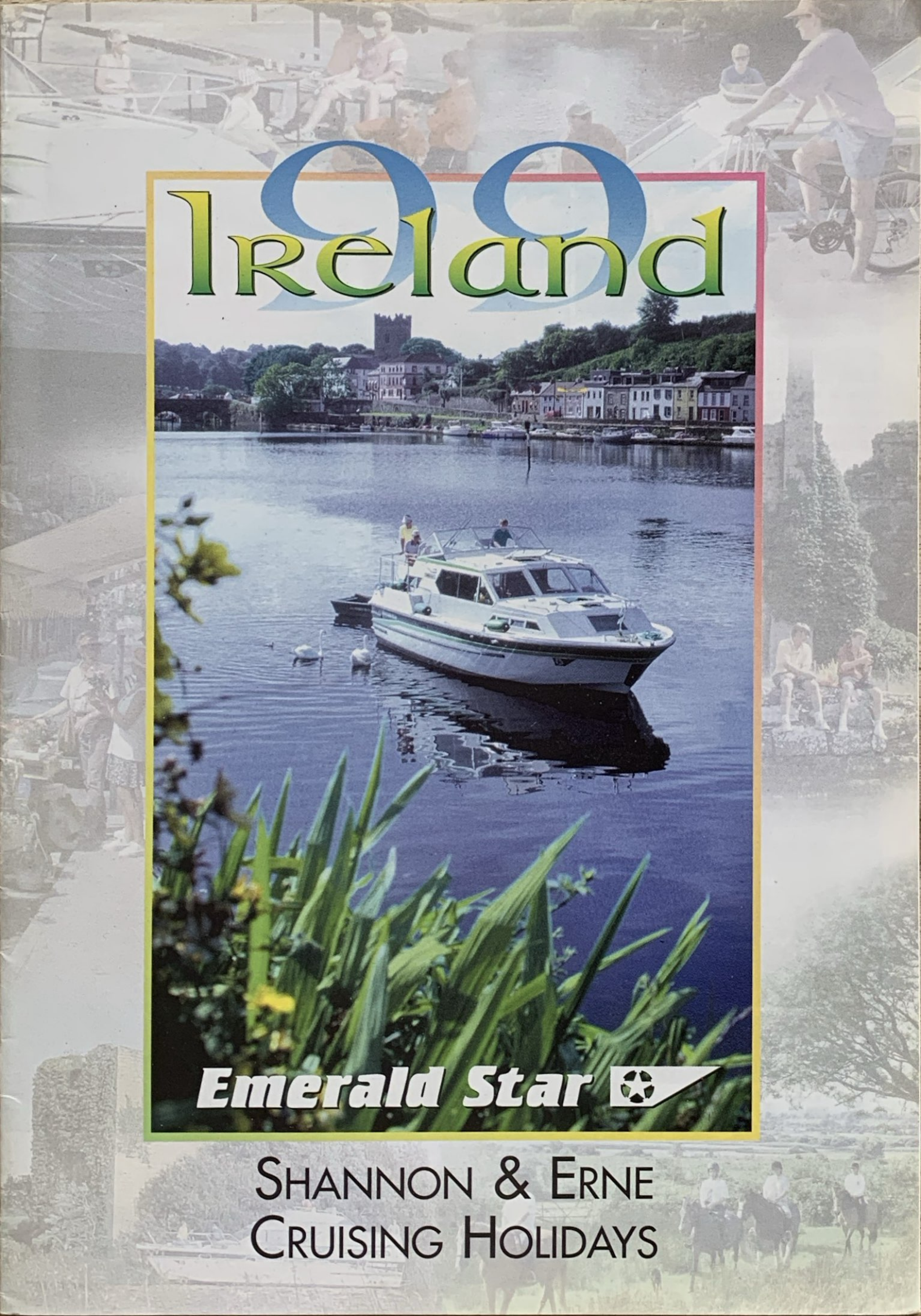
