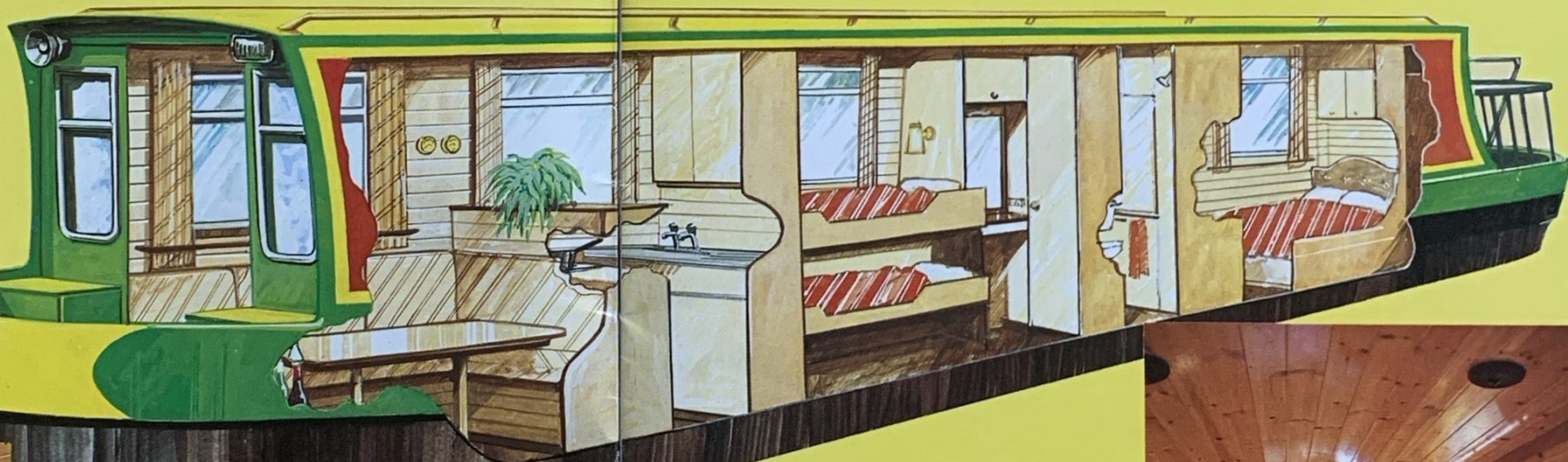

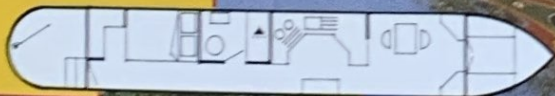
Designed for two this boat combines spacious luxury with a very practical layout.

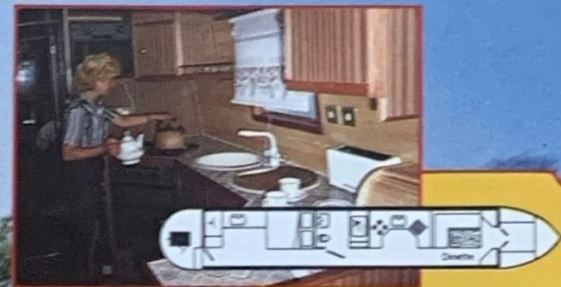

This beautifully fitted out narrowboat provides supreme accommodation for four people. Unashamed luxury is found throughout this boat. The master cabin has a large double berth with wardrobe space, vanity unit and dressing area. Colour T.V. facility is also available in this cabin. The well appointed bathroom incorporates a freshwater flushing toilet, vanity unit, shower/a-size bath.

Aft of the fore cabin is the galley with cooker, fridge freezer, microwave, toaster unit and ample worktop and storage space. The dining area at the fore comfortably seats four and easily converts to form a double berth when required. From here double doors open onto a small deck for sitting outside.

The whole boat is carpeted throughout and centrally heated to give complete comfort on your holiday.

4. Well appointed bathroom/s with a-size bath, fresh water flushing toilet, designed vanity unit and hairdryer.
5. Full central heating thermostatically controlled.

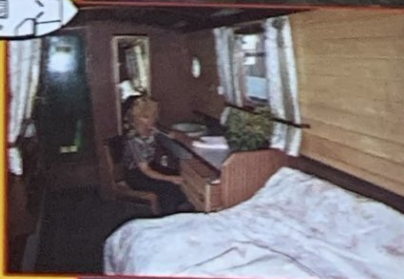
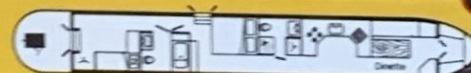

Two single berths at the stern adjoin a spacious bathroom with fresh water flush toilet, vanity unit and shower/a-size bath. The main double cabin is amidships and has its own side entrance. Similar in style to that found on the Gold 4, the galley aboard Gold 6 would delight any chef of 'Haute Cuisine'. The dining/lounge area at the fore can be converted to form the remaining double berth when required.

