Stop and Search

Stop and Search is a valuable tool for detecting and deterring crime if used correctly. All searches are supervised and it is now policy that these searches are video recorded unless certain exceptions arise. In May, Tower Hamlets was the fourth highest area in London for police using their search powers with a positive outcome, with over 7,000 positive searches conducted.

What's been happening?



St Katharine & Wapping SNT had a multi-agency meeting with external partners to assess the ongoing ASB issues at Fuchsia Court, Samson Street. We spoke to several residents about their grievances regarding the use of the car park (Lilley Close) area by non-residents who are causing late night ASB. It was highlighted that the car park gate has been damaged, despite being repaired several times. We also noted lack of street lighting was a issue. We had Councillor Ullah, Lorraine from THCH and the Wapping SNT on site.

Community Road Watch

A successful speed watch took place in Wapping Lane and Vaughan Way on two different occasion it was an opportunity for residents to take part of the activity and increase safety in the area. This action resulted in a total of five vehicles getting reported for going over the speed limit in a 20MPH area.

Vehicle Warnings

St Katharine's & Wapping SNT served a total of 7 ASB Warnings to problem drivers around the area of Shadwell Basin this month. These drivers were identified as using their vehicles in inconsiderate ways, causing ASB and nuisance. ASB warnings are a way for police to restrict these behaviours, and confers the power to seize the vehicle should they continue.