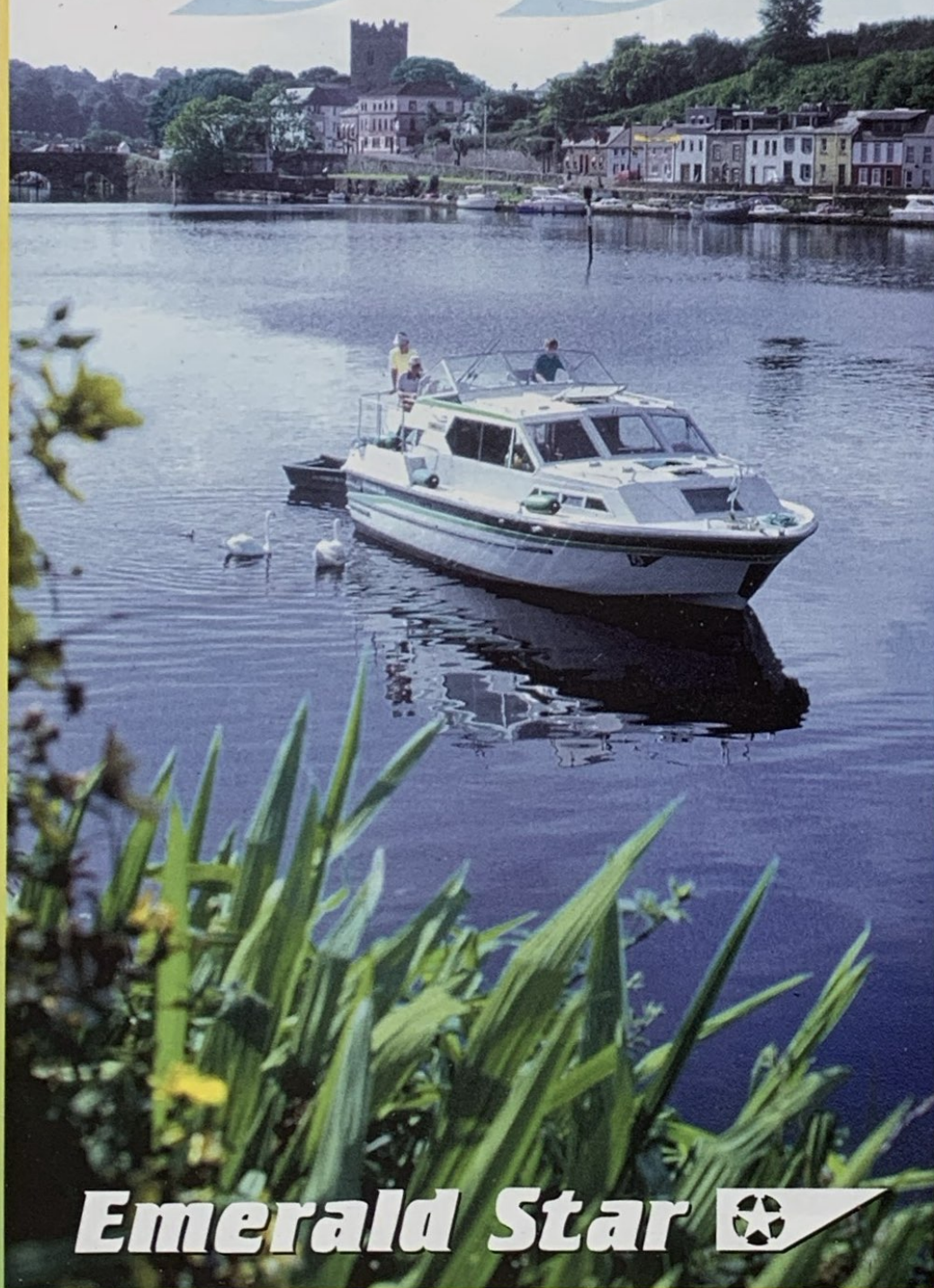

