

Legitimate Interest Assessment Arngask Hall SC048505

The purposes of Arngask Hall is defined in the constitution as follows:

The organisation's purposes are to provide facilities for recreation and other occupation with the object of advancing education, community development, and the improvement of the conditions of life of the inhabitants of the Glenfarg Community Council area.

When a person joins Arngask Hall it is reasonable to assume they do so in acceptance and support of its purposes.

To fulfil the above purposes it is necessary to communicate with members about the organisation of Arngask Hall, to promote the various events that not only raise money to help and support Arngask Hall, but also to inform about the actions taken by the organisation in support of its objectives. To this end we must maintain contact details of our members and communicate directly with them. From time to time photographic images of hall users may be taken and these may appear on the Hall website or in the local press. If users do not wish an image to be used in this way they need to make this clear to the Data Controller.

To support the Arngask Hall purposes, it is in our legitimate interest to hold the personal data and communicate directly with them or through a third party.

We have procedures in place to protect that data from misuse thereby protecting the interests of the members. As joining Arngask Hall is the result of a direct action by an individual it is considered that an opt-out option would be counter to the action of the individual.
