- ³ If you show special attention to the man wearing fine clothes and say, "Here's a good seat for you," but say to the poor man, "You stand there" or "Sit on the floor by my feet,"
- ⁴ have you not discriminated among yourselves and become judges with evil thoughts?





Elitism


- For me.... Closely related to Classism. Yet so different.

- Chosen. (John 3:16)








- Christian or Spiritual Elitism.

• Learned stereotype, automatic, unintentional, deeply ingrained, universal and able to influence behaviour.




So what is the challenge?
