CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

- Completed National Vendor Declaration Form/Travelling Stock Statement to be provided on the day of the show.
- Full particulars regarding breed, age, pedigree, NLIS number & name of exhibit must be provided on the entry form, with the exception of the prime cattle.
- All cattle entered in stud cattle classes MUST be registered with their recognised breed society.
- Entries will NOT be accepted without the National Cattle Health Declaration, Pesti Virus Certificate & Waiver forms.
- All cattle to have NLIS devices fitted.
- Age of cattle, as of show day.
- Prime cattle are to be weighed between 7am & 8am. The class will be divided into Lightweight & Heavyweight dependant on numbers.
- All cattle MUST be haltered at all times, including the use of nose dogs, unless bulls 12 months & over, who must have a nose ring.
- All ribbons will be awarded at the discretion of the judge.
- It is recommended that all Exhibitors have Public Liability Insurance.
- Bedding will be provided by the society.
- All classes will be judged as All breeds.
- Perpetual trophies to be presented & then remain with the show society
- Junior Paraders Competition (as per the RAS/ASC Beef Cattle Paraders Final (F002).
- Any animal deemed unsafe is to be removed from the grounds. Junior Judging & Parader classes do NOT qualify for Sydney RAS. Age of competitors is as of show day.
- Fitting Challenge competitors must present a steer or heifer, not over 20 months, in a rope halter & supply their own grooming kit & show halter.
- Perpetual trophies will be presented & then remain with the show society.
