DESCRIPTION OF BUILDING PRODUCT

Brad nails, also known as brads, feature a small T or D head and a finer gauge. They are a finishing nail that is used where the appearance is a primary concern. Examples of applications include fixing of moulding, trim, cabinet panelling, beading etc.

Brad nails are non-structural fasteners that have a smaller head that can be driven flush with a timber surface or countersunk below the surface.

Confast supplies galvanised and stainless steel angled and straight brads.

- Angled brads are supplied in 15 and 16 gauge and lengths from 32 mm 63 mm.
- Straight brads are supplied in 16 and 18 gauge and lengths from 15 mm 63 mm.
