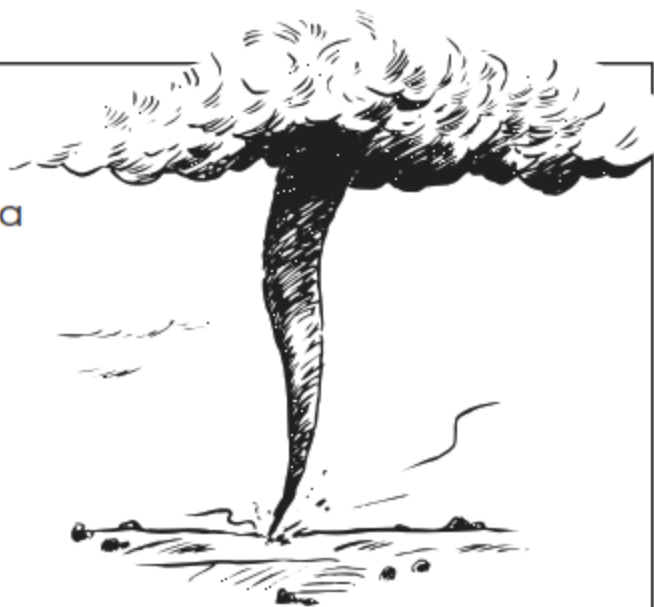

A tornado is a kind of wind storm. The winds can be very strong. A tornado is shaped like a funnel. Sometimes, a tornado is called a “twister.”

Most tornadoes take place in April, May, or June. They usually happen on hot days.

A tornado does not last long. But it can wreck everything in its path! When a tornado comes, the safest place to be is below ground. That’s why people often go to their basements before a tornado comes.
