## JOHN 1 v 4 – 5

In Him was life, and the life was the light of men. <sup>5</sup> And the light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not [\[a\]](#)comprehend it.





## John 12 v 46

I have come into the world as a light, so that no one who believes in me should stay in darkness.



# 1 John 2 v 8

Yet I am writing you a new command; its truth is seen in him and in you, because the darkness is passing and the true light is already shining.





## **John 1 v 1 - 5**

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was with God in the beginning. Through Him all things were made; without Him nothing was made that has been made. In Him was life, and that life was the light of all mankind. The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it.

## MAKE IT PRACTICAL

We need to share the light Jesus has given us. When we share His love with others, it turns the light on in the midst of whatever darkness they might be facing.

### **Matthew 5 v 16**

Nor do they light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a lampstand, and it gives light to all *who are* in the house. In the same way, let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven.





## **MAKE IT PRACTICAL**

We have to believe that no matter what we've done or how dark our circumstances may be, nothing can separate us from the light of Jesus.

### **Romans 8 v 38 – 39**

For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come, <sup>39</sup> nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

“The darkness is real, but the light is more real.” How does this revelation impacts our perspective on our current circumstances.

Has something that happened this year try to extinguish the light in our life?





## GENESIS 1 v 3 – 4

<sup>3</sup> Then God said, “Let there be light”; and there was light. <sup>4</sup> And God saw the light, that *it was* good; and God divided the light from the darkness.

We can rest knowing there is no “timer” or time limit on Jesus’ light. His light never runs out!