Between the rear and centre cabins is the bathroom comprising shower/a size bath, fresh water flushing toilet and vanity unit. A second toilet and washbasin is located by the galley area.

The well appointed galley has full size gas oven and hob, fridge, plenty of worktops and storage cupboards, double sink unit and full inventory for six people.

Thermostatically controlled central heating and carpeted throughout.

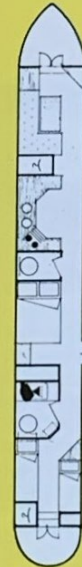
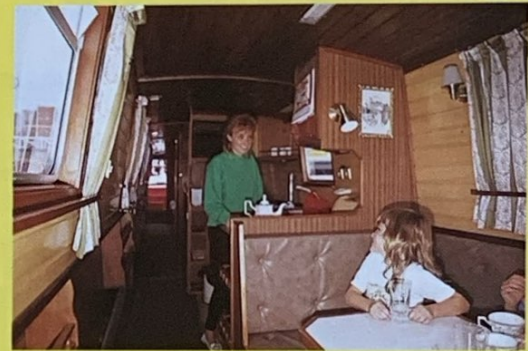
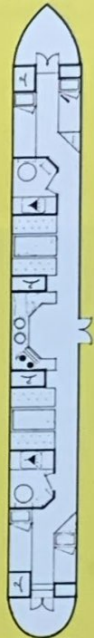
This spacious boat comfortably accommodates eight people in four double berths.

The dining areas either side of the central galley convert to form two double berths. A toilet and shower compartment adjoins each of these sleeping areas.

The lounge areas at the bow and stern convert into a further two double berths, and again there is wardrobe and draw space.

If required, either the stern or bow lounge areas can be left as single berths as shown.

For convenient access, side entrances are provided into the central galley area, which is well equipped with fridge, double sink unit, gas cooker and hob, storage cupboards and worktops.



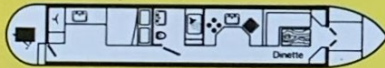

TRADITIONAL BOATS



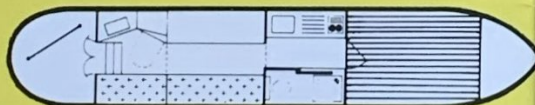

To complete the effect there is a very efficient solid fuel stove which gives the boat a snug atmosphere.

Canal enthusiasts will enjoy these boats which combine all the modern facilities of gas cooker, fridge, hot and cold water, shower and flushing toilet with the traditional aspects of narrowboats.

These boats are available for hire all year round and with the English climate they provide a splendid way to cruise in winter with the back doors open, the heat from the stove gently rising to warm the steerer. In summer the extra front deck area gives you more space to eat outside or watch the world go by.

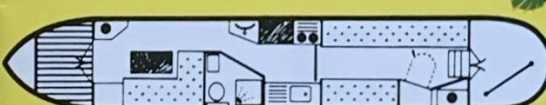
Similar in style and length to the Beaver there is a large lounge/dining area to the fore which will form a king size double berth at night.

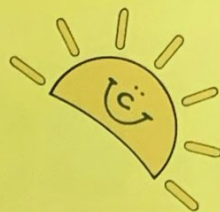
To commemorate Birmingham's centenary year we have brought the boat back from North America.

If you are looking for a flavour of canal history this boat is for you.



