANY TIME WHERE A SERIOUS ACCIDENT OR DAMAGE HAS OCCURED OR IN OUR OPINION IS LIKELY TO OCCUR BECAUSE OF THE UNSUITABILITY OF THE HIRER DUE TO AGE, ILL-HEALTH, DISABILITY, INEXPERIENCE OR ANY OTHER REASON. IN SUCH CASES, WE SHALL NOT BE LIABLE TO MAKE A REFUND OF ANY PORTION OF THE HIRE TERMS PAID.

14. HIRER'S EQUIPMENT

YOU MAY NOT TAKE ON THE BOAT: PORTABLE HEATERS OF ANY TYPE, LIGHTING EQUIPMENT, T.V. SETS OR ANY OTHER ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT OR ANYTHING WHICH MAY CAUSE DANGER TO THE BOAT, ITS EQUIPMENT OR ITS OCCUPANTS.

15. SECURITY AND FUEL DEPOSIT

YOU WILL BE REQUIRED TO PAY A COMBINED FUEL AND SECURITY DEPOSIT OF £100 AT THE TIME OF PAYING YOUR BALANCE OF HIRE, THE AMOUNT BEING SHOWN ON YOUR INVOICE AS "SECURITY AND FUEL DEPOSIT". (ALL MALE/FEMALE PARTIES WILL BE CHARGED AN ADDITIONAL DEPOSIT OF £10 PER PERSON).

AT THE END OF YOUR CRUISE, THE VALUE OF THE FUEL YOU HAVE USED WILL BE DEDUCTED FROM THIS AMOUNT. ANY DAMAGE OR LOSS TO THE BOAT OR ITS EQUIPMENT WHICH IS IN EXCESS OF THE RETURNABLE DEPOSIT, WILL NOT INCUR ANY EXTRA CHARGE. HOWEVER, IN THIS INSTANCE, FUEL USED WILL BE CHARGED AS A SEPARATE ITEM.

16. INDEMNITY WAIVER

A SECURITY WAIVER OF £18 IS AVAILABLE (EXCEPT IN THE CASE OF ALL MALE/FEMALE PARTIES). IN THIS INSTANCE, THE MONEY IS NOT REFUNDABLE BUT YOU WILL NOT INCUR ANY ADDITIONAL PENALTY AS A RESULT OF DAMAGE TO THE BOAT OR LOSS/DAMAGE OF ITS EQUIPMENT.

SHOULD YOU CHOOSE TO TAKE UP THIS OFFER, A FUEL DEPOSIT OF £50 WILL APPLY, WHICH WILL BE REFUNDABLE AT THE END OF YOUR HOLIDAY AFTER DEDUCTING THE VALUE OF THE FUEL YOU HAVE USED.

17. INJURY OR DAMAGE TO YOU OR YOUR PROPERTY

WE ARE NOT LIABLE FOR DEATH, PERSONAL INJURY, OR LOSS OR DAMAGE TO YOUR PROPERTY OR THAT OF ANY PASSENGERS UNLESS IT IS CAUSED BY OUR NEGLIGENCE OR WILFUL DEFAULT. YOUR VEHICLES AND THEIR ACCESSORIES AND CONTENTS ARE LEFT AT YOUR RISK. WE WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR LOSS OR DAMAGE THEREON OR THERETO FROM ANY CAUSE WHATSOEVER EXCEPT THROUGH OUR NEGLIGENCE.

ON NO ACCOUNT MAY YOU:

- TOW OTHER CRUISERS
- CRUISE AFTER DARK (YOUR BOAT IS NOT EQUIPPED OR INSURED FOR NIGHT NAVIGATION)
- PERMIT YOUR BOAT TO BE TAKEN OUT TO SEA
- PERMIT YOUR BOAT TO TAKE PART IN ANY RACE

YOU MUST NAVIGATE IN ACCORDANCE WITH CURRENT BYE LAWS AND MUST OBSERVE THE SPEED LIMITS APPLICABLE TO THE WATERWAY.

ON THE NORFOLK BROADS NO BOATS MAY BE TAKEN BELOW HAVEN BRIDGE, GREAT YARMOUTH, OR THROUGH THE LOCK AT OULTON BROAD. NAVIGATIONAL LIMITS ARE CLEARLY MARKED ON THE WATERWAYS AND MORE DETAILED INFORMATION WILL BE PROVIDED AT THE BOATYARD.

19. ACCIDENTS

YOU HAVE CHARGE OF THE BOAT AND ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ITS SAFE NAVIGATION. NO MINOR MAY CONTROL THE BOAT WITHOUT THE SUPERVISION OF AN EXPERIENCED ADULT. IN THE CASE OF ANY ACCIDENT OR DAMAGE TO THE BOAT OR TO OTHER CRAFT OR TO WATERWAY PROPERTY, IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO:

- FIND OUT THE NAME OF ANY BOAT INVOLVED TOGETHER WITH THE NAMES OF ITS OWNER AND HIRER, AND
- REPORT THESE FACTS TO US TOGETHER WITH FULL DETAILS OF THE DAMAGE AS SOON AS POSSIBLE. NO REPAIRS MAY BE PUT IN HAND WITHOUT OUR CONSENT. YOU WILL BE REQUIRED TO COMPLETE AN ACCIDENT FORM ON YOUR RETURN TO YOUR BOATYARD.

