

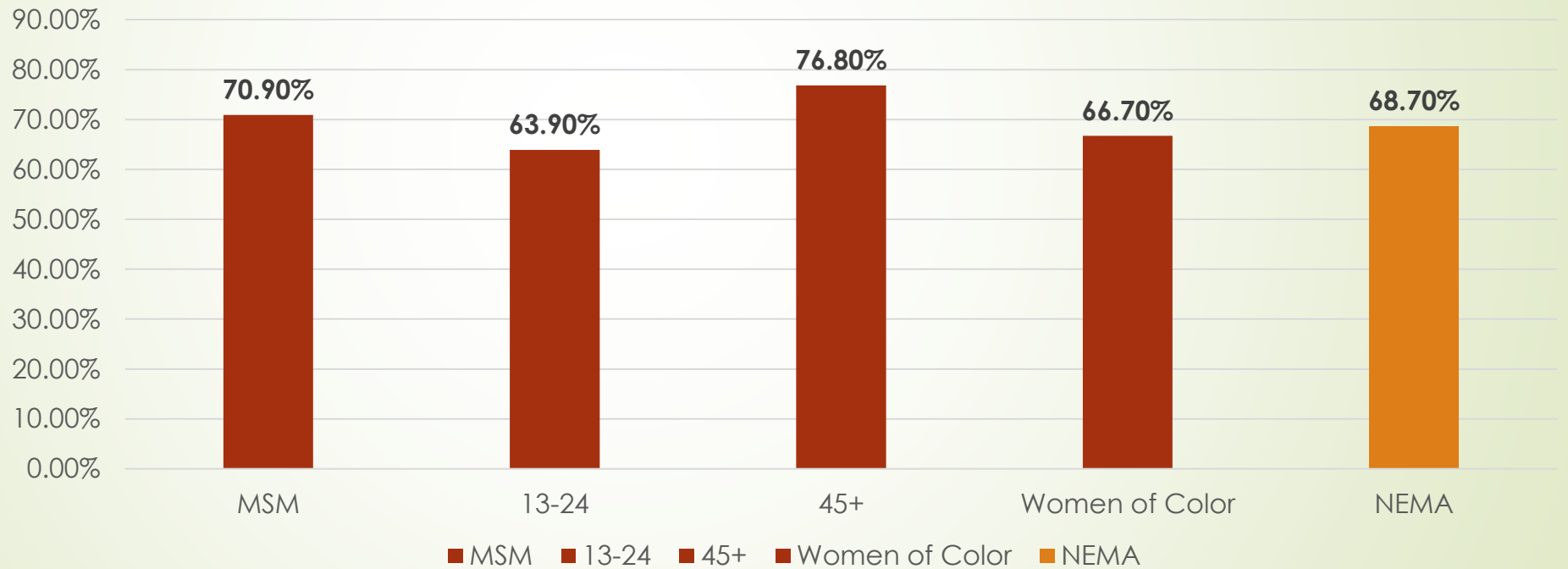


Objective

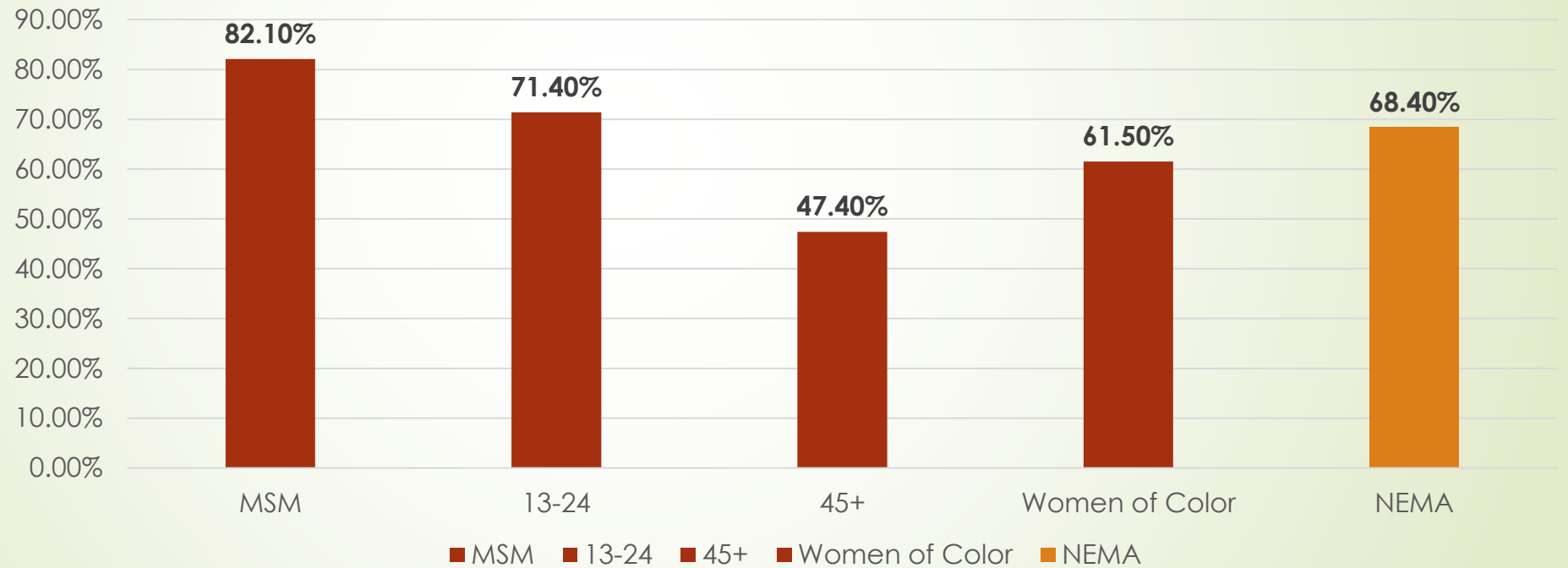
NHAS Goal #2: Link 90% of Newly Diagnosed to Care Within 30 Days

