From your Pastor's heart.....

Here are some staggering statistics. **8.2 billion** people. That's a big number. There are that many people here on earth. In the U.S. alone estimates say that there are 340 million people. Of those 340 million people, an estimated 71% claim to be Christians, meaning that roughly 100 million people don't know Jesus. That last number represents men, women, boys & girls that don't know Jesus. Those numbers seem big – even overwhelming at times. Especially when you consider our responsibility as Christians to reach our world with the gospel of Jesus Christ. 