20. LOSS OF WATER

YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY CHARGE MADE BY WATERWAYS AUTHORITIES IN RESPECT OF LOSS OF WATER OR DAMAGE TO WATERWAY PROPERTY CAUSED BY YOU WHILE IN CHARGE OF THE BOAT.

21. BOAT DELAYS OR CURTAILMENT

EVERY BOAT IS CHECKED BEFORE THE START OF EACH HIRE CRUISE SO IT IS UNLIKELY THAT YOUR BOAT WILL SUFFER A MECHANICAL BREAKDOWN. IF A BREAKDOWN OF ANY KIND SHOULD OCCUR, YOU MUST REPORT IT TO US IMMEDIATELY SO THAT STEPS CAN BE TAKEN TO REPAIR IT AND ENABLE YOU TO RESUME YOUR CRUISE.

PROVIDED THAT WE ARE SO INFORMED, WE WILL TAKE STEPS TO REPAIR THE BOAT AND/OR ITS EQUIPMENT AS SPEEDILY AS PRACTICABLE IN THE CIRCUMSTANCES. APART FROM THE ABOVE OBLIGATIONS, WE SHALL NOT BE LIABLE WHATSOEVER IN RESPECT OF ANY DIRECT OR CONSEQUENTIAL LOSS OR DAMAGE THAT YOU MAY SUFFER WHETHER FINANCIAL OR OTHERWISE, AS A RESULT OF SUCH BREAKDOWN.

WE SHALL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE CONSEQUENCES OF DELAYS OR RESTRICTIONS OF CRUISING ARISING FROM WEATHER, OBSTRUCTIONS, REPAIRS OR DAMAGE TO NAVIGATION WORKS, FLOODING, SHORTAGE OF WATER, INDUSTRIAL ACTION, FUEL RATIONING, SHORTAGE OF OR NON-AVAILABILITY OF FUEL, OR OTHER CAUSE. AND WE RESERVE THE RIGHT TO RESTRICT CRUISING IF UNUSUAL OR HAZARDOUS CONDITIONS PREVAIL.

22. SATISFACTION

WE ARE MOST ANXIOUS THAT YOU ARE COMPLETELY SATISFIED WITH YOUR BOAT. ITS EQUIPMENT AND CLEANLINESS WHEN YOU START YOUR HOLIDAY. YOU WILL BE ASKED TO SIGN A SATISFACTION NOTE CONFIRMING YOUR BOAT IS CLEAN AND PROPERLY EQUIPPED AT THE TIME OF TAKE-OVER (YOU SHOULD NOT SIGN THIS NOTE UNTIL YOU HAVE CHECKED YOUR BOAT ACCORDINGLY). ANY SHORTCOMINGS MUST BE NOTIFIED TO US IMMEDIATELY THEY ARE DISCOVERED. WE CANNOT CONSIDER ANY CLAIM FOR SHORTCOMINGS UNLESS WE HAVE BEEN SO NOTIFIED. FAILURE TO DO SO MAY RENDER YOU LIABLE FOR PAYMENT IN ACCORDANCE WITH CONDITION 15.

23. MODIFICATIONS AND DESCRIPTIONS

EVERY EFFORT HAS BEEN MADE TO ENSURE THAT INDIVIDUAL BOAT DESCRIPTIONS AND PLANS CONTAINED IN THE BROCHURE ARE CORRECT. HOWEVER, THE RIGHT IS RESERVED TO MAKE MODIFICATIONS TO BOAT SPECIFICATIONS THAT ARE CONSIDERED NECESSARY IN THE LIGHT OF OPERATING REQUIREMENTS. LAYOUT PLANS IN THE BROCHURE ARE FOR GENERAL GUIDANCE AND ARE NOT TO SCALE. ILLUSTRATIONS OF STANDARD PRODUCTION BUILT BOATS ARE SOMETIMES USED AND THE EXTERIOR COLOUR SCHEME OF YOUR BOAT MAY THEREFORE NOT BE IDENTICAL WITH THE ONE IN THE BROCHURE.

24. DISPUTES

ANY DISPUTE, DIFFERENCE OR QUESTION WHICH MAY AT ANY TIME ARISE OUT OF THE CONTRACT OR THE SUBJECT MATTER THEREOF SHALL BE REFERRED TO A SINGLE ARBITRATOR TO BE AGREED UPON BETWEEN THE PARTIES (OR FAILING AGREEMENT TO BE NOMINATED BY THE PRESIDENT FOR THE TIME BEING OF THE LAW SOCIETY ON THE APPLICATION OF EITHER PARTY). IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISION OF THE ARBITRATION ACT, 1950, OR ANY STATUTORY MODIFICATIONS OR RE-ENACTMENT THEREOF FOR THE TIME BEING IN FORCE.
