Hythe and Dibden Cricket Club is a friendly, family orientated club which provides cricket for all age groups and abilities. We are all volunteers and all share the same passion for cricket and our local community.



The club has 4 Saturday teams playing league cricket, with the first XI playing in County One. The aspiration is for the team to return to the Southern Premier League. Our second and third teams play in county five and fourth team in county six. Our ambitions don't stop there though....

We have teams play social cricket on a Sunday and midweek against touring sides and a thriving ladies section which has developed strongly in recent seasons.

In 2012 Hythe and Dibden Cricket Club achieved Clubmark status through the England Cricket Board (ECB). The ECB Clubmark is an accreditation scheme for clubs with junior sections. We adhere to the 'Safe Hands' policy for Safeguarding Children in Cricket. All of the adults at the club who work with children and meet the necessary criteria are vetted by the ECB. This includes the Enhanced DBS and 'Barred List' check. Clubmark accreditation is an acknowledgement that we take safeguarding seriously and that we are striving to provide a high quality and welcoming environment for young participants in cricket.

Dawn Bowan, our Safeguarding Officer's hard work in creating a welcoming and safe environment was recognised by Hampshire Cricket Board last year.

Our colts section:

We have teams at Under 9, 11, 13 and 15 age groups as well and also plays a triangular tournament each year specifically designed to introduce young players into more senior cricket. Last year we provided 3500 child hours of junior cricket and coaching as well as starting All Stars Cricket. All Stars Cricket gives girls and boys from the ages of four to eight an opportunity to become a star. The curriculum of fun cricket activities and games provides your children with the basic movement skills to begin a lifelong love of our sport and general physical activity.



All this has brought us to the attention of Hampshire Cricket with whom we work to help develop not only the colts section but also the club itself, being amongst the most progressive clubs in the county. The club has recently been awarded 5 Stars for All Stars by the parents of participating children. Only 8 clubs of the 63 participating within Hampshire received this award.

It is sometimes easy to forget amongst this that we are a very inclusive club, with one of our players even being a World Cup Winner Squad member of the England partial disability squad!





Part of the local community:

We have a big community presence and close ties with the Parish Council, being involved each year in organising Hythe Village Fete and firework displays with local school and other local organisations. We also host Hampshire Cricket ladies days on behalf of Hampshire Cricket Board.

We have a thriving social section and members are always welcome to join us in the clubhouse for drinks or join the thriving darts section that play in the summer and winter league.



Supporting other charities:

The first Sunday in May sees the club supporting Solent Mind, a local charity committed to raising awareness of mental health issues and to providing somewhere to turn for advice, information, and support. Luca Roberts was a popular member of our club, a lively, sociable person in his 20's, who, after a long battle with depression, sadly took his own life in June 2019. His loss was felt deeply by his teammates, who all questioned whether or not they could have done more to make a difference. They committed to raising funds for the mental health charity, to try and prevent needless deaths like Luca's and nominate his friends each year, to do the sponsored head shave.



Obviously, none of this happens by accident and we are fortunate to have a small dedicated team of volunteers who work tirelessly to promote what we do, run teams and help with coaching, especially the colt's players. We are also looking to develop and build facilities that will help us take the next steps forwards both on and off the pitch.