2019 Target Population



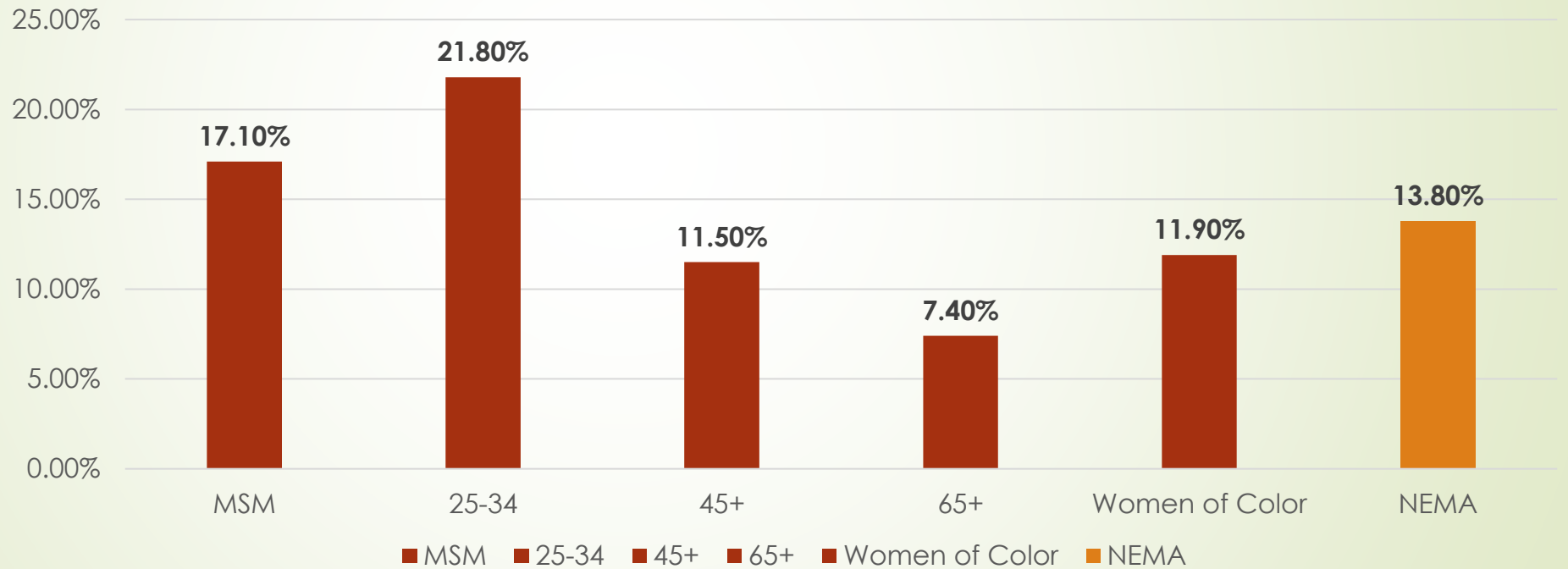
NHAS Goal #2: Link 90% of Newly Diagnosed to Care Within 30 Days

