Senior Center Yearly Report for Fiscal Year 2020-2021

The Senior Center reopened in July.

Once again approximately 170 individuals received serves from the Center.

Social distancing was observed and temperatures were taken when individuals came to the Center for programs. At first people returning to the Center was slow but gradually returned to normal.

Programs provided were Veterans Coffee Hour, Dietary Support Group, Craft, Music, and Health programs. Potlucks were also popular.

There was no Christmas Party during this time due to an uptick in COVID.

Per the normal attendance slacked off during January, February and the beginning of March. Inclement weather and fear of falling on the ice tends to reduce participation.

With the onset of better weather attendance rose again.

Once again the volunteers and staff provided the community with what it asked for and needed.

Florida Volunteer Fire Department FY 21

As we bring this pandemic year to a close, I want to thank all my officers, both fire and association, for helping me to be a better chief. They, as well as all our firefighters, stand by me with a strong devoted commitment to our department and our Town. We did our best to keep our community safe, upbeat and the Town's children in the forefront. It is great to see our small department growing. We have gained four new members this year. During the 2021 calendar year we responded to 84 calls for service.

Thanks to grants and our fundraising, I am happy to report we were able to acquire quite a bit of new equipment: a light tower, leaf blowers, rakes, chain saws, High Lift jack and new defibrillators for all our trucks, as well as Town Buildings.

In addition, through our fundraising, we continued to support Pop Cares, as well as our community-oriented endeavors. Even with the effects of the COVID pandemic, we still fostered our close-knit community by offering fire truck parades for special days, gave the children a fire prevention day, a happy Halloween, time to visit with Santa at our annual tree lighting and, for the less fortunate, a merry Christmas.

With the new repeater up and running, we have been able to have great communication with our mutual aid departments and the Town DPW. Also, though taking more time than anticipated, we continue to work on turning our old truck 7 into a new and improved mini pumper, which will be housed at the Drury station.

At this time, I would like to mention the end of an era with the burning of Charlie Briggs' house. Many of you may remember Charlie. He was a great fire chief for many years, both dedicated and devoted to our profession. Though he is gone, as is his house, he will not be forgotten.

The start of this fiscal year saw COVID-19 continuing to disrupt the world. The school was able to operate fully open and in person however social distancing and safety measures remained intact. The senior center remained close for much of the year and started to open slowly towards the end of 2021 fiscal year.

Work continued this year with Wi-Valley to provide the residents of the Town of Florida with wireless internet service. Selectmen signed the Certificate of Compliance for Phases 2 and 3 this year.

A special permit was voted by the board this year for Better Places Forests. They operate a for profit conservation memorial forest at 333 South County Road. This is a unique business to the area in which clients spread the ashes of loved ones (mixed with soil) at the base of trees in place of cemeteries. There is a 3 ½" marker placed at the base of the tree, in the soil. There are two people per tree and clients pick their own tree/location for their ashes. If a tree should die, a new sapling will be planted in its place. Better Place Forests upkeeps the property and maintains the forest in healthy conditions and a trust is created to ensure the property is maintained for years to come.

The town hall sidewalk, drainage and lawn were repaired and updated this year by the highway department. Mike Worth has joined the highway department by accepting the position of Utility worker, offered to him by the board. Jim White continues as the highway department supervisor, receiving much praise for the work he and his department do for the town residents.

This May the select board welcomed newly elected member Terry I. Green. Terry has filled the seat of Ericka Oleson on the board. Ericka continued on with her position as the town Treasurer/Collector.

