## **SEAMAN BOOK | RANKS**

### **Ordinary Seaman (OS)**

**Assists Able Seamen and Officers in deck work.**

#### **OS – ORDINARY SEAMAN Book's Rank covers the following sectors :**

<b>Deck Utility Worker</b>	Helps in maintenance, painting, and cleaning.
<b>Bosun's Mate (Trainee)</b>	Supports the Bosun (head of deck crew).
<b>Rigger / Rope Handler</b>	Assists in cargo handling and mooring operations.
<b>Deck Cadet</b>	A trainee officer learning navigation and deck operations.
<b>Stevedore/Cargo Handler</b>	Helps load and unload cargo at ports.

### **Marine Engineer Technician (MET)**

**Assists engineers in engine maintenance and repairs**

#### **Marine Engineer Technician (MET)'s Seaman Book , Covers the following :**

##### **Electrical Technician**

Handles ship's electrical systems, wiring, and power distribution.

##### **Electronics Technician**

Maintains navigation and communication systems (radars, GPS, radios).

##### **Hydraulic Technician**

Manages and repairs hydraulic systems like cranes, winches, and steering gear.

##### **Mechanical Technician**

Works on pumps, generators, compressors, and other mechanical equipment.

Refrigeration & HVAC Technician – Maintains air conditioning and cooling systems.

Welding & Fabrication Technician – Handles ship structure repairs, pipelines, and metalwork. Ship Fitter / Pipe Fitter – Installs and repairs piping and structural elements.

Automation Technician – Manages automatic control systems onboard

DP (Dynamic Positioning) Technician – Operates DP systems used on offshore vessels.

## **SEAMAN BOOK / SEAMAN'S IDENTIFICATION**

Seafarer's (crew) identity document is a document issued in accordance with the International Labor Organization (ILO) Seafarers' Identity Documents Convention No 108(1958) or No 185 (2003), the Convention on Facilitation of International Maritime Traffic (FAL Convention) and the relevant national law, REGULATION (EU) 2016/399 OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL of 9 March 2016 on a Union Code on the rules governing the movement of persons across borders (Schengen Borders Code)
