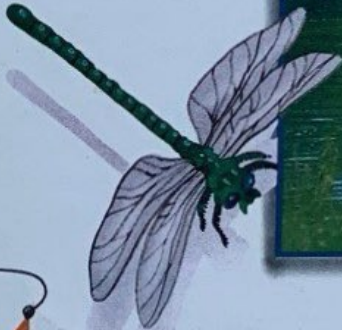

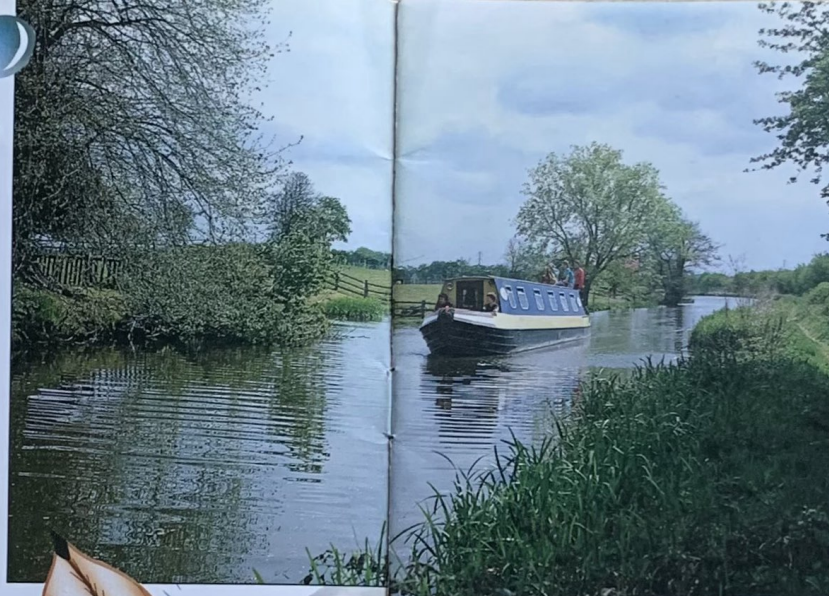

IMPROVED SERVICE

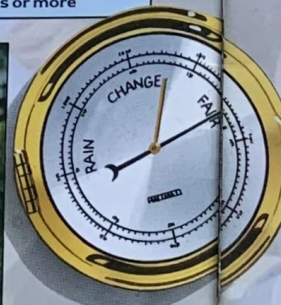
This year we have improved the service we can offer by:

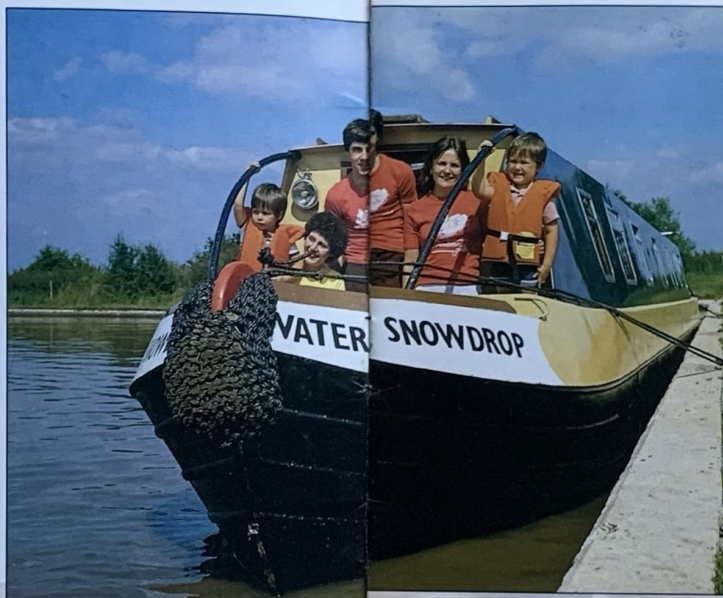
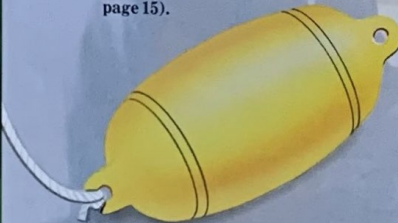
■ insurance (excluding the first £50 of any claim). We insure the boat itself and for third party liability. We recommend you take out your own personal accident, medical and luggage insurance.