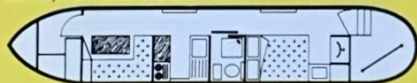

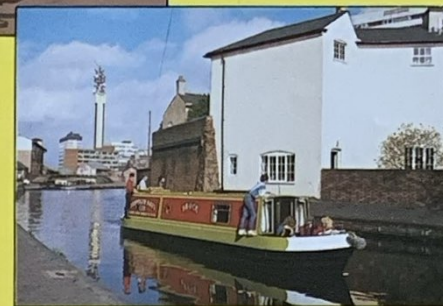
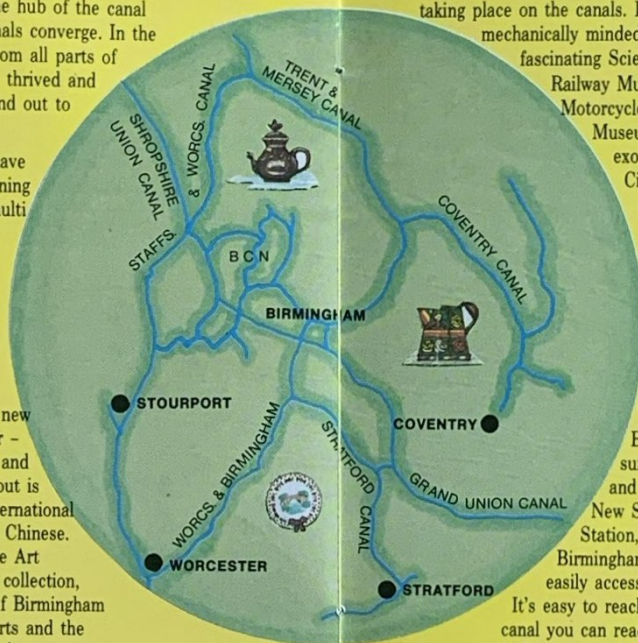
Often called 'Little Venice', Birmingham canals have taken on a new lease of life with investment opening up the canals to tourism and the creation of a multi million pound International Convention Centre adjoining the canal. Waterside restaurants and a Leisure complex using the canal as a connecting focus are planned for this centre. An exciting development for Birmingham and the canals.

For the visitor, Birmingham with its new International image has a lot to offer - shopping in its award winning malls and centres or bustling markets. Eating out is an exotic experience with a truly International choice of cuisine, from Caribbean to Chinese. The Arts are well provided for - The Art Gallery, noted for its pre-Raphaelite collection, and changing Exhibitions, the City of Birmingham Symphony Summer season of Concerts and the International Jazz Festival in July with events

taking place on the canals. For those more mechanically minded, Birmingham has a fascinating Science Museum, a Steam Railway Museum, the National Motorcycle Museum, a Vintage Bus Museum and the Patrick Collection of exotic and opulent motor cars and City centre motor racing at the Super Prix event. A lot to see and do and all very accessible from our boatyard.

But for the holiday maker the canal is still a hidden surprise, a quiet backwater which leads through and to so many interesting places of historic interest and rural beauty.

Brummagem Boats is one of those surprises - its boatyard, a colourful and hectic scene, is ten minutes from New Street Station and Digbeth Coach Station, twenty minutes away from Birmingham International Airport and easily accessed from the M5 and M6. 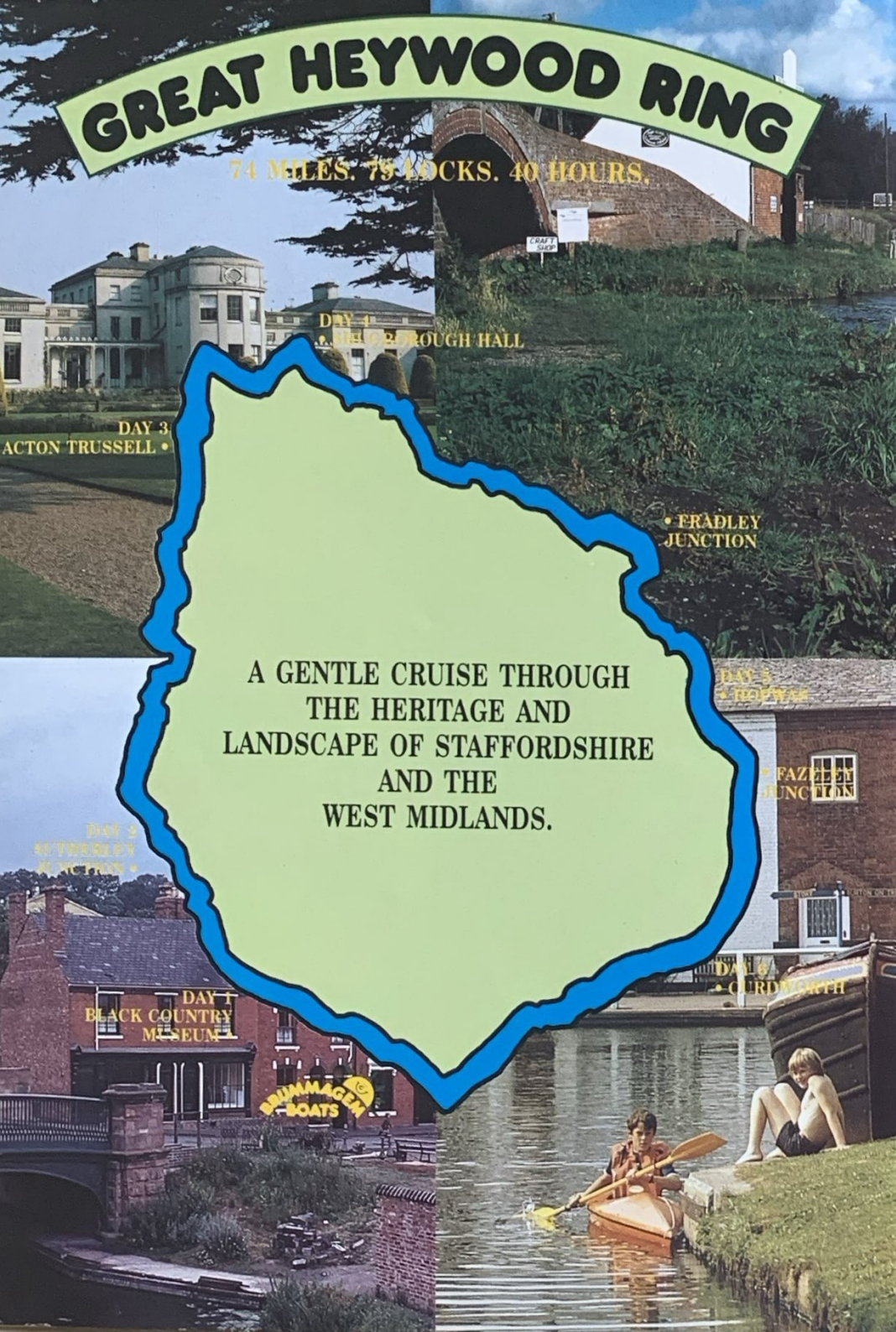

