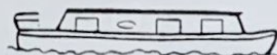

MONMOUTH AND BRECON CANAL



Our base at Llangynidr is alongside the B4558, easily accessible from the A40 or via the B4560 from the Heads of the Valleys road (A465).

CANAL CRUISING IS EASY



The 33 mile long Monmouth and Brecon Canal has only six locks, and runs from the market town of Brecon down to Pontypool, entirely within the Brecon Beacons National Park. The rural towns and villages along the way contain castles, museums, churches and interesting shopping opportunities. Other leisure activities within easy reach of the canal include pony trekking, golf, fishing, climbing and sailing. Wonderful walks abound along the entire length of the canal, with many country pubs and restaurants offering refreshment and excellent hospitality.

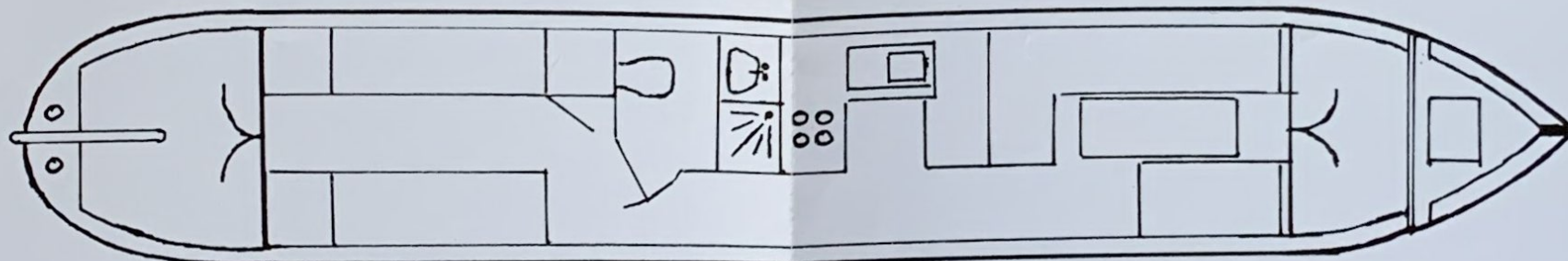
This canal is never crowded, being isolated from the main system. Few private boats visit us. Even in peak season you can travel for hours without seeing another boat. The canal is shallow and twisty. You will need a week to cruise it all.



country class

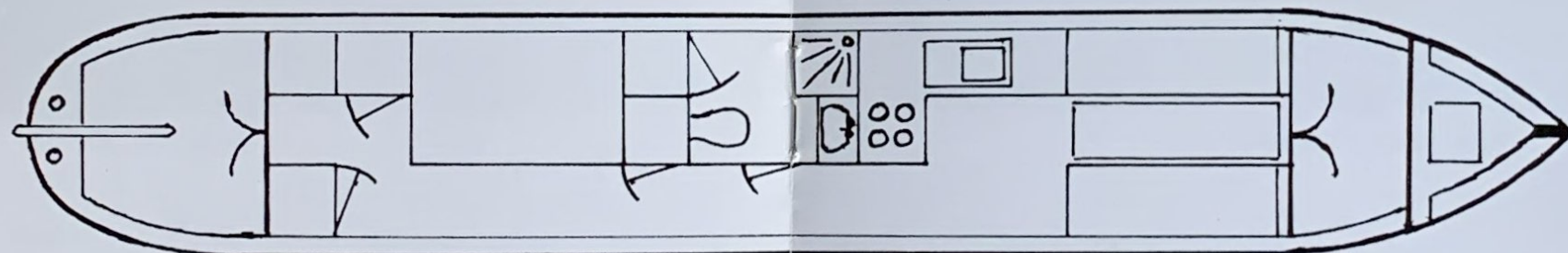

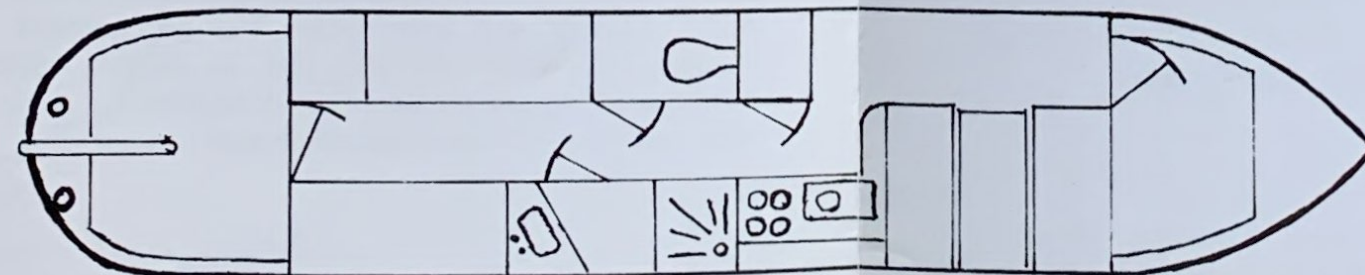
45 foot. 6 Berth. 1 Double in Lounge. 4 Bunks in aft Cabin.

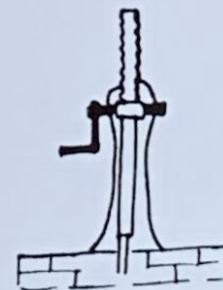
CANAL CRUISING IS PLEASURE

Diesel, Gas and Car Parking are provided free of charge. Car Parking is at the owner's risk.

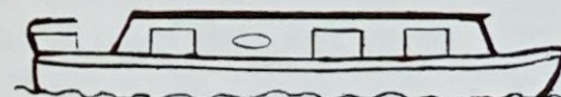
Boats are available from 2 p.m. on your day of arrival. Your boat has to be vacated by 10 a.m. on your last day.