- Cancellation scheme premium (see page 15).



BOOKING IS EASY

■ Simply fill in the booking form at the end of the brochure and send it to us with a deposit of 25% of the hire fee or £20 for Daycruisers.

■ We will then confirm your booking in writing.

■ Later you will receive an invoice for the balance of the hire charge. This needs to be paid not less than 28 days before the beginning of your holiday.

■ If you are booking less than 6 weeks before the start of your holiday please send us full payment with the booking form.

■ To be sure of getting your first choice of boat and dates book as early as possible. However we sometimes have last minute availability so do give us a call on 0270 625122.

LEARNING THE ROPES

If you've never been on a narrowboat holiday don't worry. This year you will be able to learn everything you need to know about safely enjoying your holiday in the comfort of your own home! A new VHS video is now available which can be sent free of charge with your booking confirmation. If you wish to keep the video, a charge of £5 will be made – if not just hand it back to us at Nantwich when you start your

holiday. Our boats are easy to operate and the team at the marina will spend plenty of time showing you the ropes before you set off. Complete novices might prefer to start their holiday on a Sunday when only four boats leave and we have even more time to spend with newcomers. Each boat has its own handbook full of useful information about the boat and your route. You can moor, free, wherever you like. However it is best not to tie up close to locks and bridges or on a sharp bend.

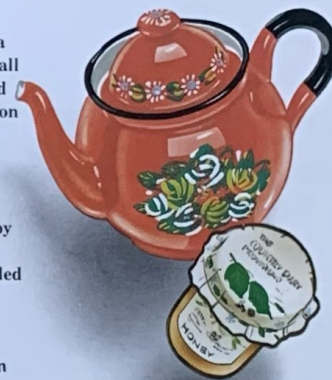
SAFETY AFLOAT

Boating on the inland waterways is very safe. Although canals are shallow it is common sense for children and non swimmers to wear buoyancy aids. We supply them free of charge, so please ask for them when you arrive at Nantwich.



ALL ABOARD!

Your crew should include at least 2 adults. Children will enjoy helping with steering and going through locks. If you would like an extra passenger to join you please check with our booking office in advance. We will let you know if there is enough room on your boat. Your extra passenger will need to bring a sleeping bag. Pets are welcome on all standard boats (but are not allowed on luxury boats). Just tick the box on the booking form to let us know.



THE START OF YOUR HOLIDAY

Nantwich Marina is easy to get to by car or train (Crewe is the nearest station) and we will send you detailed instructions on how to get there. Don't worry about last minute shopping since we stock all the essentials such as bread and milk in our shop at the marina. In addition, by filling in the detailed grocery list we send, you can have all the food you



require ready for you on arrival at Nantwich. This service is free, although you will have to pay for the groceries before you leave on your boat.

The shop also sells a wide range of other goods including maps, cruising guides, waterproofs, souvenirs and gifts.



A FLEET BUILT FOR COMFORT

All our boats are built to an excellent standard, combining the romance of narrow boat living with the convenience of central heating, shower and washbasins with hot and cold water, electric lights, TV and a stereo radio/cassette player.



The galley is fitted with a cooker with grill and full sized oven, a fridge and plenty of working surfaces. Everything you need is provided from washing up liquid and matches to whiskey glasses and teatowels. There is a full inventory of kitchenware, crockery and cutlery. In the bathrooms details such as shaver points have not been forgotten. You will also find soap and toilet paper on board. Useful items such as a set of rainwear, and a first aid kit are provided as well.