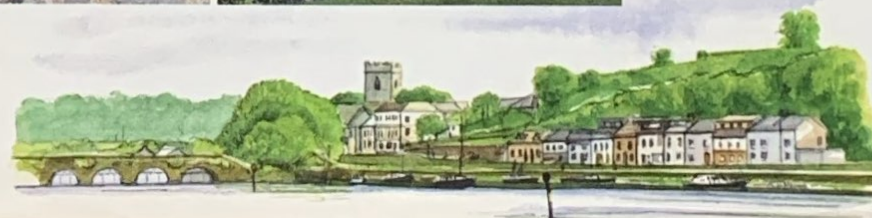

With the restoration of the 40 mile link between the Shannon and the Erne in 1994, Ireland's two great waterways have been joined to form a magnificent chain of lakes and rivers stretching from Beleek in County Fermanagh to Killaloe in County Clare - an awesome distance of almost 300 miles! No other country in Europe can offer such a vast expanse of waterway dedicated solely to boating and fishing, and flowing always slowly through undisturbed peacefulness and quiet.

So much to do

There is freedom to go where you please, when you please. Freedom from timetables, traffic and telephones. No more packing and unpacking as you travel in your holiday cruiser to small friendly villages - just peace and space and the long western evenings.

So many places

New Cruising Water

Emerald Star's newest cruiser station is situated on the river Erne in Belturbet, County Cavan where the cruising waters are markedly different to the River Shannon. From here you cruise directly into the wonderful maze of channels which forms Upper Lough Erne. About one fifth of the lough is made up of islands and there are many tranquil moorings and excellent fishing.

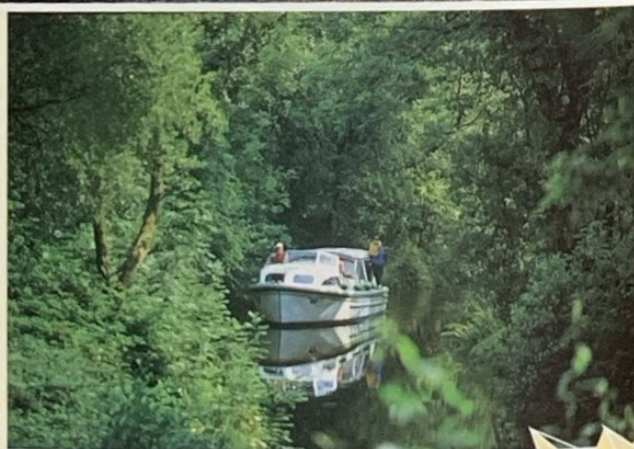
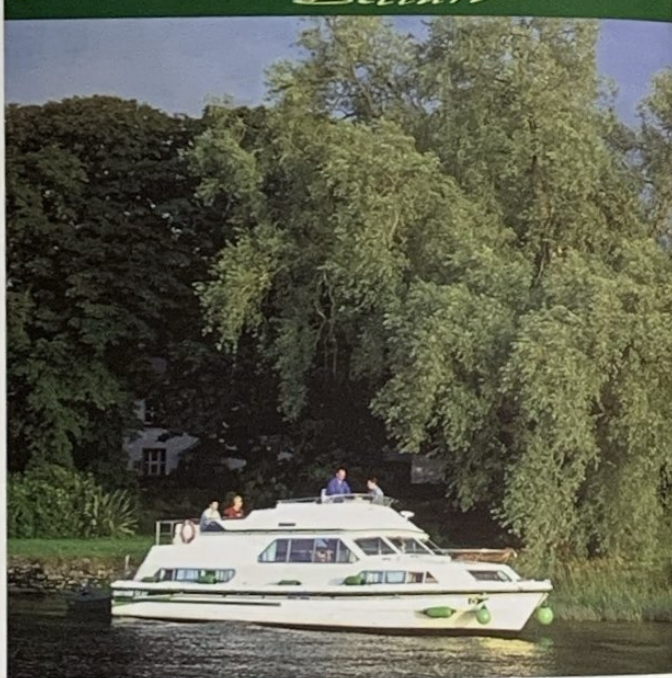
A four hour cruise takes you to Enniskillen and to the Lower Lake which is a magnificent and almost unused stretch of water reaching down to Belleek.

There are spectacular coastlines and several short walks to scenic viewing points. Places of outstanding interest are the Marble Arch Caves, the stately Florencecourt, Castle Coole, Cram Estate, and the Belleek Pottery.

