Mere filling of the Examination Form does not give the right to the students to appear in the Final Examination but students will be allowed to appear in the Final Examination after completing all other requisite formalities of J&amp;K SBOTE. The Roll Number to the students are issued, only after the completion of the semester, and to those students who have 75% of attendance and have passed at least one of the Internal Test. Even if the student appears in the final examination, his all the papers are cancelled if he/she fails in sessional marks.</p>