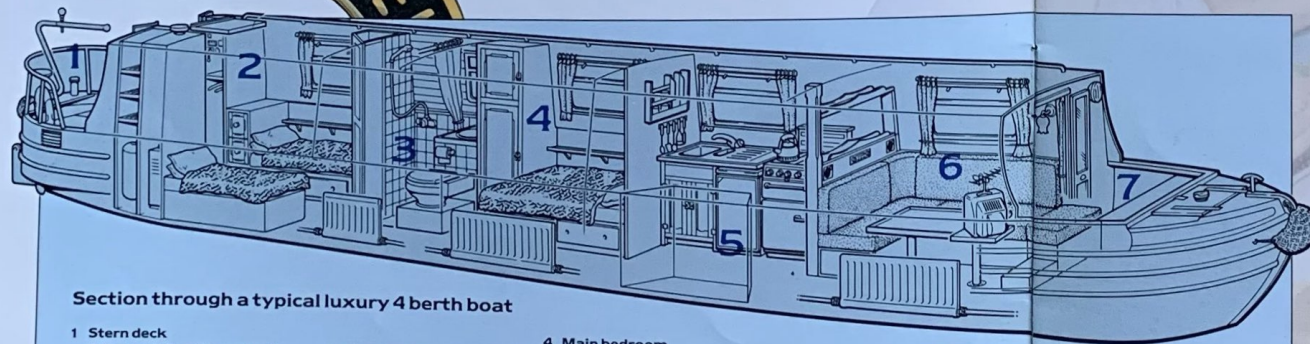
STANDARD BOATS

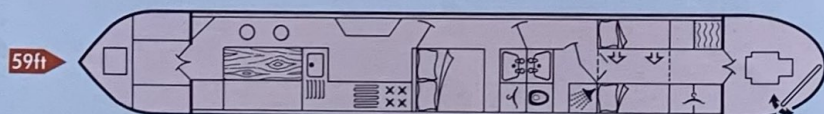

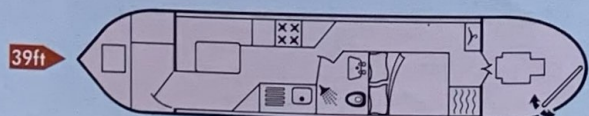

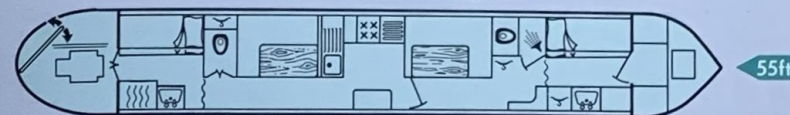

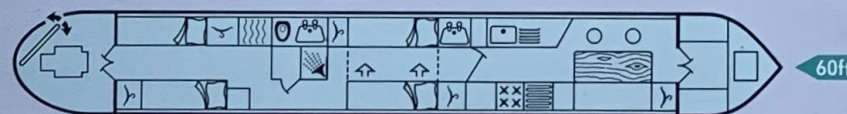


Standard 8 berth

- An ideal boat for 2 families sharing a holiday, as the fore and aft bedrooms, toilet and washing facilities are divided by the central kitchen and dining area.

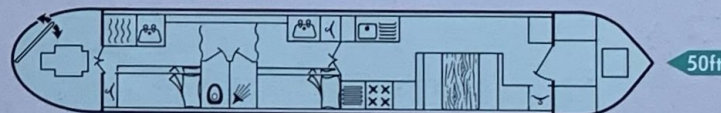
Standard 6 berth

- A spacious layout with generous storage space. Ideal for a family or group of friends sharing. There is also plenty of room to sunbathe on deck.



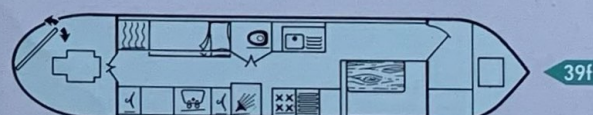
Standard 6 berth

CANAL BREAKAWAYS

DAYCRUISING

We launched daycruising last year and it has been a great success. So this season we have built another brand new Daycruiser specially designed for a day out.

Spending a day afloat is ideal for an office outing or a treat for family and friends.

Day cruisers are easy to handle. Our staff will show you the ropes before you set off and equip you with free buoyancy jackets for the children. The 30 feet narrow boats can accommodate up to 12 people and are fully equipped with everything you could need for a day's cruising. You'll find all mod. cons aboard - a small cooker, sink, flush toilet and gas fire together with all the cutlery and crockery you'll need, neatly stowed away.

We'll even make up a picnic hamper to order, freshly filled with whatever you choose. Telephone us on 0270 625122 for details.

From Nantwich you can cruise along the beautiful Shropshire Union Canal. Heading north you will pass through Hurleston to Barbridge Junction or Bunbury Locks. Following a southerly route you will reach Hack Green.



There's no shortage of mooring places and good picnic spots. And plenty of lively waterside pubs along the way. Prices have been held from 1989 and are inclusive of VAT and fuel.