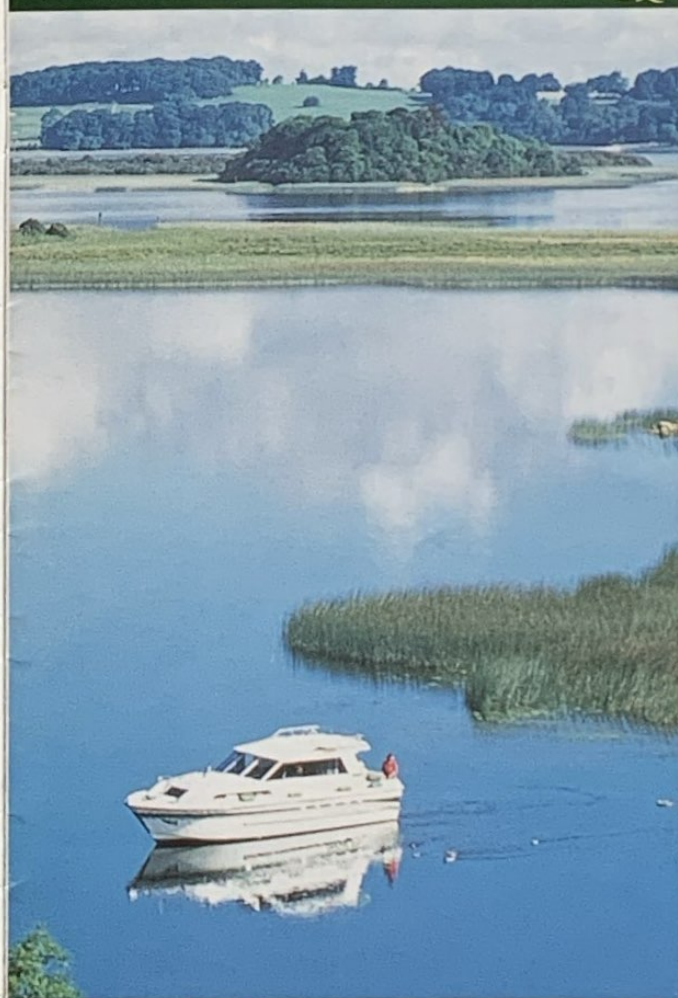
Shannon-Erne Waterway

Alternatively you can discover the newly restored Shannon-Erne waterway along the gently winding Woodford River. See the sensitive restoration of beautiful old bridges, and of the original stonework of the locks among the slow waters and the long low hills of this little known countryside. The fairytale lakes of Coologe, Derrycassan, Ballymagauran and Garadice await you.

The Shannon Source

The upper reaches of the Shannon are formed by the junction of the River Boyle and the River Shannon. These two rivers meet just north of Carrick-on-Shannon and you can cruise right up to their sources in Lough Key and through the narrow tree lined canal to Lough Allen.

A short cruise on the upper river takes you also to Leitrim village and entry to the locks leading into the new Shannon-Erne system.

Choices

The choices of cruising waters around Carrick-on-Shannon are extremely varied and its particular appeal lies in the large number of moorings and villages, all within short cruising distances of each other. Places to visit include the Forest Park in Lough Key, and in nearby Boyle the 12th century Cistercian Abbey and the recently restored 17th century King Town House.

Downstream lies the water wonderland of winding rivers and lakes, as the Shannon grows in size on its slow path southwards. You will discover the mysterious reed beds and channels in Carnadoe, Kilglass, and Grange. Lough Ree too, is within cruising distance, and offers a variety of channels such as westward to Lecarrow and Hodson Bay or eastward into the Inny River and the sheltered lakes of Coosan and Killenure.

Largest Lake

Portumna is situated at the uppermost point of Lough Derg, the largest of the Shannon Lakes, and like our other cruiser stations it offers a choice of dramatically different cruising waters.

Immediately south are the wide expanses of Lough Derg, 22 miles long and 10 miles across at its widest point. Along the shores of this magnificent lake are some of the loveliest moorings of any comparable waterway anywhere. The lake shore is wonderfully scenic, and Killaloe at the foot of the lake is reached through beautiful scenery as the hills close in on the narrowing lough.

River

By contrast, upstream of Portumna the mature Shannon is wide and calm flowing through reedy river banks with browsing cattle on its shore. Shannon harbour was once the busy terminus for the Grand Canal, and the River Suck will soon be navigable all the way to Ballinasloe.

And so to Clonmacnois. Nobody should miss the opportunity to visit the ruins of this monastic city founded in 545 A.D., and famed for its learning all across medieval Europe.

