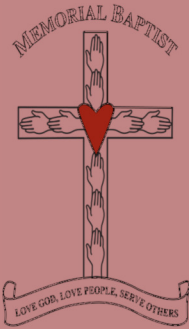

MBC MISSION TRIP

International missions have become a major part of the culture here at Memorial Baptist. In the last 20 years, we have had groups serve in Mexico, Canada, Scotland and multiple trips to Honduras and Guatemala. Many more from our congregation have provided financial and prayer support for many of these trips. It has become part of the DNA of who we are as MBC.

Our current partnership in Guatemala has yielded five trips to the country, with the sixth trip being planned for this summer. Last summer we helped with multiple ministries at our partners' main church and their mission church. We also provided materials for their Fall Vacation Bible School where 37 kids got to experience Jesus and some for the very first time.

Two weeks ago, Ruth Wiley and I had the privilege to meet up with our Guatemalan Church partner, Pastor David Lara. He was in Kentucky as part of trip with The Seminary in Guatemala City. It was great to get to hang out with him, catch up and talk about the plans and vision he has for our next visit. We talked about the church, projects and ministries that are on-going, and checked in on several of the people we have become close to on our visits. He has become a great friend!

I am always reminded that "God is Good" each time we are together. The relationships and Kingdom work that has been done through this partnership is incredible. God has moved in some mighty ways in our group and theirs. I am also excited that for the first time, we have decided to take our boys to experience Guatemala to help us serve as God leads. We will be helping with their kid's ministries at both locations, serving the women and students and continue some construction projects at the Main Church.



As mentioned above, we can't do this alone. So, the question becomes, how can you help?

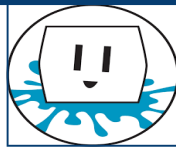