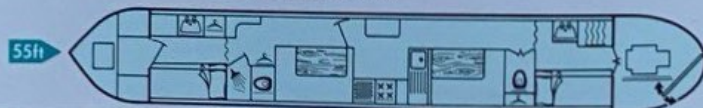

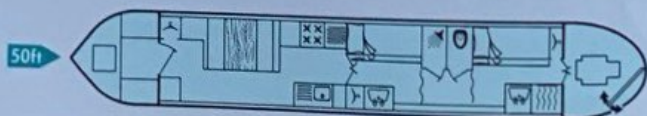

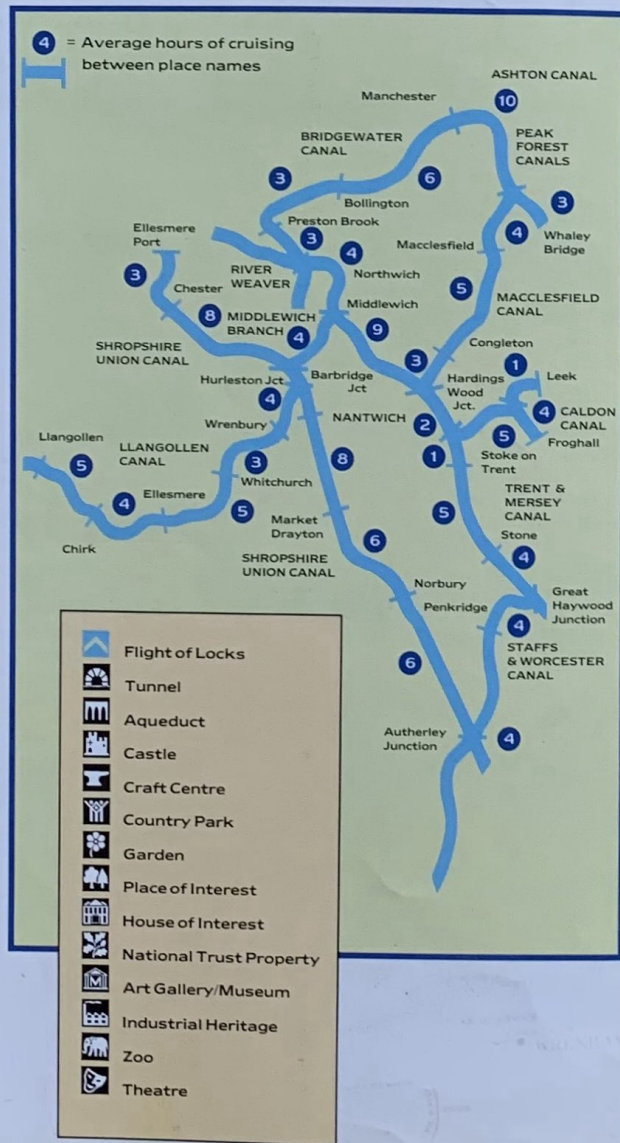
A CHOICE OF ROUTE

There are many choices of route from Nantwich Marina. There is something to suit both novices and experienced boaters. So if you took your holiday with us last year why not try a new route this year?

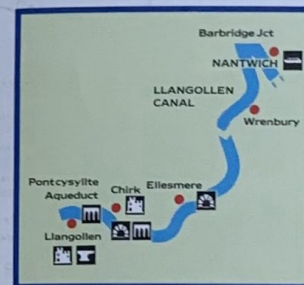

ON ARRIVAL

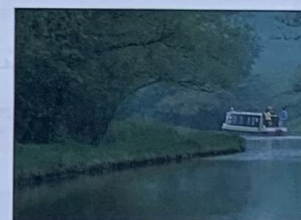

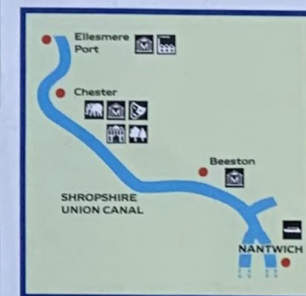
LLANGOLLEN CANAL



The return trip from Nantwich to Llangollen takes a week, cruising for 7 hours a day with a low level of effort. The famous Llangollen Canal, renowned for its magnificent aqueducts, tunnels and lift bridges passes through some of North Wales' most beautiful scenery – home to a variety of birds and wildlife. For your first canal cruise, the journey through Cheshire, Shropshire and Wales offers magnificent sights and an easy route with plenty of time to linger wherever you choose.

