Guidelines for dealing with incident / accident

- Stay calm but act swiftly and observe the situation. Is there danger of further injuries?
- · Listen to what the injured person is saying.
- Alert the qualified First Aider who should take appropriate action for minor injuries.
- In the event of an injury requiring specialist treatment, call the emergency services – 999.
- The telephone number for NHS Direct is: 111
- Deal with the rest of the group and ensure that they are adequately supervised and safe.
- Do not move someone with major injuries. Wait for the emergency Services.
- Contact the injured person's parent / carer / guardian.
- Complete an Incident / Accident Report Form.

Complete the accident book and give it to Dawn Bowman or Ian Prentice. Accident book is kept in the wall mounted cupboard by the sink behind the bar in the main club house.
