It never ceases to amaze me at the stuff that people get away with in our day. I read the other day about Thomas Hansen of Boulder Colorado, who sued his parents in 1978 for \$350,000 on grounds of "malpractice of parenting." Mom & Dad had botched his upbringing so badly, he charged in his suit, that he would need years of costly psychiatric treatment.

Comparatively speaking, Salary.com

conducted a survey in 2010 that attempted to place a monetary value on the work of a stay-at -home mom. They determined that if mothers were to be paid for their ten most common tasks in the home (laundry machine operator, janitor, van driver, computer operator, housekeeper, day care