2020 (YTD) Target Population



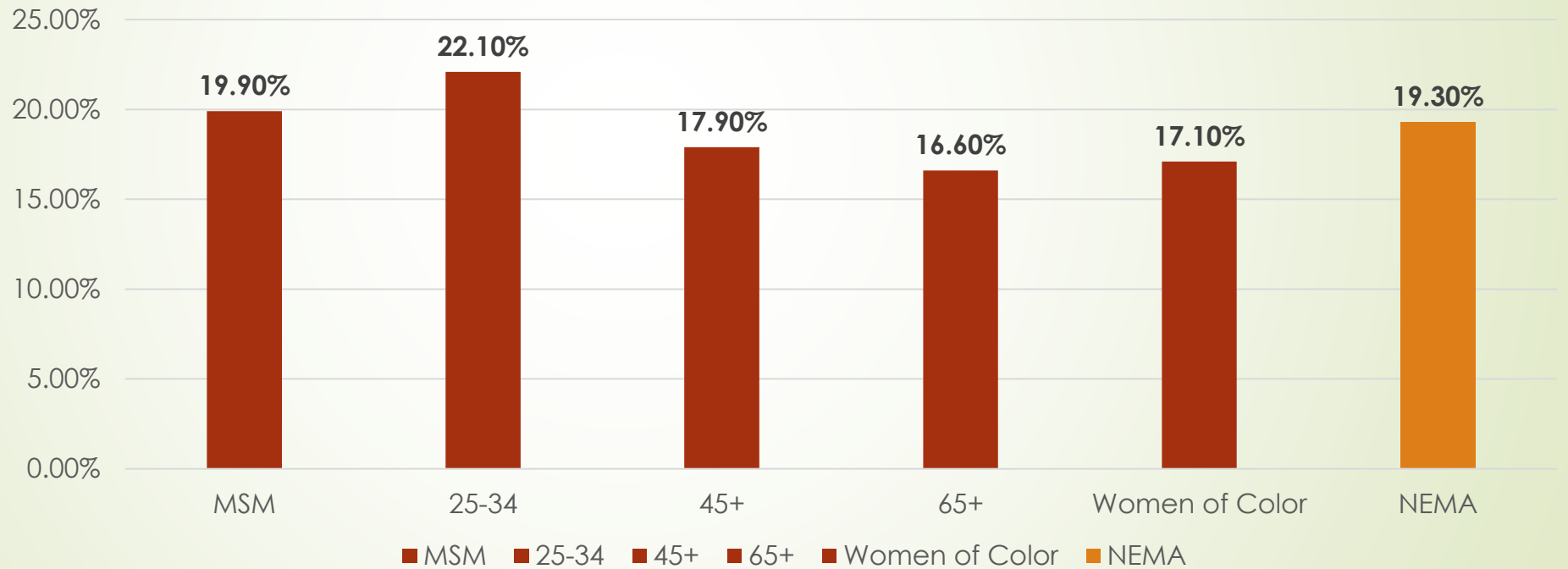
NHAS Goal #3-1: Decrease Gap in Medical Visits to 10%