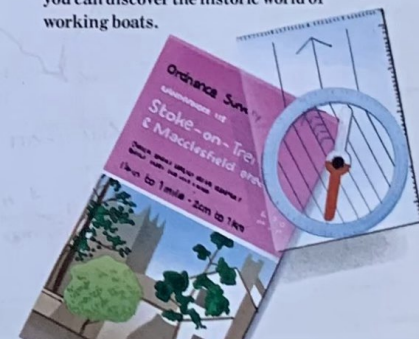

The return trip from Nantwich to Ellesmere Port takes a week, cruising for 6 hours a day with a low level of effort. A journey northwards along the Shropshire Union Canal passes through tranquil scenery. The historic walled city of Chester is 9 hours cruising from Nantwich. Moor beneath the city walls to stroll around the galleried 'Rows' or visit one of the country's largest zoos. Relax with a drink after visiting the famous shopping centre. At Ellesmere Port you will find the Boat Museum where you can discover the historic world of working boats.



THE CHESHIRE RING



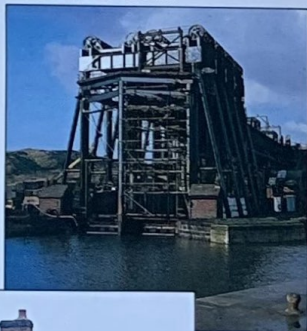
The Cheshire Ring is suitable for a 2 week holiday, cruising for 9 hours per day. A medium level of effort is required.

The ring is a splendid circular tour of the country that blends town, country, action and calm. Anderton Boat Lift was built in 1875 to transfer boats 50 feet between the River Weaver and the Trent & Mersey Canal.

On your way to the Bridgewater Canal you will pass through Preston Brook Tunnel which is 1239 yards long.

You can moor close to shops, museums and restaurants in Manchester. It can be arranged for a member of British Waterways' staff to assist you through the flight of 18 locks at Ashton. Just

give him a call the day before on 061 273 4686. You will then meet the Macclesfield Canal where you can look down from high embankments over fells and mill towns. There are plenty of corner shops and pubs for refreshment along the way as well as several interesting National Trust properties.

FOUR COUNTIES RING



This ring is suitable for a 2 week trip, cruising for 8½ hours per day. A medium to high level of effort is required.

The Four Counties Ring is a delightful circular cruise that takes you through Cheshire, Staffordshire and Shropshire. You could do it in a week but it is a pity to rush when there is so much to see and do. You'll find plenty of real-ale pubs, villages and craft shops to visit.

After leaving the old salt mining town of Middlewich you face 27 locks in 7 miles. This is a good excuse to break for refreshment at the top before heading into the 1¼ mile long Harecastle Tunnel. You will then enter the Potteries where you could visit the Spode China works in Stoke on Trent or the Wedgwood Factory near Trentham Lock.

If you have a day to spare you could journey up the Caldon Canal from which you can see wonderful views of the Peak District. Once you reach the Staffordshire & Worcester Canal you are only a short walk away from Shugborough Hall, home of the Earl of Lichfield. At Autherley Junction you turn back onto the Shropshire Union with its typically deep cuttings. There are lock flights at Audlem and Auderley and then you can take it easy on the home stretch to Nantwich.

CONDITIONS

1. BOOKING

Hire charges are payable in advance as described below. Booking deposits must be made as follows:

- Weekly and Breakaway boats,
 - 25% of hire fee for UK booking,
 - 50% of hire fee for overseas booking
- Day cruisers: £20.

The balance will be invoiced and should be paid at least 28 days before the first day of the holiday. Day cruisers: balance payable when picking up boat.

Hire charges include VAT and are subject to change should the rate of VAT change. All payments should be in £ sterling.

2. BALANCE OF HIRE CHARGES

In the event of a hirer being unable to take the holiday booked, every effort will be made to relet the boat. If successful, the hirer will only be liable to pay the booking deposit. If the boat is not relet, the hirer remains responsible for payment of the balance of the hire charge. Hirers may wish to join the British Waterways' Hire Cruiser Cancellation Scheme.

3. AGE LIMIT

Bookings cannot be accepted from anyone under 21 years of age.

4. BOAT

If through circumstances beyond our control we are unable to provide the class of boat booked we will use every

endeavour to supply a suitable replacement. Failing this, all money paid will be refunded and the hirer will have no other claim.

