

How to obtain a 'Check Code' to allow other people authorised by you – such as a driving instructor to check your driving licence on-line.

Visit the website [www.gov.uk/view-driving-licence](http://www.gov.uk/view-driving-licence)

You'll need your driving licence number that starts with the first five letters of your last name, e.g. my own driving licence starts BARTÉ followed by a number and some letters.

You need your national insurance number.

You need your post code that is shown on your driving licence.

Enter these details, then further down the page, tap, or click on START NOW.

The next page has details of your licence and along the grey boxes at the top, tap on "GET YOUR CHECK CODE"

Your check code is case sensitive and will consist of a jumbled array of eight letters and numbers such as R3 fq 6j Gw

Make a note of this code making sure the upper-case and lower-case letters are copied correctly, or better still, take a screen shot of it.

Then send this to me with your driving licence number.
