Hall-Keeper's Report	Isla stated that at present the hall makes approx. £6K from rents. Ced is concerned that the overheads are increasing rapidly mainly in respect of the electricity costs & this is unsustainable. Chris has been looking into a			

	 new energy provider. It was agreed to stick with our current one until the rates change. Ced has researched local hall rents and ours is comparable. We will need to add on 25% in order to keep afloat. It was agreed by all that this is the time to increase rents. Ced proposed this increase & Caroline seconded it. This is to go out in a letter drafted by Isla to all regular hall-users. Ced is looking for revenue funds for offsetting operating costs. He is submitting an application for Investing in Communities Trust which closes on 28th June. We have to present our green credentials? He has also applied for Helping Hands funding. Isla stated that the Fete/Gala are to use the Hall card machine at the Shindig. All were in agreement.