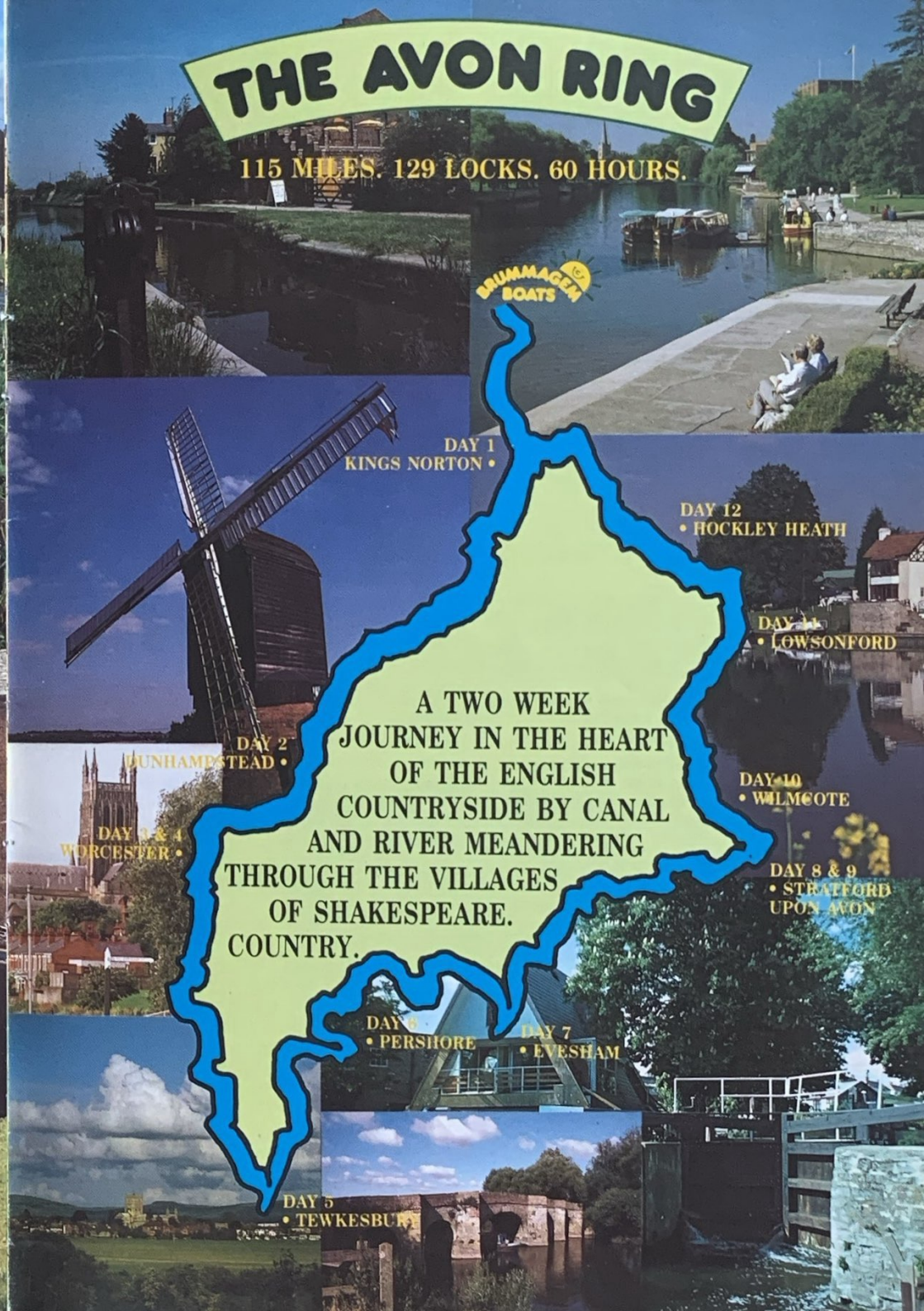

WEEKEND AND MIDWEEK BREAKS

A long weekend or a mid week break might be just what you need for a change of scene to relax, a break from your routine or to get together with friends.

We offer these short breaks on the Beaver, Ballad, Bourne, Clipper, Badger, Beau and Buccaneer Classes, which can be booked at any time throughout the year.

Your weekend break starts on Friday at 2.30 p.m., returning the following Monday at 9.30 a.m.

Your midweek break starts on Monday at 2.30 p.m., returning the following Friday at 9.30 a.m.

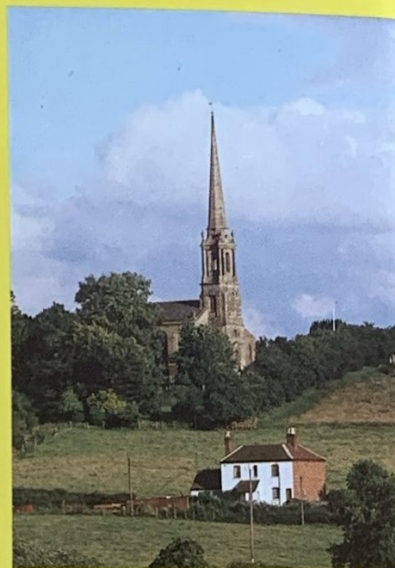
We are able to suggest several routes for you depending on the number, energy and inclinations of your crew!

ROUTE 1 - GREEN MEANDERING ESCAPE

Wander down the Worcester/Birmingham Canal through Edgbaston, Selly Oak, Bournville to Kings Norton Junction, where you will find the Patrick Collection Car Museum and a pleasant mooring.

The following day travel on through the Wast Hill Tunnel, an adventure in itself, and emerge into the beautiful Worcestershire countryside. Passing by pleasant farmland and the Bittell Reservoir you come to the village of Alvechurch. You may like to turn round in the Alvechurch boatyard or perhaps carry on to the top of Tardebigge flight of locks. From this spot it is well worth the climb up the hill to the picturesque church for the view over the Severn Valley.