2019 Target Population

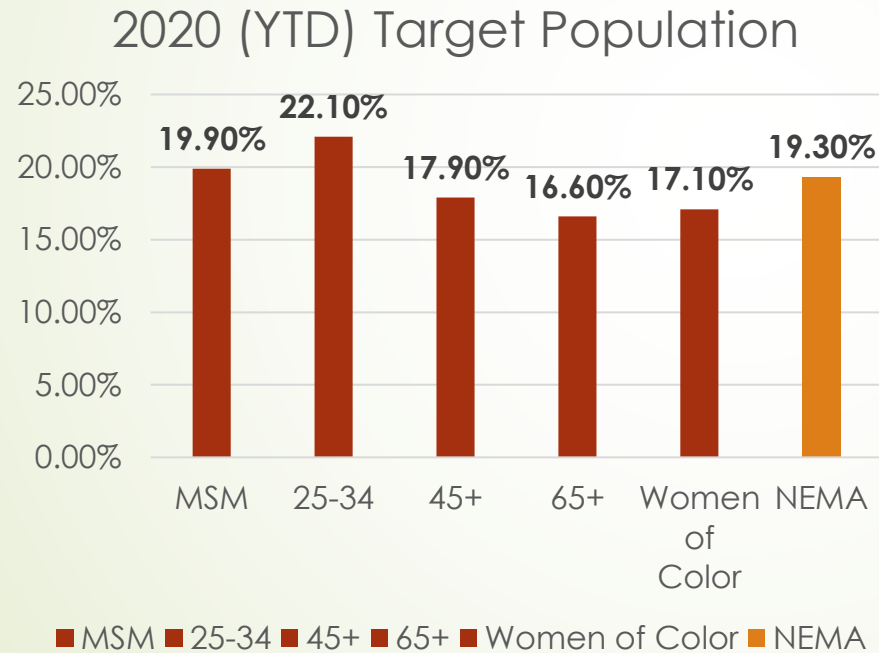


NHAS Goal #3-1: Decrease Gap in Medical Visits to 10%

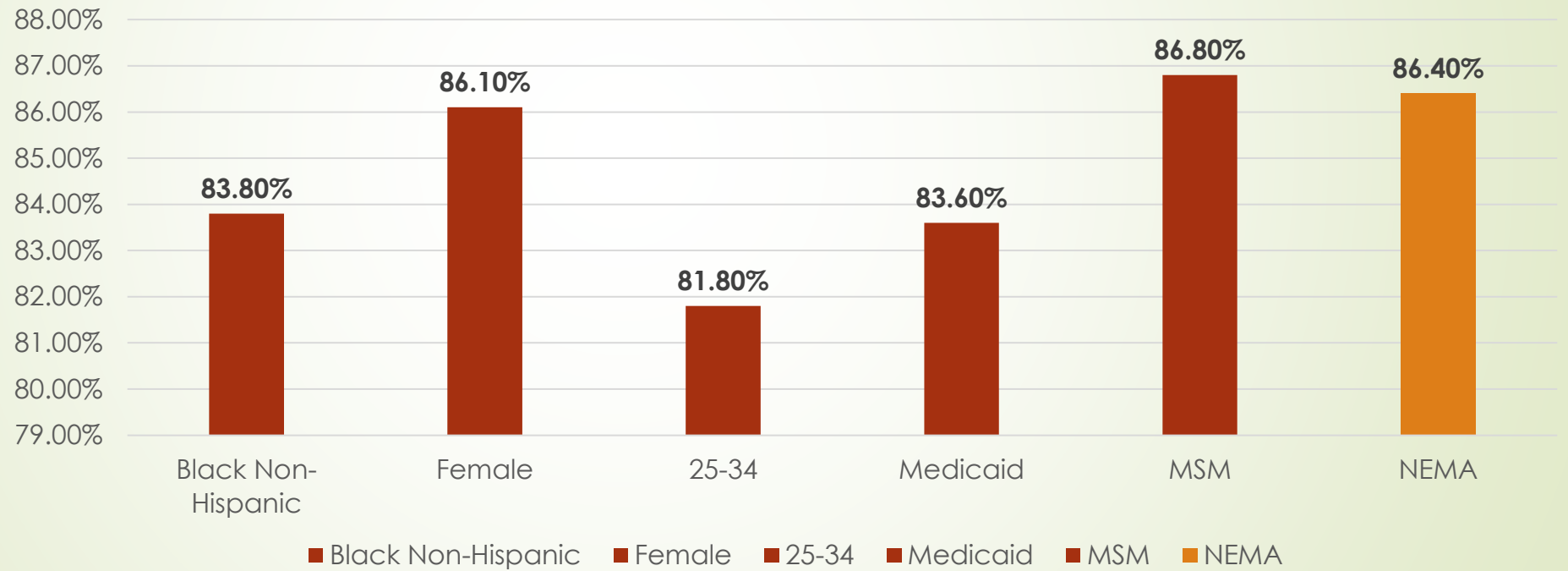
Discussion

- **523** African American; **477** 45+; **249** WOC; **373** Medicaid
- Populations below 10%:
 - 25-34 (**128**)
 - Specific NEMA Agencies

