CHALLENGES

- 1. Limited funding and support from the Central Church.
 - The central church has no available budget allocation to support Mission either local or abroad. Efforts made some leaders to source funds were apparently frustrated.
- 2. **Limited or zero financial obligations from Branches to fund Mission.** Many branches do not budget nor raise funds for Missions or Outreaches.
- 3. Lack of Cohesive (agreeable) strategic decision or vision for Church Expansion. The road map presented by the Mission Coordinator over the past years for church expansion is yet to be adopted for implementation.
- 4. Lack of motivation or readiness of members in new locations to take up challenges for church planting.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- 1. The Church leadership as a matter of obligation must have annual budget to accommodate Mission funding.
- 2. The church leadership must stop destructive criticism to ideas and innovations that can move the church forward.
- 3. Mission Offering (monthly/weekly) must be adopted by all branches.
- 5. Encouraging, Motivating and supporting members in diaspora to engage in church expansion drive is very important to church growth. Our brethren in Otun, Abuja and Overseas need more motivation to start CCBC at their locations. They are not to be castigated or frustrated no matter.

- 5. Form Evangelical Team to assist branches' crusades.
- 6. Form Sub-Team for tracts writing and publication
- Procure Mission materials and equipment for effective outreaches...to villages, schools,
 etc

- 8. Funding: (a). Mission Offering to be collected once Monthly by all branches. (b). 5-10% of Central Pulse for Missions & Church Planting.
- 9. Administration: Centrally Coordinated and Funded.
- 10. Audit: Yearly Report and Auditing of Activities.
