When he had concluded saying all this to the people who were listening, he entered **Capernaum.** ² A **centurion's** servant, who was highly valued by him, was sick and about to die. When the centurion heard about Jesus, he sent some **Jewish elders** to him, requesting him to come and save the life of his servant. ⁴ When they reached Jesus, they pleaded with him earnestly, saying, "He is worthy for you to grant this,

because he loves our nation and has built us a synagogue.” Jesus went with them, and when he was not far from the house, the centurion sent **friends** to tell him, “Lord, don’t trouble yourself, since I am not worthy to have you come under my roof. ⁷ That is why I didn’t even consider myself worthy to come to you. But say the word, and my servant will be healed.^[a] For I too am a man placed under authority, having soldiers under my command.

LUKE 7 v 1 - 10



I say to this one, 'Go,' and he goes; and to another, 'Come,' and he comes; and to my servant, 'Do this,' and he does it." Jesus heard this and was amazed at him, and turning to the crowd following him, he said, "I tell you, I have not found so great a faith even in Israel." When those who had been sent returned to the house, they found the servant in good health.

CAPERNAUM – Village of Comfort (“Kefar” and “Nahum”)

CENTURION – Commander of 80 or more, Most owed their position to their military skill, **Unbeliever**

JEWISH ELDERS – Members of the Sanhedrin (Political & Regional leaders)

MEANINGS

HEBREWS 11 v 6



LUKE 18 v 42 - Then Jesus said to him, "Receive your sight; **your faith** has made you well."

MATT 9 v 22 - But Jesus turned around, and when He saw her He said, "Be of good cheer, daughter; **your faith** has made you well." And the woman was made well from that hour.

LUKE 17 v 19 - And He said to him, "Arise, go your way. **Your faith** has made you well."

MATT 9 v 29 - Then He touched their eyes, saying, "According to **your faith** let it be to you." ³⁰ And their eyes were opened

MARK 2 v 5 - When Jesus saw **their faith**, He said to the paralytic, "Son, your sins are forgiven you."

LUKE 7 v 50 - Then He said to the woman, "Your **faith has saved you**. Go in peace."

HEBREWS 11 v 1 - Now faith is the [a]substance of things hoped for, the [b]evidence of things not seen.

GAL 2 v 20 - I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the *life* which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me.

EPHESIANS 2 v 8 & 9 - For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; *it is the gift of God,* ⁹ not of works, lest anyone should boast.