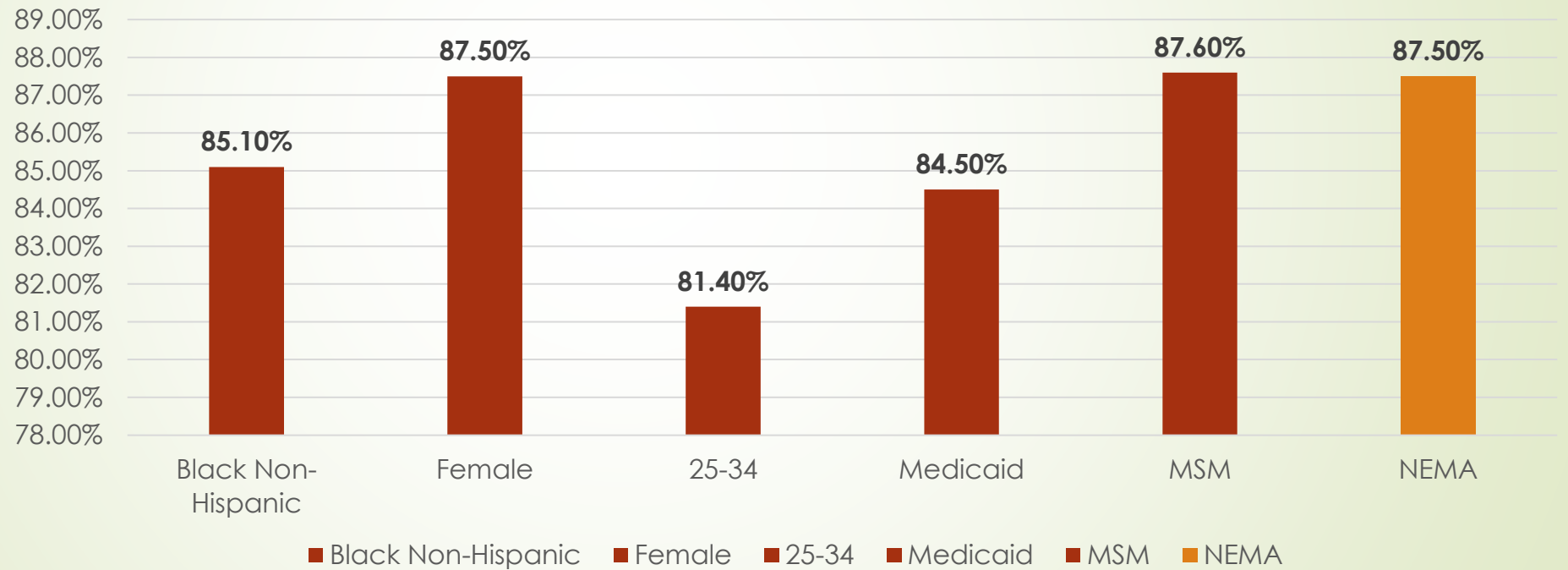

2019 Target Population

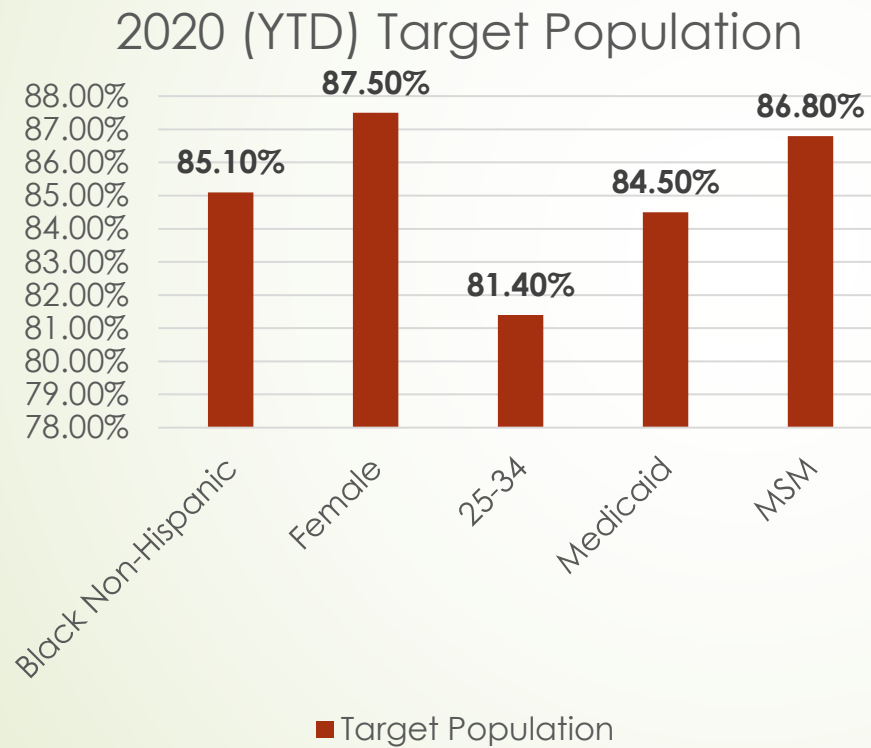


