

Select Board Report

June 30, 2019

This year the town approved its first ever skateboarding event organized by professional Skateboarder Jeff Molongoski from Ashfield, MA. The event took place over a two-day period on Whitcomb Hill, bringing more than 60 professional skateboarders to town from all over the United States as well as from as far away as Spain, Australia, and Mexico. Skateboarders were welcomed by residents and allowed to camp on property while other residents generously allowed parking. Concessions were set up benefitting the ROPES Program.

Work continued to move forward between MBI and Wi-Valley to provide the Town of Florida residents with a wireless internet.

The Select board approved the Memorial Commissions request to remove the three-longstanding cypress trees at the Church Road cemetary. The roots from one were uplifting the memorial and blocking five oaks that were planted in the back in memory of 5 individuals.

A Marijuana bylaw was placed on the warrant for the Annual Town Meeting. This bylaw removes marijuana as an excepted use for commercial growing. Under the bylaw one would need to apply for a special permit.

The Selectmen made a motion this year to submit an application switching the towns existing streetlights to LED. This would save the town approximately \$2,500 per year.

Michael Bedini joined the Selectboard after winning the May 2019 election.

Greetings from Abbott Memorial School and the North Berkshire School Union,

The 2018-2019 school year had 89 students attending Abbott School. The majority of students hailed from Florida, 10 students from Monroe, 1 student from Savoy, 4 students from Adams, 16 students from North Adams, 1 student from Clarksburg, one student from Williamstown and one student from Pittsfield. Our preschool program has continued to accept students from out of district at a cost of \$100.00 per week. Our preschool grant has grown smaller and as we move forward, we will be pursuing other grant opportunities for funding. The tuition continues to provide an offset for instructional staff and materials. Seventeen students were enrolled in our full day three and four-year-old program which is indicative of the need for early childhood educational programs.

The 2018-2019 school year saw the hiring of our new Superintendent, John Franzoni. John comes to North Berkshire School Union from the North Adams Public School system. He came on board just in time to help oversee the undertaking of the Town of Florida's huge asbestos removal project at Abbott. The school had to be completely emptied of its entire contents so that work could begin on June 18th and be completed by August 27th for the start of the new school year. Due to the team efforts of the staff, our custodian Bob Ferrara, Burke Construction, ADT and the project leader Derrick Wissman, the Florida Highway Department, Christine Dobbert and the Florida Board of Selectmen, the project was completed a week earlier than anticipated. This project could not have been completed without the support of the residents of the Town of Florida who appropriated the funds necessary for the abatement. Once again, Florida has shown its support of Abbott Memorial and the wish to see the school stay in tip top shape for the students.

Each year, as we return to school, there are additions and subtractions to our staff. 2018-2019 saw the additions of John Friedman as our shared school adjustment counselor, Josh Arico as our North Berkshire School Union Tech Director, Carolyn Hawthorne as our art educator, Dan Collyer as our math interventionist, Janet Zappula as a preschool paraprofessional and Kasha Wissman as a behavioral specialist. Each of these staff members have been welcome and necessary additions.

Florida is fortunate to be a part of the North Berkshire School Union team. Under Superintendent Franzoni's guidance, the administrative team and the member schools' staff were able to create and pilot a Parent Advisory Committee to provide five opportunities at each of the member schools for families to come together to explore strategies to work with their children that would promote literacy, mathematic skills, speech and language development as well as fine and gross motor skills. Our North Berkshire School Union team continues to refine our school safety procedures under the guidance of Trooper Andy Canata. Each school carries out practice drills for fire emergencies, lockdown and evacuation to be prepared in case we are faced with these situations. We appreciate the support that the Florida Volunteer Fire Department and Chief Mike Gleason give to the school. Each year they provide Fire Safety Week events that are educational and engaging for our students. Our fire department is a hidden gem!

Another example of how small, rural schools work best as the North Berkshire School Union is our ability to come together, pool our limited resources and service as many of our students as possible through our summer programming. The summer of 2017-2018, our summer programs were offered for eight weeks at Clarksburg School due to our summer abatement project. During the summer of 2018-2019, our summer

programming encompassed over fifty students from Florida, Clarksburg and Savoy. "The Buzz in the Berkshires" our eight-week summer program, organized by our North Berkshire School Union Summer Programming team under the leadership of Jordan Rennell was highly successful and allowed us to service all of our students at a central location. This programming will continue in the summer of 2019-2020, once again being held at Abbott Memorial School.

Bill Belichick, the coach of our New England Patriots, states," On a team, it's not the strength of the individual players, but it is the strength of the unit and how they all function together." The towns of Monroe and Florida demonstrate yearly their support of their children's' education by supporting the budget proposal of Abbott Memorial. Through the generosity of our community partnerships the students at Abbott Memorial are able to participate in many extracurricular and enrichment activities. We are able to offer basketball, archery, ski club, homework club, Kidterest activities, science fair, concerts, art shows, Americorp programming, outdoor science programs at the Manice Center, field trips to Mass MOCA, the Berkshire Museum, the North Adams Historical Museum, Specialty Minerals, etc. which allow all of our students to expand their horizons.

McCann and Drury High School continue to invite our students to their schools so that they may explore their high school options as they leave Abbott Memorial at the end of 8th grade. All of our friends at Berkshire Compact make sure that our 6th graders each year get to spend a day at one of our local colleges for 6th Grade Goes to College Day and the 8th grade participates in the North County Career Fair Program. Each of these opportunities give our students a chance to make informed decisions as they enter a new phase of their educational careers.

Our Project 351 Ambassadors continue to learn about service in their communities and find that as Martin Luther King Jr. professed: "Everybody can be great, because everybody can serve." Our Project 351 Ambassador for 2018-2019 was Ryan Medon. He led his service team to collecting 968 pounds of food for the Friendship Center Food Pantry, 75 pounds of food for the Berkshire Humane Society and monetary donations of over \$1200.00 to both organizations and the North Adams American Legion Christmas dinner. Monroe and Florida may be small communities but they have huge hearts!

In closing, we thank you for allowing us to be a part of your communities and we thank you for supporting us in the most important job of our lives: educating your children.