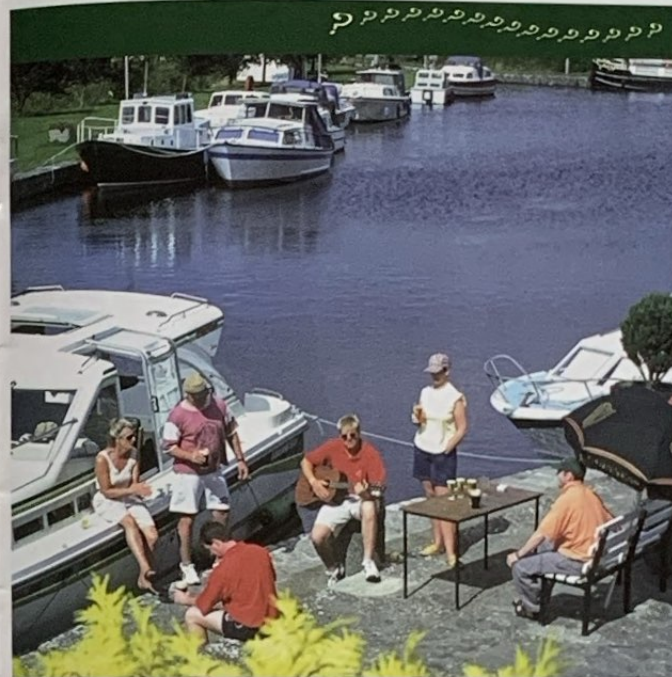

Is experience necessary

No, and no license is required either. However Emerald Star line is very conscious of the wishes of its hirers to be properly instructed and so in advance of your cruise we give you your own "Holiday Guide".

Do I get any training

On arrival you view our instructional video. Then you are given a personal tuition on board your cruiser, - a good time to ask all the questions!

What clothes should I bring

Everyone should have rope soled or non-slip shoes for safety on slippery decks. Don't forget light wetgear. Bring sunglasses to protect against reflected light from the water.

Can I bring electrical equipment

No.

How far can I travel in a day

We suggest that 4 to 5 hours cruising per day is enough for most hirers. This also is a very suitable length of time for recharging the boat's batteries and heating the domestic water. Cruising after dark is not permitted.

How do I operate the locks

You do not have to operate the Shannon locks as this is done by the Shannon Navigation Authority lock-keepers who charge a fee of £1.20 per passage. Lock hours are shown in your Captain's Handbook. For the Shannon-erne link you buy a cheap "smart card" at reception and this operates the electronic locks for you.

What about water, fuel and gas

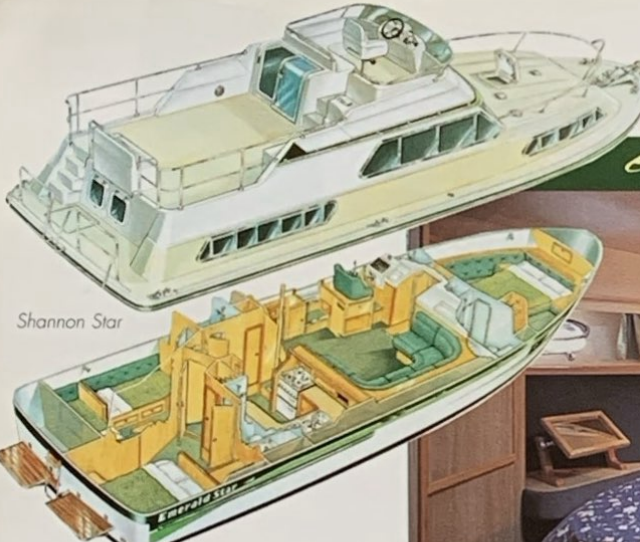
Water tanks hold between 400 and 900 litres depending on the size of cruiser, and these are full before you leave. Top up regularly. Diesel tanks hold between 160 and 270 litres, and this is usually sufficient for up to 25 hours cruising. Gas is supplied from a full large gas bottle, and we provide a reserve bottle as well.

Where can I moor

Every village has its own moorings, often very extensive. There are also moorings above and below locks. All moorings are free of charge.

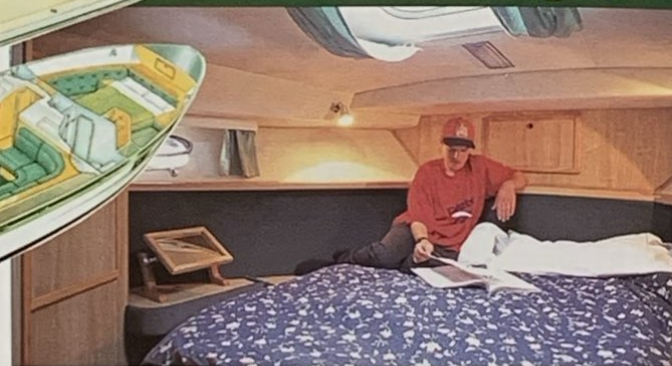
What about insurance of the boat

You are liable for any loss or damage to the cruiser and to third parties but only to the full extent of the refundable security deposit which you pay on arrival. If however you pay a non refundable boat damage waiver on arrival you are exempted from liability for damage to the cruiser and its dinghy.

Our Cruiser Fleet



What you find on board

We have 10 classes of cruisers, and each has a different layout. Choose the cruiser which best suits your needs after examining the interior layout plan accompanying each boat.

