## Transport to matches and practices policy

Hythe and Dibden Cricket Club's policy is that parents/guardians are responsible for arranging transport for players to and from all matches and practice sessions.

It is not the responsibility of the coach or team manager to transport or arrange transport of the children to or from the club or matches.

The club will not be insuring any private vehicles for the transportation of individuals in connection with any fixture or practice sessions arranged by the club, neither will parents offering to drive other team members be subject to a DBS check through the club.

The implementation of this policy is not intended to exclude any player from participation – parents or guardians should speak to the team manager or contact the Club Welfare Officer if they have any difficulties with the transportation of players.

The ECB's position is that coaches, staff and volunteers do NOT transport children to and from cricket activities.
