REGISTRATION

All players and coaches must register via the Squadi app and FFA's Play Football. Please search for Squadi on your app store. If you were a registered player last year, then you use your existing log in. Go more then register profile. New players will need to create an account. You can register the whole family under the one account. All players and coaches will need to upload a passport type photo. Parents should be the account holder and you then add your children to the account.

Birth Certificate/Identification – all new players are required to provide Birth Certificate (for juniors) or photo identification (for seniors). These can be sighted at Sign-On days or emailed to secretary@noosalionsfc.com

International Clearance – If you are new to Noosa Lions and are not an Australian Citizen or your last registration was overseas, you will need International clearance (only applies to u10 and up). This can be a lengthy process so please email treasurer@noosalionsfc.com ASAP after registering. Please note this is a FIFA requirement, and is not something that Noosa Lions, Football Queensland or Football Australia have any jurisdiction over

PLEASE NOTE:

Registration does not guarantee a place in a team. All 2025 Noosa Lions players are guaranteed a place in a team if registered by 10th January. We will endeavour to place everyone in a team however it is not always possible therefore recommend registering as early as possible

Fees for 2026 are set out below. NOTE: No player can join the 2026 competition unless full fees have been paid or intallments set up on Squadi.

Cancellations – Cancelling a paid and active registration will incur a 10% admin fee. Once a player has taken the field in a game or training your FQ registration fee cannot be refunded (only exceptions are season ending injuries in first 6 weeks)

Training Shirts are included in this fee and will be available in February. Players are required to only wear 2025 training shirts during the 2025 season

Online – Pay online at the time of registrations in the Squadi App

Installments - You can choose to pay in instalments through Squadi. Squadi will require you to pay the governing body fees plus the 1st instalment at the time of registration. TEAM ALLOCATIONS

- Players can only attend Trial sessions if they are registered for 2026 in Squadi
- All players are encouraged to play in their own age group as set out in the FQ Player Age Policy. Players will only be able to register in their own age group in Squadi. Consideration may be given for playing up in mini roos however this is not guarenteed. Football Qld will have strict parameters around the u13 and u14 age groups and playing up at this stage will not be considered.
- Any team preference requests for ages u6 – u9 must be submitted in person at the information day only.
- The Committee will be allocating players to teams, based on those registered at the time, immediately after the main sign on day Saturday 18th January. Team preferences after 2nd February will only be considered if already formed teams are not affected.



GAME DAY INFORMATION

Fixtures - fixture information will be available in the Squadi app. You can follow numerous teams to see draws and results/ladders (competitive teams)
Fixtures are expected to start on 28TH February 2026 (subject to change)

Game venues - vary depending on team/division/draw. All draws are determined Football Queensland. Games/carnivals may be held at any club within SCF.

Home games at Girraween- approximately half your games will be at our home fields. Please note we are a non-smoking venue and no dogs are allowed.

Wet weather: Updates for all grounds are available on the Squadi app and <https://footballqueensland.com.au/sunshine-coast/wet-weather/under>. Updates for Noosa Lions FC only are also found on our Facebook page.

Player insurance is provided by Football Queensland and the cost is included in the FQ component of player fees. If injured, players must log on at www.footballqueensland.com.au to lodge a claim within 90 days. All injuries must be reported to the club and we will need to sign off on the claim. For more information on what is covered please see www.footballqueensland.com.au. As the cover is limited, we recommend getting additional cover of your own or you can extend your coverage with Football Queensland's provider.

Can my child play in a team with a friend? We do our best to place players with friends where possible in the mini roos age groups (u6-u11). The exception to this is U9, U10, U11 and U12 Kangaroo's which are selected teams. Requests must be made at sign on days. Preference is given to returning players but only if registered by 15th January. Football Queensland will have strict parameters for the u13 and u14 age groups and playing up at this stage will not be considered.

Will all teams have a paid coach? No. 93% of our teams will be coached by a parent volunteer. Parents will receive support and training from our Technical Director.

Do I have to pay my fees in full when I register? No you don't. You can pay in installments in Squadi. You will have to pay the governing body fees and the first installment and then in equal monthly instalments from March. If you are having financial difficulties or would like a custom payment plan email secretary@noosalionsfc.com

Where will my game be played? Draws for all ages are controlled by Football Queensland and can be viewed in the Squadi app. Draws may not be posted till 1 week before the first game and at the start of the season may only have a few weeks in advance.

Can my child play up an age group? We encourage players to play in their own age group. If turning 9 in 2024 you are under 9. Consideration may be given depending upon ability, available positions, school friendships etc. No guarantee is made for any player to play up.
