BREATH OF GOD

- THE HOLY SPIRIT 'Ruach' can be construed as a person.
- He is invisible and like wind, because He can be felt or experienced, but not seen.

- He is the Holy Spirit, the Third Person of the Triune God. He is God's Spirit.

He also said to His disciples: “There was a certain rich man who had a steward, and an accusation was brought to him that this man was wasting his goods. ² So he called him and said to him, ‘What is this I hear about you? Give an account of your stewardship, for you can no longer be steward.’

³ “Then the steward said within himself, ‘What shall I do? For my master is taking the stewardship away from me. I cannot dig; I am ashamed to beg. ⁴ I have resolved what to do, that when I am put out of the stewardship, they may receive me into their houses.’

SHREWD

To exercise discernment (**the ability to judge well**) to avoid an undesirable circumstance.

Hebrews 5 12 – 14

For though by this time you ought to be teachers, you need *someone* to teach you again the first principles of the oracles of God; and you have come to need milk and not solid food. ¹³ For everyone who partakes *only* of milk *is* unskilled in the word of righteousness, for he is a babe. ¹⁴ But solid food belongs to those who are of full age, *that is*, those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to **discern** both good and evil.