NHAS Goal #3-2: Increase VLS to 87%

2020 (YTD) Target Population

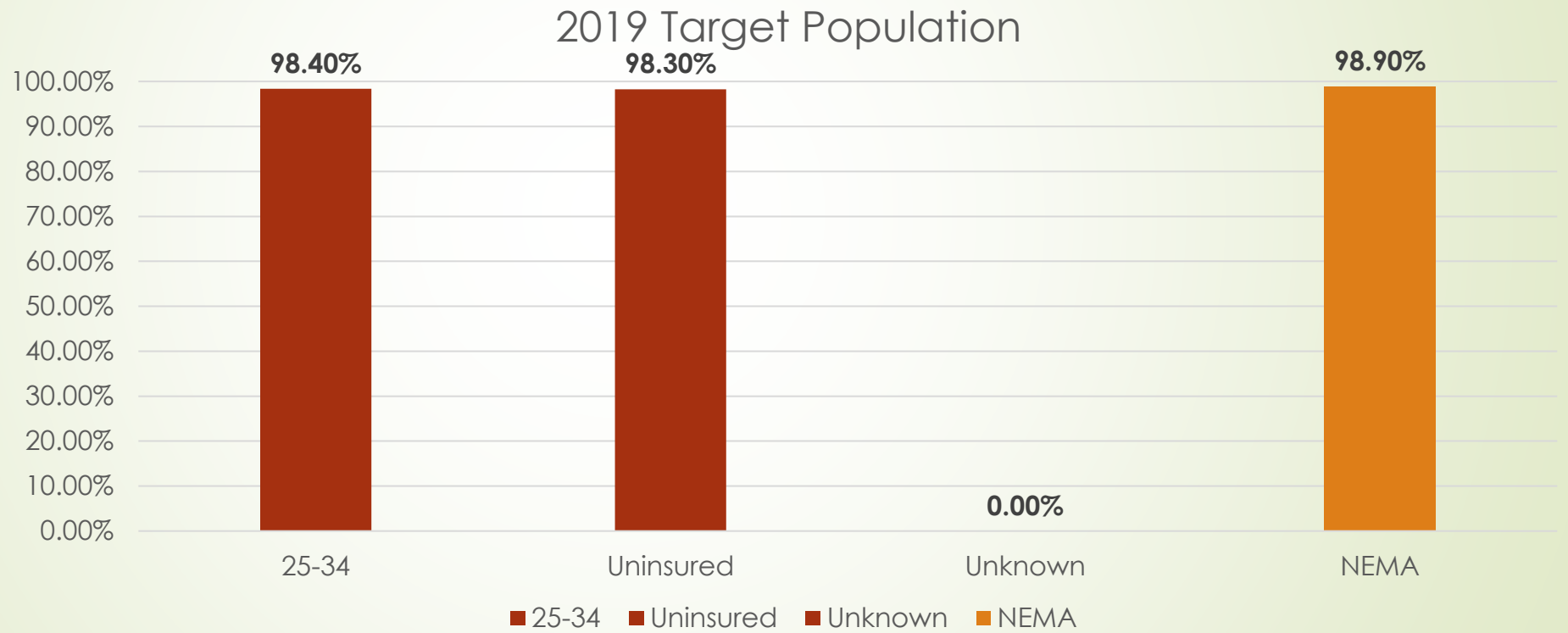

