



PLURAL

one cat two cats

one dog three dogs

Las reglas para formar el plural de las palabras son:

Cuando la forma singular termina en "o", "s", "x", "ch" o "sh", se agrega "es":

one tomato - five tomatoes

Si el singular termina en consontante + "y" se cambia por "ies":

one baby two babies

Pero si el singular termina en vocal + "y" se agrega solamente "s":

one boy two boys