5. HIRERS' EQUIPMENT

Equipment that could cause damage to the boat, its equipment and occupants must not be taken on board except with prior permission of the marina staff (as an example only: electric appliances).

Motorbikes, mopeds and gas-burning equipment (including barbecues) will not be permitted on the boat.

6. STARTING YOUR HOLIDAY

Hire of the boat begins at 3 pm. Please arrive at Nantwich Marina no earlier than 2 pm and no later than 5 pm. Day cruisers: begin at 10.00 am.

A security deposit of £50 in cash or cheque supported by a bank card is payable before you take over the boat. Day cruisers: deposit £20.

Part or all may be retained if the hirer is in breach of any of these conditions stated here.

Please check and sign the inventory of equipment on the boat. The hirer is liable to pay up to £50 for any loss or damage to the boat and its equipment.

The Marina Manager reserves the right not to hand over a boat to anyone who in his opinion is not suitable to take charge.

In this event all money paid will be refunded in full and the hirer will have no other claim.

7. INSURANCE

Insurance covering the hirer against legal liability in respect of Third Party claims and claims by passengers in the boat is included in the hire charge up to an amount of £1,000,000 in respect of any one accident. The hirer shall be responsible for the first £50 of any such claim.

8. WATERWAYS CODE

The hirer must follow the Waterways Code and observe British Waterways' current Byelaws. Our boat can only be cruised in daylight.

9. ACCIDENT

If the boat is involved in an accident do not admit any fault.

Immediately telephone one of British Waterways' staff at the numbers supplied at the beginning of the hiring period with full details including names and addresses of other parties involved.

10. BOAT BREAKDOWN

Please telephone Nantwich Marina immediately. Do not attempt repairs yourself or order anyone else to. British Waterways shall not be liable for the consequences of any such failure or breakdown or for any loss or damage or delay, sustained by the hirer.

11. CRUISING LIMITATIONS

Please advise the Marina Manager at the start of your holiday if you intend to cruise on rivers. No cruising is permitted on tidal waterways. Your boat is

licensed for use on all local waterways except the Rochdale Canal in Manchester. You will have to pay a fee for its use. Day cruisers: The boat must not be taken through locks.

12. RETURNING THE BOAT

The boat should be at Nantwich Marina by 9 am on the last day of the holiday and completely vacated by 10 am. Day cruisers: boat must be returned by 8.00 pm or dusk whichever is earlier. A fixed sum of £10 for every hour or part of an hour the boat is overdue will be payable.

The boat and equipment should be returned clean and tidy. If not the deposit may be retained to cover additional cleaning costs.

13. DELAYS

British Waterways does not accept responsibility for delays or alterations to planned routes due to boat breakdown, navigation problems or any other reasons beyond British Waterways' control.

14. CAR PARKING

Parking at Nantwich Marina is at the owner's risk. British Waterways will take all reasonable care, but cannot be held responsible for any loss or damage caused to vehicles or their contents left on British Waterways' premises.

'British Waterways' refers to British Waterways Board.

CANCELLATION SCHEME

BRITISH WATERWAYS HIRE CRUISER CANCELLATION SCHEME

Once your booking has been confirmed, you are responsible for the full hire charge of the boat, even if you are unable to take possession. If you have to cancel your booking prior to the date of departure for any reason, you must notify British Waterways immediately and we will endeavour to relet the boat on your behalf. If this is achieved, then you will forfeit only your deposit to cover the

costs involved in reletting. If it is not relet you will remain responsible for prompt payment of the outstanding hire fee. If you have subscribed to British Waterways' Hire Cruiser Cancellation Scheme, you will be entitled to a refund of all monies paid in respect of the booking and you shall not be liable to British Waterways for any outstanding balance of the hire fee, provided:

1. the reason for the cancellation is one of those listed below
 2. you notify the British Waterways immediately the circumstance arises
 3. you substantiate the reason for cancellation to the British Waterways' satisfaction by providing a medical certificate or other appropriate document.
- The following are qualifying reasons:
- a) death, serious illness, pregnancy complications, jury service, redundancy of any member of the holiday party.
 - b) death, serious injury, illness of a close relative of the hirer (close relative

means spouse, parent, parent-in-law, brother, sister, child, dependant.)
c) death of a close business associate of the hirer.
