

## Vendor Directions – Family Pride in the Park 2024

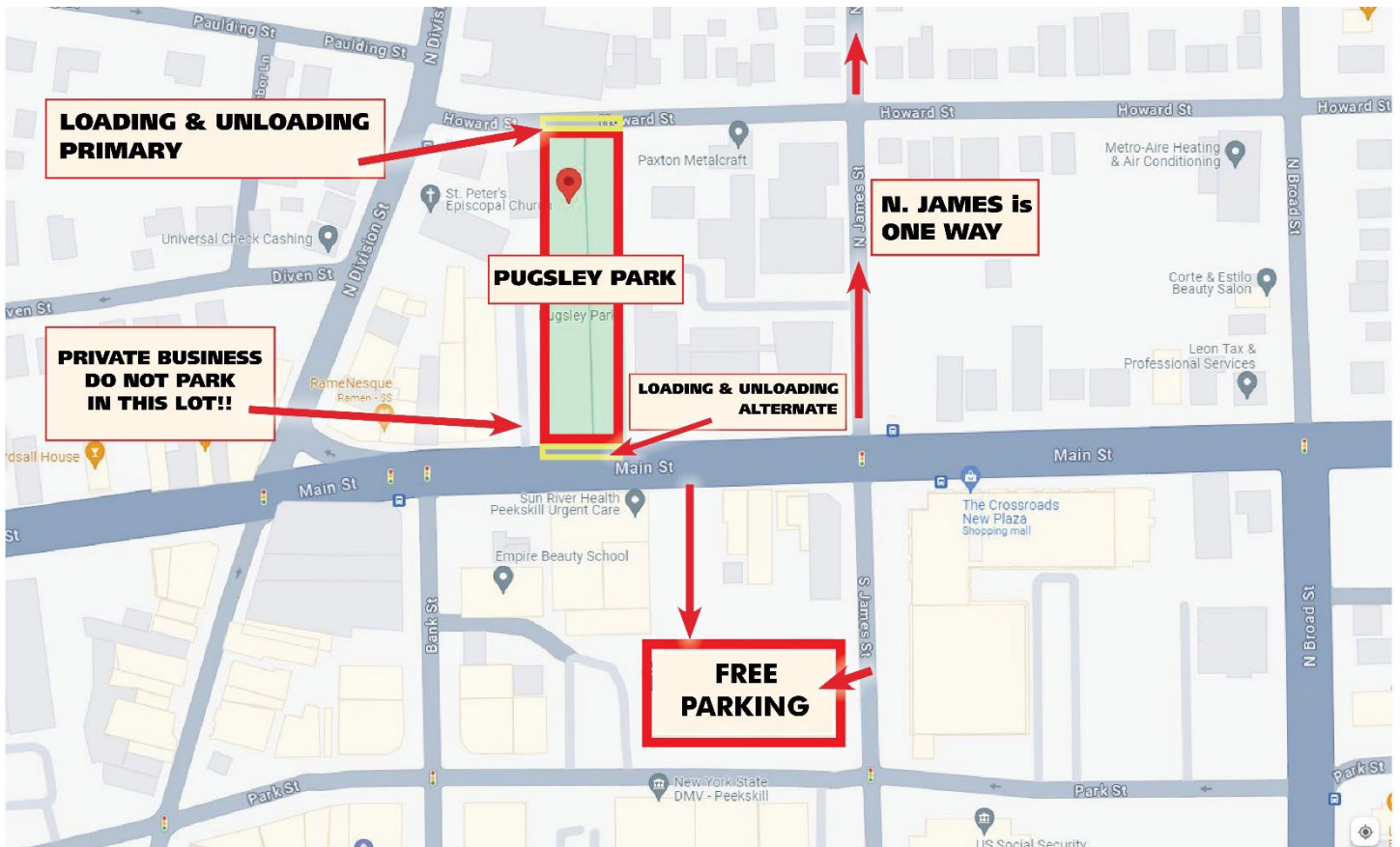
Saturday, June 29<sup>th</sup>, 2024 - 1 pm to 5 pm

Pugsley Park Downtown Peekskill - Rain or Shine

There are two entrances to this park. The Vendor Entrance is on Howard Street

GPS address is **1021 Howard Street, Peekskill, NY 10566**

The park has been fully renovated since our last event, and the layout is very different. **All vendor spaces are on the Howard Street side of the park this year.** The parking spaces directly in front of the park on both sides will be blocked off for unloading and loading purposes only. PLEASE unload your vehicle as quickly as possible and then move your car to the James Street Garage for Parking before setting up your booth. Please **DO NOT PARK** on the Main Street or Howard Street sides of the park. **DO NOT PARK** in the *Sav-Mor Auto Parts* Parking Lot; this is a private business, and you will be towed. **Free Parking** is located in the James Street Garage.



**Vendors may arrive and start setting up from 9:30 am to 12:30 pm.  
You must be parked, set up, and ready for the event by 1 pm.  
No Late Entry Setup Allowed.

**Family Pride in the Park 2024 - General Guidelines:**

- Vendor fees must be paid in full prior to the festival.
- This is an outdoor festival—plan for Rain or Shine. There will be no refunds due to inclement weather.
- There will be no refunds for not showing.
  