Greetings from Abbott Memorial School and the North Berkshire School Union,

The 2020-2021 school year was an unprecedented year for school districts across the state and country. In the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, only fourteen school districts were able to open for full in-person learning to support the educational and social-emotional needs of the children. The Florida School District/Abbott Memorial school was one of those fourteen districts to open and maintain safe, in school learning for all students due to the diligent planning and preparation of the school teachers and staff, Principal Dugal, NBSU admin team, and school committee. The COVID-19 pandemic shut school districts down across the state of Massachusetts in March of 2020, leading to a quick adjustment to remote learning plans to finish that school year. It became apparent to the leadership team of the North Berkshire School Union that developing a plan to educate our children in-person was a priority as we prepared during the spring and summer months for the reopening of school in August due to the internet access issues in several of our communities, including Florida, Monroe, and Savoy. We are proud to state that the NBSU had three of those fourteen districts that educated students in-person during the 2020-2021 school year (Florida, Rowe, and Savoy). Clarksburg students in grades K-5 were fully in-person, while their junior high school students came to school daily for a half day in-person, and half day of remote learning, due to space restrictions, so they were classified as a hybrid model. It was a tremendous achievement by all of the schools to develop plans that brought children back to school safely each day, while also offering a remote learning option for those few families who preferred that learning model during the 2020-2021 school year.

The 2020-2021 school year involved many changes to the way school operated in order to keep everyone in the building safe each day. All staff and students were required to wear masks all day inside the school building. We built in mask breaks throughout the day to allow children and staff more time outside where they were not required to wear a mask. Outdoor learning was built into the school day to allow everyone another break from their mask wearing requirement. School cafeterias were no longer utilized for large gatherings at breakfast and lunch as students adjusted to either eating at their desks in the classroom or outside if the weather was nice. Social distancing became a new term we were all familiar with due to the requirement of trying to stay six feet apart inside the school building. Unfortunately, the prekindergarten program had to be discontinued for the 2020-2021 school year due to the spacing requirements and building limitations. There was also the requirement of maintaining good ventilation in the building which meant windows were left open a few inches, and ventilation systems were updated. After an evaluation, it was determined that the school gymnasium and cafeteria needed an overhaul of the air flow system, and the town graciously supported this work to make improvements under the guidance of Assistant Superintendent Jennifer Macksey.

Abbott Memorial School remained ahead of the curve in providing this adjusted form of in school learning due to the dedicated efforts of the entire staff, school nurse, principal, students and parents. The transition to this new version of in school learning was very satisfying as so many school districts struggled to provide their students with an appropriate education model. While other school districts had difficulty coming to agreements with staff regarding in-person learning, the Abbott teachers and staff worked together with the administration and school committee to navigate the bumps in the road to safely maintain in-person learning for the modified 170-day school year, with the exception of one five-day period when the school went to remote learning due to several positive cases in one classroom. This change was made out of an abundance of caution to keep everyone safe and healthy in the Abbott School community.

We learned and survived the school year, and along the way the students, parents, staff, administration, and school committee all gained a new understanding of what it meant to figure things out as we traveled together down this uncharted road. Everyone worked in collaboration to do what is best for the students in order to keep them safely learning in-person because we knew that was the optimum plan to benefit student learning and social-emotional well-being. I wanted to say thank you to the entire community that makes up Abbott Memorial School for their unselfish efforts that made this all possible for the entire school year. Think about it? The Florida School District was one of only fourteen districts across the state to accomplish in-person learning for the entire school year (by the way, there are close to 400 school districts in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts). We should all be proud of that effort to benefit our students in the best way possible under these conditions.

We also said goodbye to two very important people at the end of the school year. Principal Heidi Dugal and School Nurse Teresa Boucher retired after many years of service to the school district and town. We again discovered how difficult it is to say an appropriate goodbye during a pandemic, but I just want to say that it was my honor to work with both of them during the last three years as superintendent. Nurse Teresa was a tremendous leader and source of knowledge to help develop plans that kept the NBSU schools open for in-person learning. Principal Dugal is an amazing educator and leader who dedicated almost all of her 34-year educational career to teaching students at Abbott Memorial School. They have left a legacy at the school that will last long beyond their time of service there. The school is in a better place because of their influence, and we are all better people because of their positive impact on all of us, both young and old.

We also say hello to our new building principal, Dr. Martin McEvoy, who has been hired to lead the school after successful stints as both a building principal and superintendent in several local communities. We welcomed a new school nurse, Tiffany Ingalls, and a new special education teacher, Madison Marceau. They all hit the ground running as we began the 2021-2022 school year, and I look forward to working with them at the school for many years to come.
