#### Selectboard:

### Jim White, Highway Department Supervisor:

  - Mike Bedini made a motion to lock in with West Oil for the heating oil price of \$3.18 per gallon for 16,000 gallons and the diesel fuel price of \$3.60 per gallon for 8,000 gallons. Tim Zelazo seconded. Unanimous.
- All the boilers are scheduled to be cleaned in August.
- Jim questioned when the hiring process should start for Doug's position. The board instructed Joan to add the discussion for positing his job to the next meeting agenda.
- Expanding the cemetery from the new cemetery to the wood line.
- Working on the sides of Central Shaft Road
- Allstate won the bid for the rubberized chip sealing to be done on Central Shaft Road and Stryker Road. The bid is \$369,337.75. The work will start in August and is to be paid out of Chapter 90 funds.
- The grader needs a new starter.
- Maintenance Man cleaned all the town catch basins.
- Landfill inspection is scheduled for September.