- Vendors have access to the vending area for setup between the hours of 9:30a and 12:30p.
- Vendors must be ready by the festival start time of 1:00 pm.
- Vendors are responsible for the security of their booth during load-in, load-out, and throughout the event.
- This festival runs from 1 pm to 5 pm, we expect you to stay till the end of the festival.
- All vendors have Free Parking at the James St Parking Garage after unloading. (see map)
- Vending spaces are assigned at management's discretion. Your space assignment cannot and will not be changed on the day of the event.
- Vendors are allowed a 10' x 10' tent/canopy only – larger tents cannot be accommodated.
- All vendors must provide their own equipment, tables, chairs, tape, string, etc.
- All stands or tables will be stable, safe, and clean.
- All tents must have all four legs weighted with a 20-pound weight or secured with stakes. Please make sure that stakes and ropes do not interfere with other tents or walking paths.
- Some electricity can be provided from light poles in the park. However all extension cords must be provided by vendor. Small, very quiet generators may be allowed and can be put directly behind your vending space. We reserve the right to have you discontinue using the generator if we feel it is problematic.
- Vendors may not exhibit any material deemed offensive or objectionable to the adjacent or surrounding vendors or to the festival as a whole. **This is an all-ages, family-friendly event.**
  
- **If you carry it in, please plan to carry it out at the end of the day. This includes packing materials and other trash (or recycling) related to your vending process.**
- Unprofessional conduct or abusive language by vendors towards festival staff, volunteers, other vendors or attendees may be immediately expelled and excluded from future festivals.
  
- Did we mention you must be responsible for taking everything you carried in with you at the end of the event? This includes ALL trash you created during the process of your vending.

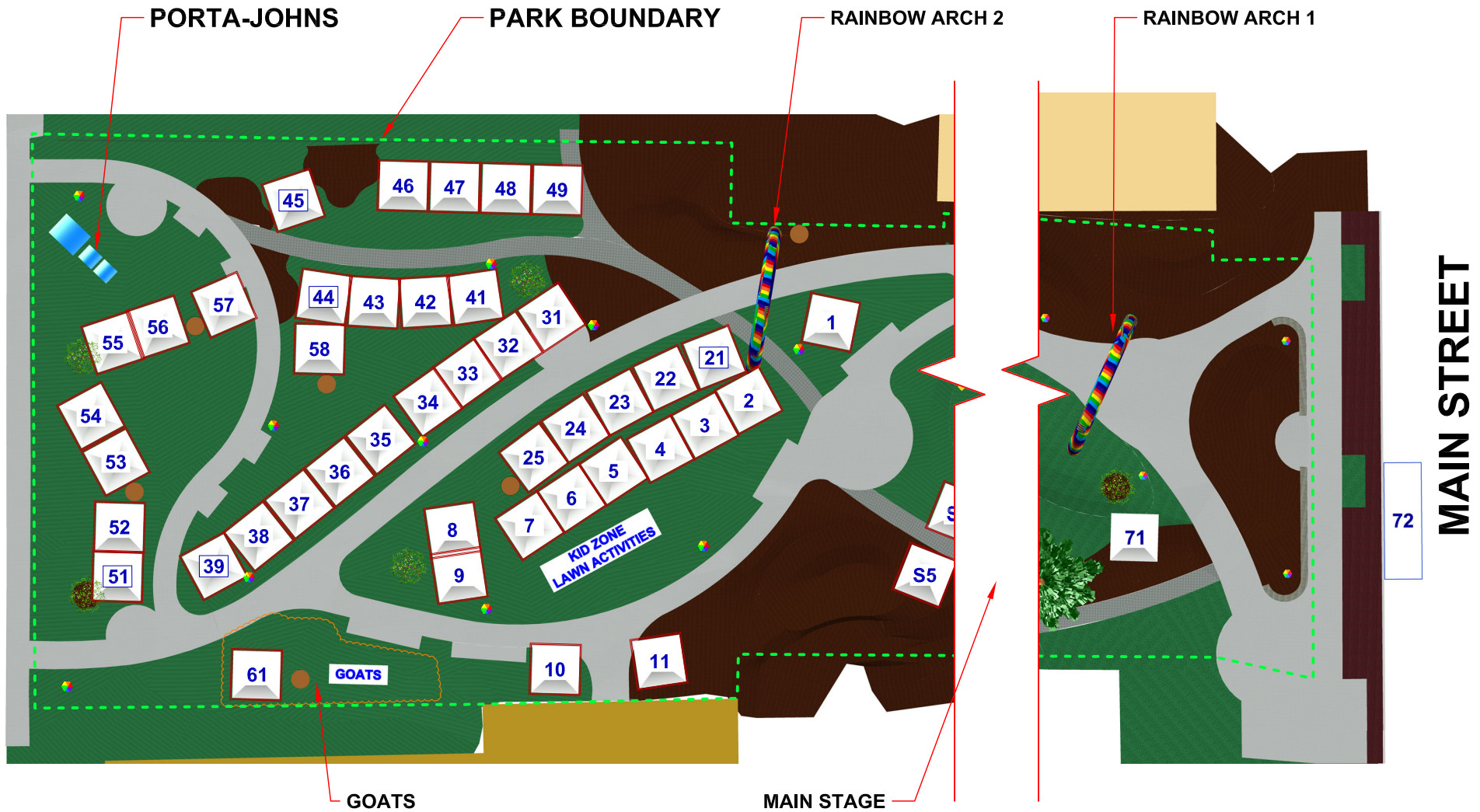
