Perspectives -

From your Pastor's heart.....

The other day I read a devotional thought from *Matthew 11:1-19* that dealt with **uncertainty**. The primary thought was that life is filled with **uncertainty**, especially in the midst of so many changing health issues like we find ourselves in. It is obvious that many things remain outside of our control, including coping with difficult circumstances and facing the unknown. Heightened **uncertainty** touches many areas in times like these – the economy,

employment, finances, relationships, and physical and mental health.

Amazing it as is. uncertainty even affects our relationship with God. When we don't know where things headed, and we're are uncertain what direction to take under circumstances, it's easy to reflect that same uncertainty on God, and to wonder if He really is in control. if He even knows what's going on in our lives, and if He really does care.

One of my favorite worship songs is the song "Good, Good Father." The second verse says, "I've seen many searching for answers far and wide, and I know we're all searching for answers only You provide, 'cause You know just what we need before we say a word. You're a good, good Father, it's who You are, it's who You are, it's who You are, it's who I am, it's who I am.

I know those repeated lines can seem a little redundant when you're reading them, but please let them soak in and reinforce exactly who your **God** is, and who you are to Him. Despite the **uncertainty** you and I feel at this very moment, your **God** is still in control. And regardless of how bad things may feel to you right now, your **God** is still good. And whether you feel loved at all in the midst of these circumstances, **you are loved by your God!**

The words I want you to take personally in closing are the words of 1 Peter 5:7 - "Cast all your anxious feelings on Him because He cares for vou." Swiss Reformed theologian Karl Barth is often regarded as the greatest **Protestant** of the 20th theologian century. The story is told about an occasion when Barth was asked in an interview, "What is the most profound thought that ever entered your mind?" After a brief moment of reflection.

Barth replied, "The most profound thought I have ever known is the simple truth – Jesus loves me, this I know, for the Bible tells me so."

I know we have recently celebrated Valentine's Day, and certainly nobody loves you like God does. I hope and pray that even in the midst of many uncertainties you are certain that you are loved by God.


