Current Group Priorities for 2023-2024

1. Develop and embed 'Think Family' principles within the practice of the VSRG member organisations who will work together to influence and support the launch of the county wide Family Hubs initiative.
 2. Reduce the impact of neglect on the daily lived experiences of children and young people through sharing knowledge from Reviews and Lessons Learnt to improve outcomes for families of early intervention delivered by VSRG member organisations and the wider sector.
 3. Improve our individual and collective capacity to be a 'learning organisation' with a particular focus on replicating 'what's worked' from our effective collaboration to deliver COMF, by replicating this consortium model with lottery funding secured by CYA, to meet the identified needs of children and young people county wide.
 4. Develop the commitment and capability of VSRG members to proactively engage with the recruitment, preparation and involvement of Children and Young People in identifying the future strategic imperatives of the VSRG.