At this point 'wind your boat' and head back up along the Worcester/Birmingham. If you would like to see some of the Northern Stratford Canal, with its unique Guillotine Lock, Swing and Drawbridges, then turn on to it at Kings Norton Junction. But be well aware of your return time to the boatyard when planning this.



ROUTE 2 - BLACK COUNTRY TRAIL

For those interested in Britain's industrial heritage take the boat up to the Black Country Museum (4 hours cruising). Moor up overnight by the Museum and in the morning visit the Museum with its recreated Victorian street and workshops, mine and tramway, or take a boat trip into the Dudley Singing Caverns.

The next day travel through the Netherton Tunnel to Windmill Junction and then to the end of the Dudley Canal at Coombeswood Basin.

This route brings you into the heart of the Black Country and their wonderful ales and pubs!

There are plenty of backwaters to explore on the Birmingham Canal navigations, so ask your 'See Out' at the boatyard for more details.



THE BRUMMAGEM FLY TRIP BOAT



'The Brummagem Fly' trip boat is available for hire throughout the year. You may charter this 70 ft skippered boat for educational trips, parties, receptions or business meetings - it is fully licensed and insured to carry 48 passengers.

A lazy evening cruise with buffet and bar is a very pleasant but unusual way to entertain, celebrate or just while away the day. For these occasions we offer a buffet service with a variety of menus.