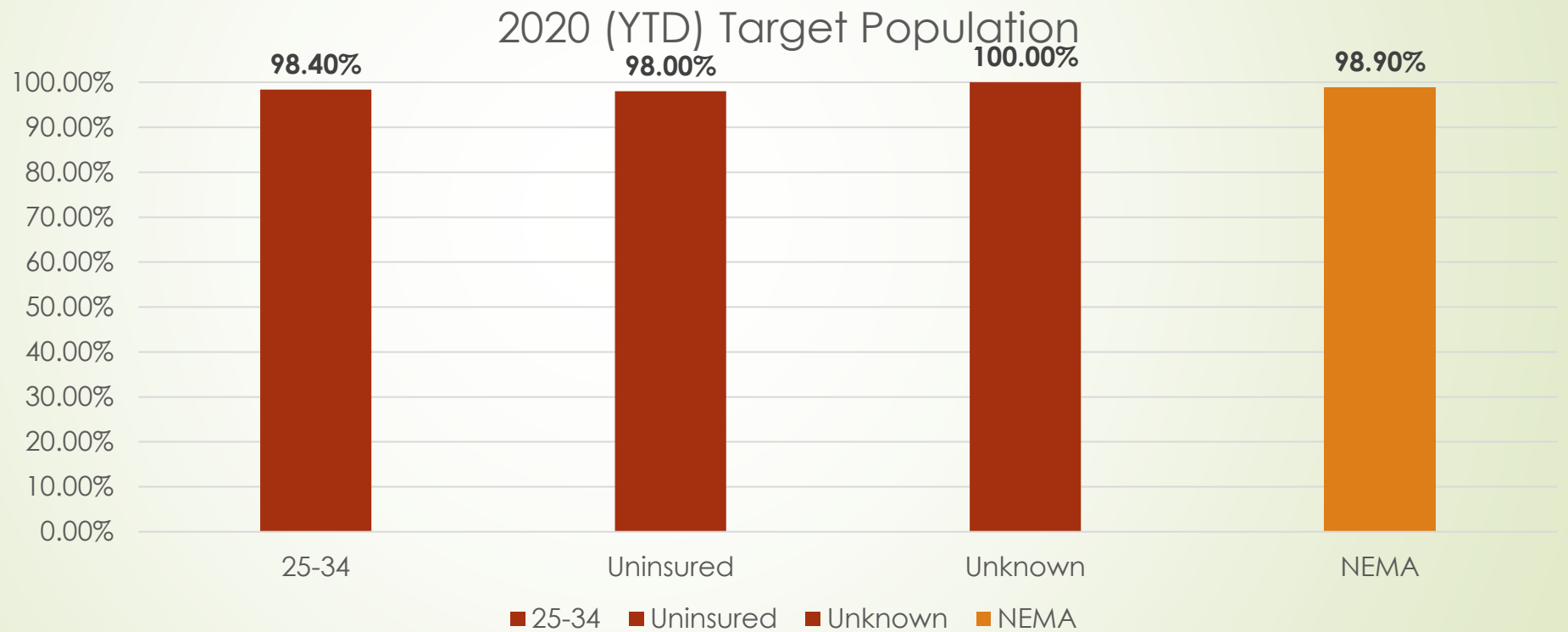


- NEMA Performance Report: **87.60%**

