Treasures report 2025

After the prior dismal year, this year has been as good as it gets. Income has increased across the board, despite the bar being closed for nearly two months whilst renovations were completed. The bar has had a profitable year which has helped support the club redevelopment and projects.

The much needed increase in revenue is mainly due to events such as the village fete, rock the pier and the fire works and football presentation evening, we must thank all the people who helped with out this we would have no money in the bank.

Whilst this has been a good year we have spent large amounts of money and time on the club renovations. The bank balance and cash at the 31 December 2025 was £47,205. BUT the club has relied on Mike funding the renovations and is now currently owed £20,594. With out this the club would not have been able to complete the projects.

In the short term the club will need to pay Mike and have all of our largest bills before the season, insurance, balls and leaguer fees and pitch repairs normally costing around £10,000.

With the club looking to complete new long term projects, we need to keep funds and prepare for the possibility of the fete, fire works and other events being affected by the weather. With out them we will struggle.

In summery the club had a good year helped by the weather and success of the renovations and club fundraising events. This has resulted in a surplus of funds £9,114 however this is after a large amount of abnormal costs
