**RE: A6116 MAINTENANCE WORKS**

Thank you for your enquiry of 28<sup>th</sup> March 2024, originally addressed to Adele Wylie, Chief Executive, which has been passed to me to respond on her behalf.

In preparation for carriageway patching works, which will take place in summer 2024, we will be undertaking kerbing works on the A6116 Islip By-pass.

These works will commence on Monday, 22<sup>nd</sup> April 2024, and will be completed by Friday, 24<sup>th</sup> May 2024. These works will be undertaken under temporary traffic signals.

As soon as we are aware of confirmed dates for the patching works, we will then be able to advise you further.