 - 25-34: **130**

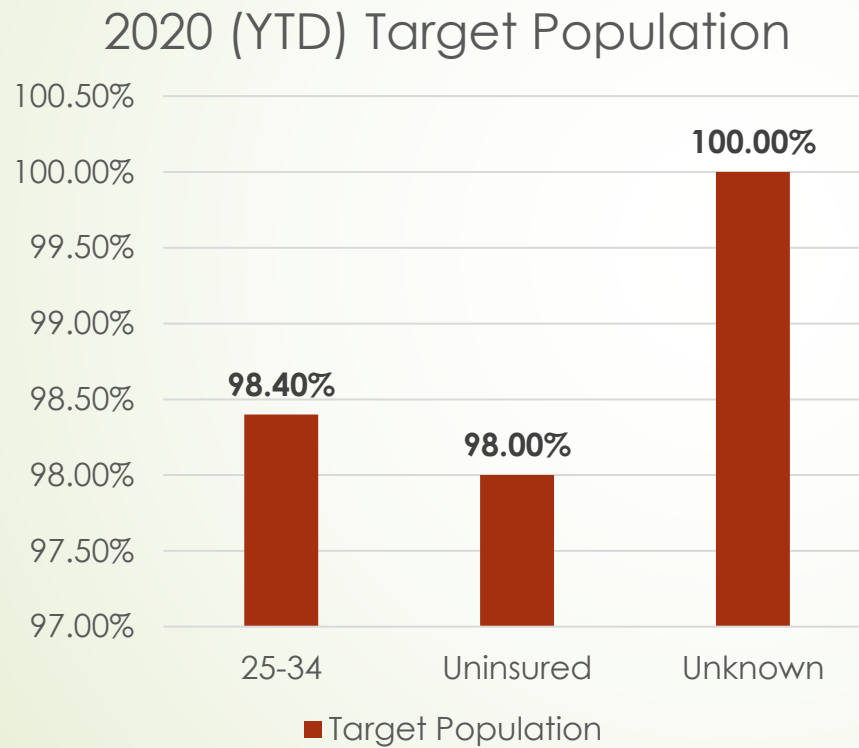
NHAS Goal #3-3: Increase ARV to 98%