All our cruisers are thoroughly serviced at turn-around and are ready for you with full supplies of water, fuel and gas. All the linen is changed, and the boats are cleaned and inspected before handover to you.

Sleeping Accommodation. The figure and symbol (6) represents the number of full adult berths on board, maximum 2 per cabin. When there is an additional figure (+1) this represents a child's berth, or an additional berth in a cabin.

Domestic Equipment. All our cruisers have H/C water, electric lighting and refrigerator, gas cooker with oven/grill, 220v shaver socket, shower, central heating and cleaning equipment.

Bed Linen. All bedding including sheets, u/blankets, blankets (or duvets), pillows, pillowcases, hand towels.

Galley. Fully equipped with cutlery, crockery, glassware and cooking utensils.

Marine Equipment. Adult lifejackets (childrens on request), lifebuoys, dinghy. All necessary ropes, fenders, first-aid, fire extinguisher, fire blanket, boarding ladder, fend-off, anchor and chain. Detailed navigation maps, radio and binoculars.

Telephone. Direct Boat to Base link for use in emergencies.

Diesel/Water/Gas. Full diesel tank adequate for 25 hours of cruising. Full large capacity water tank. Full and reserve gas bottle.

Showers. These are shown by the symbol and are usually situated in the washrooms with hand-basin and toilet.

Boarding Ladders. All cruisers have boarding ladders permanently fitted aft.

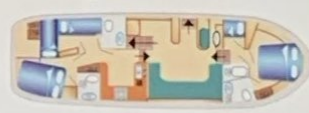

Hire Conditions (SUMMARY)

All bookings whether made directly with Emerald Star Line or through Travel Agencies, are subject to our Conditions of Hire.

These are printed in your Captain's Handbook which you will receive prior to your cruise. They are also available at all of our offices. All hirers are bound by these conditions, the most important of which are summarised here.

If booking directly with Emerald Star you must pay 25% of the hire charge in advance, and the balance one month in advance of cruise. A booking once confirmed can only be changed on payment of a £10 fee.

If booking through a Travel Agent you pay them in advance and present their voucher on arrival. A cruiser is booked only when the official Agency Confirmation is received by Emerald Star.

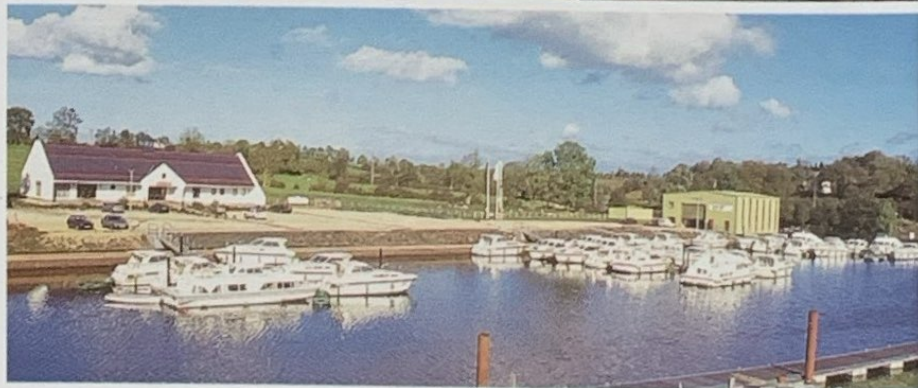
If you cancel you may still be liable for the cost of the cruiser hire. Our policy is to charge the full cost of cruiser hire for all cancellations made within six weeks of your cruise or for the peak season. If we succeed in rehiring the cruiser, the charge is 5%.

In every case you pay the appropriate refundable Security Deposit, or non-refundable boat damage waiver fee on arrival, and cost of diesel on departure. You are not liable for claims for damage to third parties in excess of your **refundable** Security Deposit unless this damage is caused wilfully or through your own negligence. If you pay a non-refundable boat damage waiver, you are exempt from damage to the cruiser and its dinghy, but not for the loss of inventory items. At no time are you covered by our insurance for loss of, theft or damage to your personal belongings aboard the cruiser or dinghy.

Embarkation. Cruisers are not normally ready before 16.00 hrs except by prior arrangement with the Station Manager. Those with servicing or other problems may be further delayed. On arrival, a representative will give the hirer a trial and acceptance run of about 15 minutes, and the hirer will also check the cruiser inventory. After this and unless the hirer requests further instruction or information, he will be deemed to have accepted responsibility for the cruiser and its contents.
